I recently found myself, together with some friends and colleagues, in the unenviable position where our integrity (essentially our character) was questioned. It was our personal integrity that was questioned at first, and then our corporate integrity in terms of how we conduct ourselves in the workplace.

Interestingly, the accusations came from fellow believers and fellow harvesters in the fields of God. Be that as it may, these types of accusations can lead to some intimate times of self-reflection, a time where one can test the motives of one's own heart. Ultimately, I needed to prove to myself that there was no basis to the accusations.

A negative side-effect of a situation like this, is that one could simply give in to the accusations and give up on one's calling and vision from God. Should this happen one would simply be guilty of the "fear of man."

The fear of man is debilitating at best, and all strong leaders avoid this trap! It is this fear that will paralyse a leader to make the right and effective choices that will lead him to success. When one is constantly held back by, "What will they think?" and "How will they react if I do this or that?" then progress can never happen. This irrational fear of man will prevent a leader (and by implication his entire team) from having the courage to make mistakes and fail, and in so doing stopping a natural learning process to achieve success. The fear of man will see the leader avoid failure, and as Robert Kiyosaki rightly remarked, "If you avoid failure you'll also avoid success." Rather, one should fear the Lord, and by this we mean to hold the plans, opinions and intentions of God in high regard and to worship Him simply for whom He is! When we worship God we are safely ensconced in His presence and that is a place of safety far away from negative issues and things that can hamper progress [Proverbs 29:25].

So let me encourage you to keep close to the voice of God, and to obey Him no matter what others think or say. Don't be foolish and ignore wise counsel from others, but be confident in the leading of God.

FEATURE ARTICLE

ANDRÉ & JENNY Roebert

t a young age, both André and Jenny gave their lives to the Lord Jesus, sensing His call on their lives to impact the world with the love of God through the Gospel.

André and Jenny met while attending Hatfield Christian Church in Pretoria, the church André's uncle, the late Ps Ed Roebert, started. They were both involved in the youth ministry and André served in the media department and music team as well. A little known fact is that André plays the trumpet! He financed himself through Bible School being involved in business and commerce, where much of the commercial experience he has today was honed. The year 1990 was significant for André as this was the time where he gave up the pursuit of a business career in favour of full time ministry. A year later he joined a growing community church in King Williams Town in the Eastern Cape. After their wedding in March 1992 Jenny then joined André in the Eastern Cape where they served together as Youth Pastors. Some time later they became regional Pastors and within 4 years found themselves as assistants to the Senior Pastor and his wife. By this time the church began to explode in attendance and had a significant impact in the town and surrounding areas.

In 1996 God started to birth in both André and Jenny a deep desire to see an outpouring of the Holy Spirit in South Africa. As a result of being significantly impacted by the ministry of Dr Rodney Howard Browne, they formed the ministry Revival South Africa; the need to spread the fires of revival to the small towns and villages across Southern Africa compelled them to take a team and travel extensively from town to town. The motivation behind visiting the smaller towns of South Africa was partly spurred on by the fact that the more well known speakers and preachers tended to focus their attention on the larger metropolitan centres, and André and Jenny felt that the more rural population were as much in need of an encounter with God as their urbanised counterparts. Over the next two years the team of Revival South Africa saw thousands of people saved, set free from sin, and set on fire for God. During this time, they were significantly impacted by Kenneth Copeland Ministries, through their monthly magazines and television broadcasts, that provided a wealth of sound, Word based and faith filled teachings. Their hunger for the presence of God and His incorruptible Word fuelled their desire to see the world touched and changed by the powerful and life-giving Gospel. André and Jenny followed the Lord's call to begin, what would soon become a ministry to touch the nation of South Africa, and later the entire continent of Africa and parts of Europe, in many ways, and so in 1998 The River Church was birthed. The church meetings were initially intended as a place where people could come to be refreshed in their spirits and have a significant encounter with God. The ministry schedule during that time was rather intense! A typical week would involve "church setup" (the church was held in a local East London theatre) from 5AM on a Sunday morning, church service, and then the striking of the "set" to be packed into a truck, ready for departure on Monday. Monday morning would see the team travel to the next town on the agenda, have meetings through to Friday evening, packed up and ready to travel back home on Saturday for the Sunday service. Every other week was spent at home catching up with all the administration associated with the ministry.

In September 1999 God led them into the first of many business ventures to come, enabling them to finance the ministry and vision God had given them to quicken the body of Christ and bring in the end time harvest of souls. One of the Farmers Cooperative Union buildings became available on the market, and the 50,000m2 building was purchased as a Ministry Centre and headquarters for the future River Group. Today it is still called River Park, and stands adjacent the harbour at the entrance to East London on the R72 road from Port Elizabeth.

Today André and Jenny are the CEO's of the River Group, comprising of over 47 different companies and ministries, touching people globally with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. With a multi-million Rand turnover annually, they have been able to stay focused to the call of God as the primary purpose of all they do. Today the group has hundreds of staff and is operational in many business centres around the nation of South Africa.

A national network of churches has been established and daily television broadcasts through Faith Broadcasting Network reach millions of homes every day. One such broadcast, Days of Glory 2009, saw over 188 000 souls come to accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. The total number of people impacted by the 24/7 broadcasts through the various channels is incalculable, but the flood of testimonies received bear testimony to the effectiveness of the network.



Today the River Group has its own print company, bookshop, media centre, affiliated churches, River Air Charter Service (specialising in medical emergency flights), satellite television channels, broadcast and recording centre, building investments, a satellite radio broadcast channel, a hotel group, associated ministries and a humanitarian aid division in full operation. All of these work together as a whole in spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ, both effectively and efficiently, across the nations of the world. In order to facilitate the ever expanding global reach of the ministry, a USA office was also established in 2015, from where much of the international broadcast administration is coordinated. André and Jenny constantly strive to follow the plan of God for their lives, and to fulfil the vision and call of God through everything they do. This attitude is passed on to all who form a part of the ministry, and as a united team they support and continue the work of God. Both André and Jenny are adamant that the ministry is not about them, but that it is about God, and that the work they have started will continue long after they have gone to be with the Lord.

André and Jenny are the proud parents of three children, Jordan, Faith and Christian.



ENJOYING EVERYDAY LIFE



t seems that stress is the disease of the century. Products and programs to manage stress are a multi-billion dollar business, whether the "cure" is medicine, counseling, books, seminars or classes. But I've discovered that God's way of managing stress is the most effective way to live.

Jesus says in John 14:27 (AMP): "Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.]"

I know what it's like to live under the burden and pressure of stress, and I know what it's like to have God's peace. I can honestly say that I will do whatever I have to do to have God's peace in my life, because it is not God's will for us to live with stress all the time.

It's easy for us to feel like we can't avoid being stressed-out because it's just the way the world is today. But the truth is just because stress is a disease of our culture doesn't mean we have to adopt the ways of our culture and live the same way.

We have two options: We can continue to be stressed-out until we fall apart, or we can learn how to receive the peace Christ gives in every circumstance, rather than letting stress get into us.

THE CURE FOR STRESS

For many years, I lived with constant stress. I was sexually abused by my father throughout my childhood. Then when I left home at the age of 18, I married the first man who came along because I was afraid no one else would want me, and that led to five years of misery. He ended up abandoning me. By the time I was 23 and met Dave Meyer, I was a mess! I was worried, full of fear, insecure and had a poor self-image. So I tried to find value in what I did and became a workaholic.

Over time, I developed physical problems, like frequent headaches and backaches, and I created problems in many of my relationships because I was unhappy and hard to get along with. I finally came to the place where I decided that I would not live that way any longer. Whatever it took, I was going to have God's peace and live a peaceful life. James 1:21 (AMPC) says, "...In a humble (gentle, modest) spirit receive and welcome the Word which implanted and rooted [in your hearts] contains the power to save your souls." Although I was a Christian during this time of my life, I needed to "get saved" in my soul-my mind, will and emotions. I needed to renew my mind with the Word of God so I could know the Truth and be set free from the root issues of my stress.

This is how it works: When we study God's Word—reading it, meditating on it, getting it deep down in our hearts—it changes the way we think. This causes us to change the way we talk, which changes our attitudes, and then our behavior changes. At this point, the things around us—our circumstances—can't control us anymore.

GET TO THE ROOT OF YOUR STRESS

Being set free from the pressure of stress begins with God's Word, but we also have to understand that if things are going to change in our lives, we will have to take responsibility to change them with God's help. So the first thing we need to do is pray and be willing to hear what He has to say about the real root of our problem. If you're already doing your part, then be determined to trust God to fix things. But if you're not walking in wisdom or you're doing things a certain way just because that's the way everybody else is doing it, then follow the direction He is speaking to your heart to make a change.

We must pray and obey! This means we make a commitment not to live based on the culture around us but by the leading of the Holy Spirit, who lives in us as born-again believers in Christ. Our mind-set should be: With God's help, I'm ready to make a change. Then as we do what He shows us to do (or what He shows us *not* to do), we'll be able to live in peace.

Pursue the peace Jesus is offering you today. It's not the kind the world gives—the kind you have as long as your circumstances are the way you want them to be. The peace Jesus gives makes you calm and undisturbed on the inside, in your soul, no matter what's going on around you. Study other scriptures about peace, like Philippians 4:6-7, Colossians 3:15 and 1 Peter 3:11. Put your trust in God completely and enjoy the life Jesus died to give you. Through Christ, you can learn how to manage the stress of this world, instead of letting stress manage you!

CHANGE YOUR APPROACH AND GIVE YOUR SOUL A VACATION!

One of the most comforting scriptures in the Bible is Matthew 11:28. In this verse, Jesus tells us, "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy-laden and overburdened, and I will cause you to rest. [I will ease and relieve and refresh your souls.]"I think it's interesting to note here that Jesus said He would "ease and relieve and refresh" our souls, not our bodies. It sounds like He's saying we need to give our souls a vacation.

THE INNER AND OUTER LIVES

We all have two lives: an inner life and an outer life. Your inner life is your soul life, which includes your mind, will and emotions. Your outer life is your physical life. And while God cares about every detail of your life, He is more concerned with your inner life than your outer life.

I have found that it's possible to give your body rest but not your soul. For example, have you ever had trouble going to sleep because you were worrying about a problem and couldn't stop thinking about it? This kind of activity just wears us out inwardly. We can also wear our souls out with too many thoughts running on, too many decisions to make, too much talking, and too much multitasking. Worry, fear, excessive concern about what other people think and insecurity are also common reasons people are worn-out and don't have any peace.

I remember when I used to be jealous of Dave and the peace he had. I was worn-out most of the time, worrying about problems but he wasn't. Now, we had the same problems, but while they wore me out, Dave was still peaceful and happy because he would cast his cares on God. One of his favorite scriptures is 1 Peter 5:7, which says, "Cast all your anxiety on [God] because he cares for you" (NIV). And even now, anytime someone goes to Dave with a problem, he'll encourage them to "cast your care" and give them that scripture.

It used to make me so mad when he wouldn't get upset when I was upset, but eventually, I got to the place where I was desperate to have what he had. So I prayed and told God I would do whatever I had to do to be peaceful, and He taught me how to change my approach to life.

THE REVELATION THAT CHANGED MY LIFE

I came to realize that the world is not going to change, the devil is not going to change, and all of the people who bother me probably aren't going to change, so *I have to decide to change*.

In John 14:27 (AMP), Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give...to you. ...Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]" So we can be peaceful and make the decision not to be troubled, afraid, agitated and disturbed, but it won't just happen automatically.

The truth is, we won't have peace if we don't pursue it on purpose, because there will always be opportunities to get upset or offended about something. For example, you lose your car keys when you're running late, or you get caught in a traffic jam, or someone at work gets the promotion you wanted, or



the electric bill is higher than you expected it to be...and on and on. There can be an endless cycle of stuff that happens that we can get upset about.

We also have to remember that we have an enemy who wants to keep us worn-out. The devil is a peace stealer and he works hard to set us up to get upset. But we can learn how to change our approach so we don't live upset all of the time. And Jesus gives us the best example to follow.

THE KEY TO LIVING IN PEACE

Jesus didn't conform to the world—He walked in the Spirit. When He felt tired and pressured from the crowds who wanted Him to help them, He took time to walk away and get rest. He spent time in prayer, alone with the Father, because He knew He wouldn't be any good to anybody if He didn't get refreshed.

It's so easy to let other people's needs and emergencies control and manipulate us. And when we let others run our lives, we can get to the point that we're falling apart! It's not wrong to want to help or please people, but we need to take care of ourselves, calm down and stop getting upset about things that usually don't really matter anyway.

Make the decision today to commit your ways to the Lord and rest in Him. Cast your cares on Him, knowing He loves and cares about you all the time, in every situation of your life. He'll meet you where you are and ease, relieve and refresh your soul!

Abdul* and his wife, Arina*, are from a country in Central Asia. When they came to faith, about five years ago, they did not expect that one day they would pay a heavy price for their newfound Christian faith. For after eight years of diligent and excellent service as a sales manager at a big furniture company, Abdul was shown the door – purely because of his love for Jesus! So at 37, Abdul, his wife, and their four children were without an income...

Three years into his faith journey, Abdul's pastor left their congregation to plant a church in another city. In his stead, Abdul was chosen by the congregation to lead the church and was ordained as a pastor. The church, however, was not able to provide Abdul with a salary, so Abdul continued working as a sales manager at the furniture company. The news of his pastoral ministry spread rapidly. When the owner of the furniture company, a dedicated Muslim, learned that one of his employees was a Christian pastor, he immediately fired Abdul.

DENY CHRIST AND SECURE YOUR JOB

The director of the sales department tried everything to keep Abdul on. He even asked Abdul to deny Christ and to abandon his congregation. "You have a family, you must feed them; leave your Christ for the sake of your family," he said. But Abdul remained unshaken in his devotion to Jesus, "There is no way [that] I am going to refuse Him who did not refuse me and who died for my sins."

"It was a very difficult time for my family," Abdul says as he recalls what they went through. "I tried [being] a private taxi driver, [but] we could barely make ends meet. I remember one day when we did not have enough money to buy milk for our kids. I came into our apartment and saw my wife, Arina. She was crying. I went to our bedroom. I was very upset and was questioning God's will for my family. I fell on my knees and began praying, 'Heavenly Father, did You really want me to serve as a pastor? Did I understand You correctly? Please reveal Your plan for my family and show me Your face!"

GOD MAKES A WAY WHERE THERE SEEMS TO BE NO WAY

And God did! A week after Abdul cried out to the Lord in desperation, he met an Open Doors worker. Abdul was able to explain his situation to the person; sharing his desire to continue serving as a pastor.

One of the ways in which Open Doors could assist Abdul and his wife, was to provide them with a microloan to start up their own business. Abdul opened his own shop in which he sold household water filters. It provided him with an income to support his family, whilst also allowing him to continue serving at his church.



"There is no way [that] I am going to refuse Him who did not refuse me and who died for my sins," Abdul* said. Afterwards he found himself without a job.

Abdul's business is flourishing and he has also



started to sell building materials and equipment. "I was able to hire two Christian brothers to help me with the shop, so I'm practically free and available for the pastoral ministry within the church now," Abdul said when Open Doors recently paid him a follow-up visit.

Before, Abdul doubted God's calling because he had no way of providing for his family... Today, as God graciously chose to use Open Doors as an instrument of His encouragement and provision, Pastor Abdul continues to shepherd his flock and to teach the Word of God in one of the most restrictive regions for Christians in the world today.

HOW DOES YOUR GARDEN GROW? Part 2

Little can compare to a peaceful stroll through a beautiful garden. When vibrant colours and fragrances are blended in with the fresh outdoors air, it makes for a tranquil yet exhilarating, sensory feast!

The Bible often likens our lives to being gardens, designed and destined to produce healthy, life giving fruit and beautiful attributes that constantly showcase God's glory at work in our lives.

Just like any garden on earth, the gardens of our lives, being our hearts and minds, need constant nurturing and care. Neglect to pull out weeds that have the power to choke and destroy life giving seedlings, can result in our gardens becoming lifeless, barren and dry wastelands. That's why the Word of God constantly reminds and warns us to be vigilant and on the lookout for things, like harboured offences and unforgiveness, that can steal our peace and joy and cripple our life giving faith.

Now, just as important as ridding our gardens of harmful weeds, is the process of nurturing life giving seeds!

God's Word in our hearts produces faith!

I believe, that the most vital tool we possess to cultivate and nurture the seeds of life and faith in our gardens is to keep God's Word planted in our hearts. Every promise concerning us in the Word of God, every spiritual gift and the complete work of the cross has already been secured and accomplish by Christ Jesus. By His grace, we can live in the fullness of His blessing and freedom from every work of the enemy. However, scripture clearly teaches that the way we live out that fullness of life is through faith. Remember, by grace it has been made available for us, through faith in Christ Jesus, we walk in the reality of the blessing (Romans 5:2 and Ephesians 2:1).

If you understand the powerful force of faith, you will know that firstly, it is the currency of the kingdom of God. Without faith it is impossible to receive the finished work of the cross in our daily lives. According to God's Word, at the point of salvation, every believer is granted a measure of faith. When we believed the Word of God, which is an incorruptible seed, and received its truth in our hearts, it produced the faith to receive Jesus as our Lord and Saviour. The incorruptible seed of God's Word, when planted into the soil of our hearts, always produces life giving, supernatural faith. The book of Romans teaches that we are able to increase and grow our faith, every time we hear and receive the Word of God in our hearts. In other words, the more time we invest in meditating and feeding our minds and spirits on the Word of God, the more it affects our belief system and produces faith. Keeping God's Word in our hearts and minds will keep a steady flow of life producing faith in the gardens of our lives.

Our words of faith produce life!

Another vital tool I believe we possess, to cultivate and nurture the seeds of life and faith in our gardens is our tongues!

Do you know why? Our tongues dominate our thinking! Our tongues can keep us right in or out of the blessing of God. It's not sufficient to just stop speaking negatively, we actually need to release the power and life giving faith of God's Word into the gardens of our lives by declaring the truth of God's Word!

The way that faith becomes activated to produce life in the gardens of our lives, is when the truth we believe in our hearts, from God's Word, becomes the words we speak with our mouths. Simply put, our words must line up with what we believe. When we release our faith filled confession into the atmosphere, through our words, it will never return void, but will always accomplish what it was purposed to do! 





So I'm eating breakfast at a nice hotel this weekend and within a few minutes, an attractive couple walks in and sits at the table next to me. Once they ordered, the next thing they did was to pull out a mobile phone, find a music video on YouTube, set it on the table and start watching.

They never spoke to each other. The only communication between them was to sing along with the music video (much to the dismay of the other restaurant customers.)

I sat their amazed that:

- 1) They couldn't get through a meal without watching a media program.
- 2) They never actually spoke to each other.
- 3) In-between chewing, they sang along at normal levels completely oblivious to the other diners.

The distracted culture reigns these days.

People can't get through a movie in a theatre without checking their social media multiple times. One study indicates Middle-School kids check their social media 100 times per day on average. We can't drive cars without it. (As deaths from car accidents skyrocket.) On airplanes, I rarely see anyone reading a book anymore. The vast majority are playing video games or watching movies.

It's changing our behaviour in far more fundamental ways than we ever dreamed.

CHANGE REVOLUTION

Have the Movies Lost Their cultural Impact?

I just finished watching the Oscars alone, sitting in the concierge lounge at a hotel. Not that I don't watch lots of things from a hotel (because I travel so much), but for some reason, this year made me realize how little I cared. But it wasn't always that way.

Ingmar Bergman's "The Seventh Seal" was mesmerizing back in college. An atheist who honestly portrayed his struggle with faith captivated me. Then, it was David Lean's epic "Lawrence of Arabia" that really made me understand what a camera was capable of capturing.

In those days, films had a remarkable impact on culture. I'll never forget the horse's head in the bed from "The Godfather." I suggested my parents see "Butch Cassidy and The Sundance Kid" until I remembered Katherine Ross undressing. When they came home, I thought my mom would kill me.

Remember The Graduate, One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest, or The Deer Hunter? And during that period, filmmakers like John Cassavetes were literally inventing the independent film movement.


Back then movies really mattered. They dictated cultural norms, helped give a generation a voice, and were the dictionary definition of "influence."

But now? We live in a far more disjointed, distracted culture. Water cooler conversation is far more likely to focus on TV shows like "Breaking Bad" or the latest mobile app. Young people follow other gamers on Twitch more than they follow talented film directors.

In the past, a significant part of the enjoyment of a movie was in the communal nature of the screening. All those people sitting in the dark watching the screen was something akin to a religious experience. But today? We have a generation who doesn't even know how to behave in a theatre. I've lost count of the number of people I've asked to turn off their phone or stop talking. It's easier – and far less stressful – to just watch on an HD screen in my bedroom. And how much cultural impact can you really have when the mainstream movie industry admits the target audience has become 14 year old boys?

And apparently I'm not the only one who's lost interest. I haven't seen the ratings from last night yet, but last year's drop in Oscar viewers (a new low of 37.3 million viewers in 2015) was obviously an indicator that something has changed. And the uproar over diversity in this year's films was telling as well. After all the grandstanding from a handful of stars, it only generated contempt from Chris Rock during the actual show: "Other years, black people didn't protest the Oscars because they were too busy being raped and lynched to care about who won Best Cinematographer. When your grandmother's swinging from a tree, it's really hard to care about Best Documentary Foreign-Short."

The bottom line is that for all the promotion, publicity, and celebrities on the Red Carpet, the film industry simply isn't influencing the culture as it did. But the question becomes, "What is influencing culture today?"



I am sure that the definition of "city" has changed dramatically over the history of man. Have you ever wondered (like I do), about what city it was that Cain fled to after murdering his brother Abel? I mean, logically it seems that at the time there was Adam, Eve and their two sons; at least, those are the characters from the history of mankind that we had met until then. So, what city is the Bible writer referring to? Perhaps the drama that played itself out in the murder of Abel happened some hundred odd years after the closure of the Garden? Even then that city could not have been huge by any stretch of the imagination.

What I find even more intriguing is that Cain fled to the city because he believed somehow that it would provide him with the safety he needed at that time. Today, nothing has changed. People 'flee' daily from the perceived insignificant rural life to exchange it for the promised glamour and success of the urban life. Once there, they soon realize that the tranquillity of a rural life have aspects that far outweigh the frantic rat-race mentality often associated with city life. Fact is, we have both experiences as valid realities in the lives of people. Now whether one stays in a village or in a city, the way life is experienced in that setting is still determined by the people themselves. Could there be a better quality of life in a rural environment as opposed to city life? The accessibility of retail items in cities far outweighs the rural counterparts. But then again, what is life really about – quality of life or the amassing of stuff?

Walk into any travel agency and the majority of offerings are destinations to major cities around the world. There are travel options to more remote areas, but these seem to be far less when compared to urban travel. Why is this so? Could it be that our cultural and historical collections are by far and large housed in cities?

Let me get back to Cain for a moment, and the fact that he sought refuge in a city. Cities have always been associated with strength, safety and the collective efforts of mankind. Even at spiritual level cities are equated with strongholds and beauty. Examples abound in Scripture, the "City of David" being one. Another example is that God compares the Bride of Christ to a city, more specifically the New Jerusalem by name. So if all we live and experience has its roots in the spiritual (a theme we've explored in previous issues) then could we learn to find peace and security in the madness of life that is associated with urban living? We can also find comparisons between the way we beautify our living spaces (and our urban experiences) and the way we take care of our spiritual man.

No matter how we look at the places we inhabit, both positive and negative experiences will form part of that life; the crux of the matter being in which choices, and how those choices are made!

We stand at the beginning of a new month full of potential and promise, and we have a unique opportunity to make a difference in the places we call home. These opportunities include the ability to make choices that will benefit or harm those who share our space. This places a great responsibility on our shoulders... are you brave enough to embrace this?

More than two billion people (world population 7 billion) have no access to essential surgical care and this causes immense and unnecessary suffering to individuals, families, communities, countries and continents. This lack of essential surgery, apart from the functional suffering, kills more people per year than HIV-AIDS, TB and Malaria together. It destroys the economic potential of individuals and countries. Tertius has been volunteering full time with the organization Mercy Ships International, Operation Smile and The Pan African Academy of Christian Surgeons since 2006 to help relieve this enormous burden that destroys lives. These organizations reach out to the forgotten poor with a message of hope and show them by word and action that each human life is valuable, important and certainly not forgotten. They restore dignity and self-respect while physical and spiritual healing takes place.

Since 2014 Tertius has undertaken three bicycle tours in Europe, South Africa and the USA to raise funds and to raise awareness for this cause. The USA tour was the longest and most recent tour to date; from New York to San Francisco. Not in a straight line but in the shape of two smiles over a 4 000 mile/ 6 500 km distance in June/July 2015, hence the 'Cycle Miles for Smiles' campaign; to put smiles on people's hearts and faces. It is estimated that approximately 12 million people were reached with this message through television, radio, the written media and talks at hospitals, churches and various public opportunities. The fourth cycle tour on this global mission is planned from Amsterdam through Belgium to the UK and Ireland, and back to Amsterdam from 2 May to 27 May 2016 to continue to raise funds for this work, to raise awareness of the surgical need of the poor as well as to talk about the opportunities for individuals and organizations to get involved and help tackle this huge need that is within our reach to make a difference.

The journey of Jean Bosco -a cassava farmer in the Congo



A mysterious growth appeared on Jean's back in 2003. What Jean calls his malady was, in fact, a lipoma—a benign, soft-tissue tumour composed of body fat. Left untreated, a lipoma can advance into giant proportions. In extreme cases, it can even weigh up to eleven pounds. This helps put Jean's plight into perspective—by the time he boarded the Africa Mercy, the watermelon-shaped lipoma protruding from his back weighed twenty pounds. In 2013, Jean's lipoma ruptured and began to bleed. He had no choice but to seek emergency medical care in Brazzaville but could not afford the surgery he would need.. But then he learned about the Mercy Ship that had arrived in his country...

Under the expert hands of South African volunteer Plastic Surgeon Dr. Tertius Venter, the excision of Jean's massive lipoma was complete in two hours.

Today, Jean is overjoyed with this gift he has received from Mercy Ships. "What could I

give Mercy Ships in return?" he asks. "What am I to say to God for what He has done for me? This ship goes beyond. This ship is in God's truth". "All I can give is thank you."



Jean Bosco—a farmer, a father, and a husband—can now return to his family and his land as an unburdened man. His easy smile lights up as he envisions his homecoming. *"Imagine your favourite fütbol team has just won the World Cup,"* he says, *"...that is exactly how my family is celebrating as we speak. There is a very perfect joy that is waiting for me and mine when I get home. It has been ten years since I could rest on my back".* (Excerpt from Grace Antonini's blog 'Unburdened'. 

So don't ever let anyone look down on you for being different. You are perfect and created in God's image. Just wait and see what amazing story God will write in your life if you follow His commandments.







Lightcast specializes in digital media distribution and are currently developing a new mobile app for Faith Broadcasting. In addition to the mobile app, live streaming as well as Video-on-Demand (VOD) options will become available via ROKU, AppleTV, Android TV and AmazonFire from May 2016.

Faith Broadcasting Network is already broadcasting to approximately 50 million homes via satellite distribution. This means that from May the Gospel will now reach 250 million homes; as per broadcast viewership calculations, this number of

homes can easily be converted into roughly 750 million potential viewers! The harvest field is ripe and there are millions of people in need of the good news of the gospel to set them free.

Faith Broadcasting Network is humbled to be a part of the Divine vision to reconnect the whole earth with God, and are hard at work to fulfill the mission and purpose that drives the vision.

The reason Ps André decided to go the digital distribution method can partly be attributed to the fact that worldwide an increasing number of people are favouring these methods as opposed to traditional TV. By broadcasting on both traditional TV as well as newer digital distribution channels, the content on Faith Broadcasting Network can now maximize its viewership potential.
