I have shifted office for the next two months, travelling through 19 of the 50 USA states. As I'm writing I am overlooking the Gulf of Mexico from a beach in Destin, Florida, and everything is really picture-perfect. I am surrounded by American holiday-makers that seem not to have a care in the world, and everything seems to be pretty much 'normal.' However, on a different level altogether there is a massive war going on, and symptomatic of this war is the recent declaration by President Obama to legalize same-sex marriage in the whole of the USA. While this decision by the highest power in this country will surely have severe repercussions on their economy, it is also a real and dangerous picture of the world at large. No matter where we go there seems a real and decisive turning back from the ways of God, whether it is a national apostasy, secularism, humanism or the simple disregard of God in all matters pertaining to life. The writing has been on the wall for some time now, with global culture working hard at desensitizing the human race to the presence, reality and ways of God. We see it everywhere. Jesus commissioned us to be the light and the salt on the earth, meaning that we are the carriers of a message of hope, a gospel of life and a solution of love. So instead of curling up in a foetal ball and bemoaning the current state of affairs, He wants us to stand up straight and clothe ourselves with His truth - 'qird our loins' as it were! God's Word is alive and powerful and has within it the ability and purpose to produce the force of faith on the inside of whoever chooses to hear and receive it in their lives.

Why is faith so important to every believer? Well, simply put, without faith, it is impossible to please God. Perhaps it's easier to understand this statement by talking about what brings God pleasure. Scripture states that the Lord delights in the prosperity of His servants (Psalms 35:27), which is easy to accept because the blessing of prosperity is exactly what was on His heart for us when Jesus went to the cross. Jesus died to redeem us from the curse that has been over mankind since the fall of man. When we as believers choose to walk in the fullness of that redemption, I believe it brings God much pleasure. The fullness of God's blessing, His anointing, the freedoms Jesus secured for us, all of these benefits were intended, by a loving God, for every man to enjoy.

And the only way to walk in the fullness of these benefits, is by faith (Hebrews 6:12). When we put faith to use, it will cause every area of our lives to align with God's promises concerning us. However, unless we put it into use, it just remains dormant inside of us - with no effect. Everything Jesus did for us on the cross becomes a manifest reality in our lives, only when we exercise our faith.

But what does it mean to exercise our faith? The English dictionary says that exercise is: putting into action, use, operation, or effect. So in order to see the supernatural promises of God become a reality in this natural world, we need to put our faith into action, we need to put it into use and operation. We need to put our faith into effect.

James 2:20 says, "... faith apart from [good] works is inactive and ineffective and worthless..." The word works here means corresponding action. So, you can read James 2:20, like this, "...faith apart from a corresponding action is inactive and ineffective and worthless..."

In other words, if the Word of God has instructed us to do something in order to set a promise into effect in our lives, then we actually need to do the corresponding action that is connected to that promise.

Let's take the promise in 2 Corinthians 9:7,8 as an example. It states that a purposeful, cheerful, prompt to do it giver will receive abundant grace "... so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need - be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]."

The promise of abundant grace and financial blessing is linked to the corresponding action of cheerful giver!

The problem, however comes when we hear the promises of God, faith rises up on the inside of us, yet we fail to activate that faith by doing the corresponding action. There is a 'tug of war' that takes place between our hearts and minds. As born again children of God, we are born into the kingdom of God. The language of that kingdom is faith. So the language of our spirits is faith. However, the language of our minds is reason. And the two are opposed to each other. They are constantly fighting against each other.

That is why scripture instructs us to constantly renew our thinking to the language of the kingdom of God - the language of faith. A little while ago, I heard Kenneth Copeland say that before we can become fluent in a foreign language, we need to think in that language. So for our minds to become fluent in the language of the kingdom of God - we must keep them renewed to the Word that produces faith! If we don't, at the times our spirits want to respond to the faith that has risen on the inside of us, our minds will resort to reason and not recognise the language of faith. And reason will usually win, causing us to not follow through on the corresponding action that would activate our faith to receive the promise.

James 1:22 says, "But be doers of the Word [obey the message], and not merely listeners to it, betraying yourselves [into deception by reasoning contrary to the Truth]."

You see, when we hear God's promises, and faith rises up on the inside of us, yet we don't do, or obey the Word, we betray ourselves from receiving the reality of that promise. Simply because reasoning convinced us to not obey the Word.

As powerful and vitally important as faith is in our lives, its ability to cause the supernatural promises of God to become a reality in our natural lives depends on our obedience to do what the Word says.

I once read that if we choose to be a doer of God's revelations and not just a hearer, His river of Divine provision will never cease to flow into our lives.

t is said that in the heat of a battle during World War II, Winston Churchill gave a speech that consisted of one sentence. He said, "Never, never, never, never give up!" I don't know if that's really the only thing he said, but I do believe the Holy Spirit is speaking that one thing to many of us today. Don't give up, because God has so much in store for our lives.

DON'T STAY STUCK!

It's very easy to want to give up when things get hard. Sometimes people get stuck where they are and don't know how to get out, so they think giving up would be easier. It may be they feel they're not smart or talented enough...maybe something traumatic happened to them...or they may have failed at something or made terrible mistakes in the past.

But the Holy Spirit anoints us to press in, to press on and go through to our victory, even if things don't go the way we planned. Failure does not mean there are no more options. You can learn from past mistakes...history is a good teacher. Try again...if nothing else, you'll learn what works and what doesn't work and go from there. You can turn your obstacle into an opportunity to grow wiser and mature spiritually.

God wants us to live a good life. However, there is no elevator ride a good life. Trust and perseverance are a must. John 10:10 tells us that "the thief comes in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). The Holy Spirit will leadus one step of faith at a time into the good life God has planned for each of us.

NEW BEGINNINGS

There will always be obstacles to overcome. There will always be "issues" to get past. But there will also be do-overs... second chances...new beginnings. It's never too late; justdon't give up! God is all about fresh starts. He forgives our sins, our mistakes and failures when we repent. We need to learn to forgive ourselves as well. Stop remembering what He has forgotten and enjoy your life. You don't have to keep paying for your past, just receive His forgiveness and go on. You are a new creation in Christ! (See 2 Corinthians 5:17.)

Because of that, all things are possible with God. The Holy Spirit leads us, one step at a time, and gives us resurrection power to enjoy our lives even when our circumstances are not so enjoyable.

Of course the enemy will throw up all the roadblocks he can...that's just who he is. But with the Holy Spirit leading the way, you don't have to get stuck in a difficult moment or season. Stay focused, determined and obedient and He will lead you through.

That is the key...obedience. Work with the Holy Spirit. Yield to His guidance and don't resist Him. How many times has the Holy Spirit prompted you to do something, but because it doesn't feel good you resist His lead? For example, He may encourage you to give up certain friends. But you love them...and you want to be loved, so you ignore that nudge in your heart. But God just wants to lead you to better, healthier relationships. He is always looking out for your best interest.

IN BETWEEN TIME

It's the "in-between" time when you will have to persevere. And whatever happens during your "in-between," know that it is an opportunity to grow strongerin your faith and relationship with the Lord.

When the Holy Spirit spoke to my heart while I was making my bed one morning years ago, He told me I would travel the world teaching His Word and have a large teaching ministry. But there was definitely an "in-between" period for me. I had to learn some things...like how to be in authority by being under authority. I had to learn submission and humility...and I had to forgive.

I remember one time during my "in-between," when I held on to the leg of my desk and cried because I wanted to run. I begged God to help me to stay put. Thanks to the Holy Spirit's help, I persevered and endured several years of testing, growth and development, and eventually began my full-time ministry at the age of 42. But it didn't happen overnight for me. It didn't happen so quickly for Moses, David, Ruth or Paul either. It won't happen in a snap for anyone, but if you won't give up, God's plan for your life will happen.

Even if you've had a bad foundation in life you can have a new beginning...a do-over... a fresh start—and a great finish. Just be determined to *never give up*!

Just not so long ago we observed the Pentecost season and it always warms my heart when I am reminded of the tremendous sacrifice that the Lord Jesus Christ made for you and I. In John 16:7 (NKJV) the Lord Jesus said "Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you."

I had the privilege of speaking at an open air meeting on a rugby field in Vereeniging on a very warm winter's day and as we spoke about the person of the Holy Spirit a beautiful gentle breeze blew through that rugby stadium and people were amazed at how God physically impressed Himself upon us. I think the biggest problem amongst believers is that they minimise the reality of the third person of the God Head, namely our Lord Holy Spirit. That unbelief limits God to work on our behalf. Horatius Bonar a very famous Scottish hymn writer who loved the Lord

passionately said "All unbelief is the belief of a lie," and of course we know exactly

we know exactly who the

father of all lies is, the deceiver of the brethren, it is the devil himself. He hates God so much that his primary weapon is to bring "deception" amongst the believer and of course if you can't believe then God can't work.

The woman with the issue of blood who said to herself "If I could just touch the hem of His garment, I will be healed." She was desperate, she had no money, all her money had been used up and no doctor could help her (Matthew 9:22) When she touched the hem of His garment and the Bible says that that issue of blood that had been flowing for twelve years was instantly dried up and she was healed. Jesus turned around and said "Women your faith has made you well." We see the same things happening to the blind man Bartimaeus in Mark 10:52 (NKJV) where he said "Rabboni (Teacher), that I may receive my sight," and the Lord said "Go your way; your faith has made you well." When we start to understand that the Holy Spirit is a friend who sticks closer than a brother and wants to help us in every aspect in our lives because He is the Comforter (Parakletos which is Greek), the Encourager, the Counsellor and the Advocate. He is available for you and me.

All we have to do is call upon Him. I have started to do that more now than ever before in my life, because I am realising like never before

that without Gods supernatural intervention you and I are not going to make it. Let us start to pay more homage, more respect, and more love, towards our Lord Holy Spirit. Jesus knew the potential of the Holy Spirit to help us so much that He said it is more advantageous for you that I go away because if I do not go away I cannot send the Helper. We need to cultivate our relationship with Him. Many people

"But I can't hear Him speak and I can't see Him." No, but He is there. I am a real home sick farm boy, but I call upon the Holy Spirit, my Friend and He is indeed such a comforter and reassures me that Jill is well, that the Lord can look after her even better than I can and that encourages me.

May God bless you as you continue to trust the Holy Spirit for every aspect of your life and of your family and your business.












Thoughts on Sharing by Waldo Malan Special Control of the Control



We have this great commission from Christ to go into the whole world and share the Gospel. Before we are able to respond the commission we have to respond to Christ Himself, since the commission will just be another job if not motivated by a personal relationship. This simply means that if we even attempt to abide by the instructions of the commission without first having a personal experience with the giver of the commission we have already failed. We can storm the streets with tracts and Bibles, stand on corners with bull-horns and speak about Jesus, compare the numbers of "souls saved" from the records we keep, and still remain ineffective in connecting those very same people on the street with the love of God. The commission without lesus is just another task to be done, and ultimately devoid of power.

The word "gospel" is taken from the Old English word godspel, which is made up of the word god (good) and spel (story, message); literally it means "good message" which is sometimes translated in moderns English as "good news." Essentially the gospel is good news and not doctrine; it is not a set of rules, a behaviour thermometer, or an attitude g auge... it simply is good news. Jesus defined the message of good news rather simply - it is to show people that there is freedom to be truly loved, truly valued, and truly estimated in a relationship with God. The good news is simply to show people that they can be free from fear, disappointed, rejection, sickness and worthlessness by accepting the love and grace from a Father burning to give these away as a free gift. The good news in essence is simply a call to be loved and to love in return.

Once the good news has been tasted it sparks a response in us to serve it to others as a gourmet meal. We have an option here in the way in which to share this. Firstly, we can open the recipe book and read to others the precise ingredients to use, the exact measurements of the ingredients, the ideal temperature of the stove, the time it will take to prepare, the garnishes to complete the meal, and even show them a photograph of the finished product. Alternatively, we can present people with the finished product, let them taste it first and as a bonus send them away with the detailed recipe so they can continue to make the same meal for sharing with others. I can guarantee you that the people most impacted by our interaction with them would be the ones who actually tasted the food first.

Essentially the gospel is good news and not doctrine; it is not a set of rules, a behaviour thermometer, or an attitude gauge... it simply is good news.

It would be silly to deny that Jesus called us to spread the gospel. So we don't. But it is really up to us how effective we will be in fulfilling the commission successfully. I can think of no better way that to look at the example of Jesus on how to "do" this commission - after all, Jesus was simply asking us to do what we have already seen Him doing.

Jesus offered Himself as the 'meal of all meals' and the "dish above all other.' And I mean no disrespect by this analogy. It was lesus who said He is the 'Bread of Life' (already proclaimed in the Holy Place in the temple), and it was He who offered His disciples His blood to drink. Since He was the ultimate sacrifice, obviously we cannot offer exactly the same. However, we are called to offer ourselves to Christ, forsaking even our very lives. In this way, we too can offer others what Christ had first offered us. No greater love has man than to lay down his life for others. And so, we need to offer up our very life in order to 'do' as Christ 'did.' We then share His suffering, and in so doing, share His love.

To 'do' the commission of Christ will require everything from us, and it will require us to be nothing in ourselves so that we can be everything in Christ. In essence, the good news we bring is totally dependent on us obeying Christ until death. And in our death Christ is glorified, and this is the good news.

Today, many people are not willing to pay that price, and so the good news becomes watered down, a meal prepared with substandard ingredients, and shortcuts taken in the preparation. It is time that we dust off the original recipe and start afresh, take what is required and offer others the meal of meals!

Paul writes in Romans 8:12 that all children of God are led by the Spirit of God. He goes on to say that if suffer with Christ they will also be glorified with Him. I believe that a part of this suffering is extended to our personal lives as we erect boundaries around our families and also for the sake of our children.

It seems as if parents, in general, are more interested in staying within known comfort zones, rather than exploring avenues that could yield better results. The fact is that in "the last days" parents will have to be much clearer in vision, giving direction, setting an example and the discipling of their families.

Parents do need to realize that they might have to suffer for the sake of truth and the protection of their families, more than ever before. I want to give some real life examples of how parents are prepared to suffer for their children, and through these give the assurance that the fruit is very much worthwhile.

I see how concerned, Godly mothers would start a prayer group at their child's school for the sake of godliness at these schools. These mothers become like watchdogs in the school community where headmasters and teachers need to reckon with them. Overall the school environment is morally safer than schools where there are no parents praying or keeping decision makers accountable.

Many parents would take their children out of school and home educate them rather than entertaining suggestions to put their child in a 'special class' or putting them on medication, if in actual fact their child only needs a more individualised form of education. The fruit of

this change results in a child with a much better sense of belonging, worthiness and competence

I see a father taking his sons out of boarding school to safeguard them from the pressure of watching pornography with friends. These families 'suffer' especially when the mom was not necessarily ready for the radical step of home-schooling the children. In many instances the dads also take on the role of educating the children; while at times this is unchartered territory, they do this because they believe it is the right thing to do. The result is a child rescued from perversion because a father was willing to pay the price and suffer the consequences of initial personal inconveniences. I witness how career women adjust their lives for the sake of a child in need.

They give up a secure careers and huge salaries in obedience to the voice of God to be a stayat-home-mom to educate their children. In many instances it entails a move to a smaller house, having just one car and fewer holidays, yet more quality family time and spiritually whole children.

Many parents put down boundaries with regards to freedom in using technological devices such as cell phones, tablets and television. At times these families suffer and are labelled as 'old fashioned,' yet most children and adults are negatively addicted to technology without even knowing it. According to Nir Eyal in his book Hooked, "79% of smartphone owners check their device within 15 minutes of waking up every morning.

Perhaps more startling, fully one-third of Americans say they would rather give up sex than lose their cell phones. A 2011 university study suggested people check their phones thirty-four times per day. However, industry insiders believe that number is closer to an astounding 150 daily sessions. We're hooked. The technologies we use have turned into compulsions, if not full-fledged addictions. It's the impulse to check a message notification.

It's the pull to visit You Tube, Facebook, or Twitter for just a few minutes, only to find yourself still tapping and scrolling an hour later."

Responsible parents see the dangers of these addictions in advance and put measures in place to address a discipline where a technology can be a tool and not an addiction. One such an example is to listen and follow the Word of God on your phone first thing in the morning before starting to interact with others. More and more families are opting not to watch television programmes that negatively impact their spirituality, and also add to a waste of time.


I want to inspire parents with children in public schools, to fight for the right of their children not to be sent away to other therapy centres, but rather for their own schools to have small centres where these special needs can be addressed. I challenge churches to start centres for the special needs of gifted children in their churches. Where it is possible for parents to home educate their children it is preferable to letting them suffer and be fearful of life. When a child feels he or she is no delight to others, they are traumatised and it affects their pursuit of the purposes of God in their lives.

Parents and grandparents need to live by example now more than ever before, and to model higher Biblical values. All parents need to have a clear vision of where they want to take their children and need to be prepared to suffer for it.

Oswald Chambers in My Utmost for His Highest writes, "God gives us the vision, then He takes us down to the valley to batter us into the shape of the vision, and it is in the valley that so many of us faint and give way. Every vision will be made real if we will have patience. Think of the enormous leisure of God! He is never in a hurry. We are always in such a frantic hurry. In the light of the glory of the vision we go forth to do things, but the vision is not real in us yet; and God has to take us into the valley, and put us through fires and floods to batter us into shape, until we get to the place where He can trust us with the veritable reality."

The road that we walk with our children and grandchildren is a journey not for the fainthearted. It is a road of changing first, and then to be an example for those who follow. As time goes on I become increasingly aware of the price we have to pay to ensure close relationships with family members, and that they have an example to live life, not only for themselves but also for those who follow them.

Martie du Plessis give guidance to families about alternative education, mostly home education. When parents have more time with their children, they can live a more value based life.



Since our last update so much has happened! Let us start off with the "not-so-good" news first – during the removal of some of the old wooden floor one of the main water lines for the top floor was punctured and we sustained some water damage to the tenants on the lower floors. The team was quick to rectify the damage and managed to contain the 'flood' to a minimum. Apart from this little incident all the rest of the news is good! Roughly 50% of the old floor is either lifted or replaced by concrete, as you can see on the drawing made by our building manager. Much of the wood from the floor has been packed and freighted to Cape Town. Every time we walk on site there is an air of expectancy to see the whole project fully complete. We are amazed at the goodness of God, and thank Him daily for the

amazing team He has put in place. The municipal approval on the final changes by the architects has now also been officially approved – this is an on-going process and critical to the overall progress. The corner Prayer Chapel has also undergone some conceptual changes and the architects submitted this in the week - we are super-excited about all the changes and wait in anticipation to see the final work!

Don't be misled into believing the work that is happening at headquarters is located on the fourth only. On the "lower decks" all hands are occupied in doing the daily tasks that keep Faith Broadcasting Network on the air, and your favourite programmers and presenters 'in your lounge!' In a manner of speaking "all hands are on deck."



what you believe and why you believe it? It's not something we think about too often, because we know the path we've chosen, and now we walk it, getting on with things. It must be said though, that if you spare a thought for what it is that you have chosen to believe and what it means to you, now and into eternity, it's a pretty incredible thing! And to think that other say 'NO!' to an opportunity to be born again, and to have Christ guide their lives! Why would they say 'no' to that? There are a bucket load of bad excuses that get thought up when that question is posed, but I'd hazard a guess that one of them is because people want to live life on their own terms. Why Christians Need to Visit Museums



Our world is shaped by innovation—the newest iPhone, the latest Netflix show or the most current social media app. It's hard to imagine a world without these devices, but iPhones have only been around since 2007, unlimited streaming on Netflix came the year after and Facebook is a young company at just eleven years old. The world before this unlimited access to information now seems archaic, but staring at "devices" all day can prevent us from seeing the bigger picture. The bright light of the screen can be more than a little blinding.

Fortunately, there are remedies for this. Increasingly, many American families have employed restraints like digital curfews, no more screen time after, say, 9 PM. Others make a more substantial effort to reconnect with the larger community by joining clubs or leagues. Museums, however, offer us the best opportunity to shed our often streamlined worldview to better connect with history and understand current events in a way that can impact and shape our lives. While technology has made amazing advances that have changed the way we learn about the world, nothing can come close to the total immersion we can experience at a museum.

In Washington, D. C., considered by some to be the museum capital of the world, museums are so much more than buildings full of dusty old artefacts. They are finding new ways to be innovative by combining technology with cultural heritage and education to bring us the best of both worlds.

A perfect example is the new Museum of the Bible in Washington, D.C. which will house some of the rarest and most important artefacts related to the Bible. It opens in 2017, two blocks from the National Mall. The Museum founders hope it will be a place for people to "engage with the Bible" not only through artefacts, but also through a multimedia production of the biblical narrative and with spaces that discuss the impact the Bible has had on the world through the ages.

Even though we live in a world of unlimited streaming, there are some things we just can't find on the Internet. Turning to museums to better understand events of today lets us not just sift through endless browser pages, but implant ourselves at the root of an issue and examine it from multiple angles. They offer insight on present-day issues, along with exhibits that are just plain fun and interesting.

Museums help us pause and look back amid a culture that is always looking ahead to the next innovation. That's exactly why we need more of them. ■

Before Starting awsuit over Social Media Post



I've spent time on this blog warning social media users about inappropriate posts. But should a church, non-profit, or company start a lawsuit over a critical social media post? According to recent news reports, employers are experiencing real challenges when they try to sue employees – even when those employees are critical of the companies they work for. Even when people Facebook or Twitter bad news about the organization, or get drunk and post something highly critical, it's very tough to pursue them in court. Even in the rare cases where a company wins, they usually lose the PR battle. In other words, in the social media world, tread very carefully.

It's the wild-west out there, with lots of potential minefields for organizations of all types. For instance, someone could potentially sue a boss for sexual harassment after he repeatedly tries to "friend" him or her on Facebook. Or employers might pull a job offer after learning personal information from an applicant's social media site. All kinds of things – religious affiliation, activism, political positions and more are suddenly in the public domain and bound to be seen by potential and current employers. But lawsuits against employees and others have proven to be very difficult to win. In a 2009 case, one company sued employees over comments on a social media page that they felt violated their core values. But not only did they lose, they were required to pay the employees thousands of dollars in damages.

My advice? First – get the right counsel from an attorney that understands social media, and advice from social media experts. It's tricky stuff, and the old rules about office behaviour don't necessarily apply.

Second, jump into the stream of social media yourself.

Learn the unwritten rules about online behaviour - what's considered personal, public, serious, and funny. Otherwise, you'll blunder into a huge (and expensive) misstep. It doesn't matter if you consider yourself a "traditional" media expert. Social media is turning everything on its head.

Finally - Understand that PR has changed in a digital age.

Often, traditional press releases don't make nearly the splash as blog posts or even Twitter posts. In a social media world, the nexus of influence is changing, and you need to stay on top of that change.
