editorial



FROM THE EDITOR

I was wondering the other day about how different our life experience would have been had we not been subjected to the consequences of sin. The Bible retells the story of man's transgression through disobedience and the subsequent closing of the garden. But what if it never happened?

For one thing we would still be frolicking naked in a lush garden, playing with lions and eagles, fed by God, walking with God, doing no work that would break a sweat and have all our children delivered pain-free. Sounds like paradise, doesn't it? Compare this idyllic picture with your every day life and the divide becomes a chasm that is impossible to span. A while back I watched the film "2012", and in it were some serious craters, fissures and tears in the crust of earth to remind me just how far these two worlds are separated from one another.

A striving after success drives the world we live in, and the culture of the day demands that we satisfy those needs. Most people go to work, not because they would love to go, but because they are driven there by fear. This fear finds its expression in relevant questions such as, "Will I have enough money to pay the bills?" and also in the more superficial, "I need a bigger car and better house." Fear of not being able to provide for our families will drive us to work, and once there, to succumb to the demands that "success" places on us.

This culture is supported and perpetuated by the media around us newspapers, television, billboards, flyers and peer pressure. I think of it as a "Media Culture". For me it refers to the constant pressure it places on us to have bodies that look a certain way, dress an acceptably labelled way, relax in a comfortable way, move itself around in fashionable transport, and rest itself in a suitable home. Branding has literally become the gospel to marketers around the globe – a product without branding is dead in the water.

Branding in itself isn't really the problem, but the associations that are made with it are. Some associations are obvious and in-your-face, while others slip through more unobtrusively. Be it from bikini-clad ladies lounging on the bonnet of the latest model car or motorbike, to innocuous looking cartoon characters that really are demons in disguise. The dangers of our media-saturated culture are real and we should be aware of them and take precaution.

Our striving after success will drive us from guru to therapist and back again; it will force us into behaviour patterns not consistent with those in Eden; it will make us living contestants in a Fear Factor show called life.

The truth is that while the gate to Eden is shut, the road to peace and tranquillity is still available – we read encouragement after encouragement and find ourselves uplifted in the pages of a living Word. And so it is possible for us to exchange fear for faith, and Earth for Eden (in a manner of speaking). Let us test the things our culture holds up as normal and acceptable in the light of our conscience and faith, and let us keep that which builds up peace and discard the seeds that produce a harvest of dread.



LIVING FULL, IN HIM

Life is for the Living! But, in this day and age, can we honestly believe that a good, fulfilled and peaceful life is attainable? With the daily pressures and escalating trouble people are facing, all over the world, and from all walks of life; can an excellent quality of life become our reality? Well, according to the Word of God, it most certainly can. In John 10:10, Jesus declares that the thief, being the devil, comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. But He, Jesus, came that we may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). Proverbs 3:2, promises a life that is well worth living and full of tranquillity, inward and out! Since we know the Word of God to be true, and that God is not a respecter of persons, there is no reason for us to believe otherwise.

To live a full, satisfied life that is productive and at the same time, full of peace and tranquillity, seems so idyllic! Yet, it's a promise the Lord Jesus has secured for every believer to enjoy, if we dare to open our lives to it.

How do we attain it? Well, since the circumstances of life are constantly changing, we can certainly agree that they cannot be recognised as our source of a good, peaceful life. After all, we all know that physical things and riches, while bringing temporary happiness, can never fulfil or completely satisfy the human soul. After all, the news feeds we read are full of stories of the rich and famous, who seemingly have all the things their hearts desire; ending their lives because of their desperate unhappiness. So since the source of true happiness goes deeper than what is on the surface, perhaps it's worth digging a little deeper to discover its mysteries. For example, complete surrender was Paul's key to a fulfilled life.

In my own searching, I have come to understand that to resolve our inner struggles and complete our quest for true happiness in life, as children of God, there must be a clear and accurate perspective of who we are in Christ Jesus. In the New Testament, the Apostle Paul confessed to have found the key to true fulfilment and the ultimate purpose of life. He believed it had everything to do with intimately knowing the person of Jesus Christ and the power of His resurrection (Philippians 3:10). He often linked this theory with the importance of dying to his own selfish nature, and absolutely surrendering his personal independence to God. He spoke about abandoning the idea of selfpreservation and instead, leaning and relying entirely on the trustworthy nature of God. Paul referred to a kind of life that is fully enveloped and given over to the complete love of God, and absolute devotion to Him. He spoke of our very identity being in Christ alone, and not in anything of ourselves. To me, that seems to mean a total yielding and deliberate turning away from self; and completely conforming to God's nature and character. I have to say, at first thought, this seems to kick against the core of who we are as individuals. What about that internal struggle for self-preservation and identity? Isn't that what has kept the human race in existence? Isn't that what causes those who are oppressed, to rise up and take dominion, instead of being dominated over?

Well, I have certainly given this much thought, and have consequently found, that when we, as individuals, really know the Lord, we see this concept of complete surrender, from a very different perspective. The more time we spend getting to know the Lord, in His Word and prayer; we begin to experience and enjoy His overwhelming, unconditional and absolute love for us. This love, is the game changer. It makes all the difference in how we perceive ourselves and our God. If we don't 'get' the love factor, we will always have a missing link when it comes to our walk of faith. Personally knowing and experiencing God's love for us is what fuels and sustains our beliefs. It crosses the bridge between a mechanical and clinical religion to a spontaneous and most satisfying relationship with God.

Like the Apostle Paul, I do believe the missing link to understanding the true meaning of absolute surrender to the person, nature and will of God, is LOVE itself. Love is what answers the question, why we should surrender all and completely sacrifice our own self-preservation, to become one with our Creator.



BETHEL MUSIC'S BRIAN & JENN JOHNSON AFTER ALL THESE YEARS

Brian & Jenn Johnson are co-founders of Dove Award winning Bethel Music, WorshipU, and have been integral in the production of more than 15 albums that have influenced the culture of worship across the global church.

More than 10 years since their last solo release, The Johnson's debuted their highly anticipated studio album After All These Years at the end of January 2017, capturing the wonder, conviction, and tenderness of heart behind the story of who they've become and who they've remained over the past season.

In addition to writing and recording songs for Bethel Music's compilations, their previous solo releases include live-worship albums Undone (2001) and We Believe (2006).

Each song reflects the seasoned journey of its writers and carries a message that the unseen history we build with God is the greatest treasure that sustains our lives personally, and from generation to generation. This 10 track album hit No. 1 on the iTunes Christian Albums chart. It has been applauded as "beautiful offerings of worship" and "sure to be one of the top worship albums of the year."

Stylistically, the album takes a distinct turn from anything Bethel Music has previously recorded; lush arrangements recorded by an 80-piece symphony orchestra are the hallmark of each track. In lyric and instrumentation, the project evokes a feeling of timelessness and unfettered hope.

A Q&A WITH GARY THOMAS

1. When did you first get the idea and prompting to write the book Cherish?

Not intending to sound too mystical, but I honestly believe the thought of focusing on "cherish" was a call from God. It dawned on me that though we pledge to "love and cherish" in our wedding vows (at least in the United States), 99.9% of marriage books focus on love, not on cherish. I lived with this idea and practice for a couple years in my own marriage and began writing down my thoughts when I saw the fruits.

2. Why do you think that the wedding vow "to cherish," isn't widely concentrated/focused on?

Love really is the backbone of marriage, so it's reasonable for us to focus on love. But love without cherish can become like a ballet that focuses on the strengths and athletics without the grace and beauty. We need to keep cherish in mind so that we don't lose the wonder of what God calls us to in marriage.

3. Do you believe that once a married couple truly knows how to cherish one another that there could be 100% healing after such devastation as an affair?

In the face of true repentance, yes. I just talked to a couple last week that overcame an affair. The wife told me that while they hate what happened and wish it hadn't happened, they also would never want to go back to what their marriage was like before the affair. In this instance, the

husband was really and truly repentant and was duly accountable, and cherishing was thus an appropriate and effective remedy to rebuild their marriage.

The reality is, we all want to be cherished, and we all want to cherish the one we marry. When that happens it can create an entirely new marriage. In the book, I tell the story of a man who was married to a woman who died of cancer. He then remarried a second wife who also died of cancer. Terry tells me his second marriage was much richer than his first not because his second wife was more excellent than his first wife—he doesn't believe that at all—but because his attitude in his second marriage was so different. In the second marriage, he learned to cherish his wife and it made all the difference. It led him to a much closer, happier, and more fulfilling marriage.

4. Can you share an incredible testimony from one of your readers of their marriage being healed?

I think the one that moved me most was when a couple lifted up their baby and said, "We call her our 'sacred marriage baby." The wife had decided she wanted a divorce and had procured an apartment to move to. The husband went to his pastor, who gave him a copy of Sacred Marriage. As the wife was packing her things, she knocked her husband's copy of Sacred Marriage onto the floor and it landed face up. She read the subtitle, "What if God designed marriage to make us holy more than to make us

happy?" and was intrigued enough to begin reading.

Several hours later, she woke her husband up and said she wanted to give their marriage another try. She never moved out, eventually got pregnant, and that's the baby they showed to me. They told me, "This little girl would never have been born if we hadn't read your book."

5. Is there a short answer to the difference between actions to love & to cherish?

This might not be a short answer, but it helps to examine how the Bible defines "love" in 1 Corinthians 13 and compare that with the concept of cherishing in Song of Songs:

Love is about being gracious and altruistic. "Love is patient, love is kind." (1 Cor. 13:4) Cherish is about being enthusiastic and enthralled. "How much more pleasing is your love than wine, and the fragrance of your perfume more than any spice." (Song of Songs 4:10)

Love tends to be quiet and understated. "(Love) does not envy, it does not boast." (1 Cor. 13:4)

Cherish boasts boldly and loudly: "My beloved is radiant and ruddy, outstanding among ten thousand." (Song of Songs 5:10)

Love thinks about others with selflessness. "Love is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking." (1 Cor. 13:4-5)

Cherish thinks about its beloved with praise. "Your voice is sweet and your face is lovely." (Song of Songs 2:14)

Love doesn't want the worst for someone: "Love does not delight in evil." (1 Cor. 13:6)

Cherish celebrates the best in someone: "How beautiful you are, my darling! Oh, how beautiful!" (Song of Songs 1:15)

Love puts up with a lot: "(Love) always hopes, always perseveres." (1 Cor. 13:7)

Cherish enjoys a lot. "His mouth is sweetness itself; he is altogether lovely." (Song of Songs 5:16)

Love is about commitment. "Love endures all things. Love never fails" (1 Cor. 13:7-8; ESV)

Cherish is about delight and passion. "Your name is like perfume poured out." (Song of Songs 1:3)

Love and cherish never compete—they complement each other and even complete each other.

6. Where is your favourite place to write?

My office, preferably with a cup of chai tea nearby.

7. Have you any advice to aspiring authors wanting to tackle the marriage theme?

One of the greatest challenges is that there are so many books out there on marriage that you need to find a distinct voice and purpose. Sacred Marriage was different due in part to my limitations—I'm not a trained therapist so I couldn't write another "how to" book. Instead, I explored how God uses marriage to shape us spiritually. I'm asked to endorse many books and the main problem is that so many try to be a "one size fits all" marriage book: they contain a chapter on communication, finances, spiritual intimacy, sex, conflict, etc. The problem is, I feel like I've read those books/chapters dozens of time. Find a unique angle—something that hasn't been addressed—and bring your unique voice to it.

8. Who is your greatest critic?

Myself.

9. Which authors do you love to read?

I love to read the Christian classics: Calvin, Francis de Sales, John Owen, Pascal, Brother Lawrence, Fenelon, William Law, Jonathan Edwards, John Wesley, C.S. Lewis, Tozer, and many others. For contemporary writers, I'm a big fan of N.T. Wright and John Ortberg.

10. Do you believe knowing your spouse's love language will enable you to cherish your spouse in a specific way suitable to them?

Yes. I believe the 5 Love Languages can be a very helpful and effective way to cherish your spouse. Cherishing is all about the "particular." It means different things to different spouses. If you want your spouse to feel cherished, you need to find out what makes them feel cherished.

11. Can you describe one or two practical ways that you, Gary, cherish your wife Lisa?

Here's the foreword Lisa wrote that might answer this in her own words:

I know what it feels like to be cherished.

A warm hand covering my cheek, maybe with a little eye contact

A gentle back rub

A cup of coffee by my bedside when I wake up in a hotel room

Words of affirmation, beyond what I deserve, sometimes even spoken in a room full of strangers

A hand pressed on the small of my back

A gas tank that remains miraculously full

Soft words when a harsh response might have been justifiable

Some of these things might make you feel annoyed rather than cherished! Cherishing takes on different forms for each of us, but for me, it is the little acts that leave me feeling adored, safe, worth the effort.

Just hearing the word cherish makes me want to hug Gary, give him a kiss on the cheek, and say thank you.

12. What have you learnt the most about your marriage after publishing your first marriage book?

A good marriage takes a lot of work, but it's worth the work. To be married and not work on your marriage often leads to misery. If you do the work to grow your marriage, the effort will repay you tenfold. A happy, close and intimate mar-


riage is one of the best gifts in life.

13. In summary, what do you believe is the power of Cherish?

Cherishing teaches us to rely upon God and to prize our spouse in a way we never have before. When a spouse is cherished, the environment is set for him/her to grow in their beauty and excellence. Cherishing can be chosen and learned, and cherishing really can transform a good marriage into a great one, and a frustrating marriage into a satisfying one.

14. Are you writing another book now, can you share a sneak peek with us?

Yes, I'm working on a devotional to help engaged couples get spiritually prepared before their wedding day.



MEDITATION

If we look in the Word of God in 1 Timothy 4:15(NKJV) Paul tells Timothy, "Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all."

When we meditate we have an opportunity to digest what God is trying to tell us. I would call it; one of the disciplines that the church is not majoring on in these days. It is evident by the way in which we see so many believers, who are not totally convinced about the fundamentals of God's Holy Word.

When we meditate on The Word of God there can be no doubt about what God means when it comes to Bible principles. For example John 14:6 (NKJV) Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." Now if you meditate on that scripture, you will see that it is impossible to agree with the interfaith people who say that all roads lead to heaven, if you don't meditate on that scripture and you "speed read," than you will overlook the importance of the fact that there is only one God. Speed reading is a clever technique to get lots of work done, but to extract deep nourishment we need to read slowly. If you and I say that we do not have time anymore to meditate, we are in deep trouble.

Vance Harner said, "When we are too busy to sharpen the axe, then we are too busy." Abraham Lincoln the very famous US president came from the country. He would win all the agricultural competitions and shows. He was a tall, strongly built man. They said that when he took off his top

hat and his tails, he would roll up his sleeves, take an axe and beat everybody at splitting wood. They once asked him, "If you had 6 hours to cut down a large tree, how would you go about it?" He said, "I would send the first 4 hours sharpening the axe."

Some of us have problems with our memory, especially as we grow older, and especially when it comes to memorising Bible scriptures. The great theologian Matthew Henry said "Meditation is the best help to memory."

I often have people write to me and they would say they have a problem with different temptations in their lives. Some tell me they have a problem with lust and yet they continue to engage in pornographic material. Josiah Holland said, "The mind grows on what it feeds on." If we cannot meditate on God's Word we leave the door wide open for all kinds of temptations from the world to enter in. So we need to start, not only to read the Bible slowly, but most of all to meditate on the words that we read.

Remember that all work and no play makes Jack a dull boy. If we cannot give ourselves time to systematic meditation on God's Word we will never grow in the Kingdom of God. We will become standard Christians, who bring no glory to Jesus Christ.

May God bless you as you start to discipline yourself and meditate regularly on God's Word regularly. ■



YOUR EMOTIONAL HEALTH: GOOD FRUIT OR BAD ROOT?

Are you emotionally healthy? It seems there are a lot of people who aren't, and I used to be one of them. Because I grew up in a very unstable, angry atmosphere and was abused by my father for years, I became a miserable, angry, controlling adult and didn't know how to have healthy relationships. And until I learned how to grow in my relationship with Christ, I was a mess in my soul.

Many people have wounds in their soul because of things that have happened to them. They've been abused or mistreated and it's caused them to have a victim mentality, to get stuck in self-pity, to have an out-of-control temper or a constant sense of insecurity, and so on. When we have unhealthy emotions, and the bad behavior that comes as a result of it, we have to get to the root of the issue to fix it.

Matthew 12:33 (NLT) says, "A tree is identified by its fruit. If a tree is good, its fruit will be good. If a tree is bad, its fruit will be bad." In other words, where there's rotten fruit, there's a rotten root!

I remember years ago when I would complain to Dave, saying, "We don't talk about anything!" Finally, one day Dave said to me, "You know, Joyce, WE don't talk. YOU talk and you want me to listen and agree with you." He was right! Whenever I would share an opinion about something with Dave, if he didn't agree with me, the fight was on!

We would get into these big arguments and I would end up so confused, thinking, "I don't even know what we're talking about anymore!" The really frustrating thing was I didn't understand what my problem was, so I just kept blaming it all on Dave.

When we don't take responsibility for our problems, we blame them on someone or something else. But when I finally got to the point where I was sick and tired of arguing with Dave all the time, I prayed for God to show me what was wrong. He answered my prayer and revealed that I had a root of rejection in my soul from the way I was raised, and until that root was dealt with, the fruit (or behavior) in my life would never change.

When you're afraid of rejection, if people don't agree with you, you feel rejected by them. So when Dave and I were trying to have a conversation, if he didn't agree with me, I felt that he was rejecting me.

The truth is when Dave had a different opinion, he wasn't rejecting me; he was rejecting my opinion. And I had to learn to separate who I am from my opinion and trust that whether or not he liked my opinion, he still loved me!

It was a major breakthrough for me to get this revelation. Through this situation I learned how to be a person who is loved and valued by God, because of what Jesus has done for me, and to separate my "who" from my "do." It took some time and I had to be determined to trust God's Word, which says He loves me unconditionally and nothing can separate me from His love, but eventually, I became secure in knowing who I am in Christ.

I want to ask you again: Are you emotionally healthy? Are you dealing with a root of rejection in your life? Is there a person in your life that you can't talk to without getting upset or losing your temper? When someone disagrees with you does it make you feel insulted, stupid, rejected, or disrespected? If this is you, then you need to know that God doesn't want you to live this way.

In Ephesians 3, the apostle Paul prayed for the Ephesians: "That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God" (vv. 17-19, NIV).

This is my prayer for you—that you would be planted deep in the knowledge that God loves you unconditionally and know that, while He may not always love

everything you do, He always loves you! I also want to encourage you to spend time every day alone with God in prayer and study the Word. Dig in to scriptures about the love of God and choose to trust that every one of those promises is for you.

The truth is: You are loved and you are valuable to God!.



WHAT TO DO WHEN PEOPLE REJECT YOUR IDEAS

If you're a creative person, at some point you'll find a boss, investor, studio, or colleague who rejects your ideas. Sometimes it will happen so often you'll start to question your own ability, and wonder if you're really creative at all. In these moments (which will definitely come) my advice is:

Never base your creativity on other people's opinions of your ideas.

Early in my career I worked with a boss who disliked so many of my ideas he eventually fired me. Low and behold, I discovered other clients were willing pay me to execute the very ideas he hated! It reminded me about Walt Disney being fired by a newspaper editor because, "he lacked imagination and had no good ideas."

Years later, I had a few friends that asked me for advice about their careers. But they simply refused to listen to any advice – solicited or unsolicited. It was incredibly frustrating because those simple ideas could have made a profound difference for them. But time after time, they used excuses like "I'm simply wired differently," or "You don't understand this particular situation." The truth is, they weren't willing to

put in the discipline and hard work of making those ideas happen.

But rather than be discouraged I simply launched a blog and started pouring that advice into it. And that's a big reason I launched what you're reading now.

After his first book – the iconic thriller *Carrie* – received 30 rejections, writer Stephen King finally gave up and literally tossed it in the trash. But his wife fished it out and encouraged him to resubmit it. He finally found that person who recognized the value of the idea, and the rest is history. Today, he's one of the best-selling authors of all time.

So don't be discouraged. When your ideas are rejected, write them down, keep them nearby, and sooner or later the right person, project, or situation will come along.

Is life, your job, or your career stressing you out? If you're trying to accomplish anything with your life, and you were honest, I'll bet you'd admit to being stressed out at least some of the time. In fact, you may be stressed out pretty much ALL the time. So if stress is a bigger and bigger part of your life, then here's one important thing you need to learn: The greatest key to beating stress is to control the things you can. The truth is, we often allow simple things that we can control to get away from us. And when we start harnessing those things once again, the stress equation dramatically changes.

Certainly we can't control airline schedules, client behavior, the weather, unexpected events, difficult co-workers, or other things out of our influence. But there are plenty of things we can control, and when we do, those issues start making a much smaller impact. For instance, we can control our sleep schedule, and science has proven that simply getting enough sleep will dramatically change our attitude and productivity. We can control showing up late, and that issue alone will reduce enormous stress.


We can control how we respond to a crisis, how often we exercise, quiet times, our spiritual life, and our attitude about work. When you stop and think about it, you have far more control over life than you think.

The bottom line is that far too often, we give up controlling things we have power over, and when that happens, our personal stress levels escalate.


That is why we are always able to put our hope and trust in Him and know without a doubt that He will never fail. ■

INTERNATIONALLY RENOWNED WORSHIP LEADER DARLENE ZSCHECH RELEASES LIVE CD/DVD, "HERE I AM, SEND ME THIS MARCH"

Renowned worship leader, author and pastor Darlene Zschech releases the Here I Am Send Me (Hineni) CD/DVD globally on March 3 from Integrity Music. Recorded live with her team at Hope Unlimited Church on the Central Coast of New South Wales, Australia, the album is Zschech's first project following a life changing cancer diagnosis in 2014 and features 11 new songs penned by her along with guest writers like Martin Smith, Paul Baloche, Jenn Johnson and Leeland Mooring.

Here I Am Send Me is also Zschech's first new album since 2013's critically acclaimed Revealing Jesus. Produced by Andy Mak, the new recording opens with a full-on declaration of the greatness of God in the song "You Are Great" written with Martin Smith (Delirious?) in response to the most challenging season of her life.

"When I was at my sickest, Martin flew over from England to sit with us, sing songs over our church, and walk and talk with me and my husband, all the while speaking courage into us," Zschech says, her voice full of emotion recalling the dark days after her diagnosis of breast cancer that is now in remission. "It's week one of treatment and you feel like

you're going to die, and Martin said, 'Darls, I know you're going to want to write songs about this season. What do you want to say?' And I said, 'I want to say 'HE IS GREAT!' And so we wrote this song together and have been singing it in our church. That's where it started... In the midst of the fire, it doesn't change who our God is."

"Cancer is a dreadful thing," continues Zschech. "The medical world doesn't like to use the word 'healed.' They like to say the word 'remission'... but I'm believing God's report over my life. I speak Psalm 91 over myself every day, I take my medicine and I take the word of God and I do my best with what I can do in the natural and trust God with those things over which I have no power."

Following this opening track, the album proceeds to take listeners through a journey declaring God's greatness, love and call, and gives worshippers a voice of response, as in the song, "You Will Be Praised." Written with Baloche and Johnson upon Zschech's first return to America after cancer treatment, the song unabashedly declares the power of the Holy Spirit living among us that makes fearlessness possible in every season and circumstance of life. It is, in many ways, her testimony.



The album also features "Beloved," a modern hymn of surrender co-written by Zschech with Mooring and Casey Moore. Other standouts include "Love and Wonder," written by the Zschech's teen daughter, Zoe, and Bonnie Gray from Hope UC, "Kingdom Come," co-written with Thomas Macken and reflecting a year-long teaching theme at the church and "Go," written with Andy Mak, that closes the album.

This closing song of commissioning is a message that will be sensed throughout the project by listeners, including in the song from which the title track was gleaned. "Here I Am Send Me' was written following the revelation I received from Genesis 22, which is when Abraham responds to God in worship by saying 'Hineni,' meaning, 'here I am Lord, whatever you ask, before you ask, my answer is yes'," says Zschech.


"None of us know how many days we have," continues Zschech. "Whatever days I have—and I'm declaring a ripe old age—I want to live them intentionally. I want to live the love of Christ...


