As believers in a fallen word, we are involved in fighting the good fight of faith, every single day. Each circumstance we face demands a response from us, and our response pretty much determines the end result. Either we face the challenge with godly discernment, following the leading of the Holy Spirit within us, which will pave the way for victory and success. Or, we face the challenge with a reaction based on our emotions, of shock and hurt, fear or anger, or sometimes, just plain fatigue. This kind of reaction never brings the desired result, instead, it just heaps on more trouble, making the problem far more complicated than when it began. That's why being able to discern God's wisdom in every circumstance, over and above our warring emotions is key!

Now since godly discernment is being able to perceive and understand God's perfect will concerning a situation, we should probably pay attention to sharpening that spiritual skill as our choice weapon of combat in our fight of faith.

The Bible often refers to our spirit man needing good, disciplined training and exercise. In fact, it clearly states that without it, we simply won't get to the place where our spirit man is strong or dominant enough to take and keep control over our human nature. In other words, we really have to train our spiritual senses to dominate our emotions, especially when the going gets tough and our feelings can easily spiral out of control, confusing us to the point where we don't know what God's will is in the matter anymore.

Hebrews 5:14 says we can train our senses to discern between good and evil. What it means is that we can train our senses to perceive and understand what is good (of God) and what is evil (of the enemy) as easily as if it was second nature to us.

How do we go about training our senses to do this? Through spiritual exercise!

You see, anyone who wants to get into good spiritual shape has to be diligent to exercise himself spiritually. This is why the apostle Paul told Timothy, in 1 Timothy 4:7, to exercise himself unto godliness.

The word "exercise" is the Greek word gumnos, and is literally translated naked. You see, Paul was describing how the athletes of that time used to train naked, having nothing around their bodies that would hinder them or trip them up while they were training.

Paul was telling Timothy that to become spiritually fit and skilled in discernment, he had to strip himself of all mentalities and thought process that would hinder his growth and development in the Lord.

Paul knew that if Timothy stripped wrong attitudes from his life and approached challenges with the right attitude: The hardships he faced wouldn't hurt him but rather would assist in developing him and making him stronger. The only way we can strip ourselves of incorrect thought processes and attitudes is by habitually meditating on the Word of God! We have to renew our minds to think God's thoughts and have His perspectives – instead of our own.

When Paul said, "...exercise thyself rather unto godliness." The word "godliness" is the Greek word that describes piety, godliness, or a radical, fanatical devotion. In other words, Paul was telling Timothy, "Don't do just the average that others would do and get an average result. Put your whole heart and soul into developing yourself to the maximum level."

By purposefully, wholeheartedly, and habitually meditating on the Word of God, praying in the Spirit, and spending time fellowshipping with the Lord, we train our senses to discern what is of God and what is not. We become so familiar with what God's heart and thoughts are that we easily hear and recognise the voice and leading of the Holy Spirit inside of us.

Let's not put this 'resolution' off any longer! Daily spiritual exercise in the word of God will bring our lives into submission to the Spirit and have our senses trained and in fine tune to the voice of God. This way we will be able to clearly hear His wisdom, over and above any other voice of reason or confusion. And when we pay attention to that wisdom, peace and joy flood our hearts and minds, giving us the assurance we need to go ahead and act on that wisdom and obey what it tells us to do. Choosing God's wisdom above all other reasoning always positions us for success and victory, because its supernatural power will cause every natural obstacle to fall in line with the will of God.

Make the choice today to step into this spiritual training program, where our senses will be fine-tuned and skilled to discern God's wisdom all the time!

e all have the same amount of time – 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. And the longer I live, the more I discover that time is too valuable for us to waste any of it. That's why it is so important that we learn to live *on purpose, for a purpose.*

The truth is if you make wise decisions now, you will have a better future. But if you waste your time now, you will have regrets. And regrets are terrible because you can't go back and do anything about them.

That's why we need to do the right thing when we have the opportunity to do it instead of blaming our circumstances or how we were raised or how the world is for the way that we live. We can learn how to co-operate with God and make changes that will make something good happen in our lives.

ARE YOU A PARTICIPATOR OR SPECTATOR?

Ephesians 3:20 is an exciting verse people like because it says God *"is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly more than all that we dare ask or think [infinitely beyond our greatest prayers, hopes, or dreams]"*(AMP). But if we stop there, we don't fully see what this scripture is saying. It goes on to say *"according to His power that is at work within us."*

God is able to do great things as His power works *in* us and *through* us! So it's not just about God doing things *for* you – He wants to do things *through* you. We are meant to be partners with God who participate in His plans, not merely spectators.

We have to stop wishing life would change and start taking action! We need to pray, spend time with God and study His Word, and as He speaks to our hearts, we need to step out in faith. I want to encourage you not to let fear keep you from moving forward. If you are afraid of making the wrong choice, then make a determined decision to take a step of faith – do it afraid! – and trust God to show you if you're going in the wrong direction. Because sometimes we can't find out what the right direction is until we step out and find out.

PARTICIPATE WITH PRUDENCE.

In Proverbs 1:1-5, we learn some of the main ways we hear God's voice as we seek Him. Verse 4 says, *"That prudence (good judgment, astute common sense) may be given..."* (AMP).

The Merriam-Webster online dictionary defines prudence as: "the ability to govern and discipline oneself by the use of reason; shrewdness in the management of affairs; skill and good judgment in the use of resources.¹ A prudent person is disciplined and a good manager. He won't waste his money, time, energy, talents or his words." We see this in the following scriptures:

- Proverbs 10:19 says the prudent person "controls his lips and keeps thoughtful silence."
- Proverbs 12:16 teaches that "the [arrogant] fool's anger is quickly known [because he lacks self-control and common sense], but a prudent man ignores an insult."
- And Proverbs 31:16 describes the prudent woman as one who carefully considers new opportunities before making a decision and uses her time in ways that benefit her.

These are just a few verses that reveal ways you can be prudent. I want to encourage you to study them and look up others that will help you get more revelation of how you can be prudent.

ARE YOU BUSY OR FRUITFUL?

God created you to live on purpose, for a purpose! He has not called you to be busy – He has called you to bear good fruit! He's given you free will so you can make good choices in every single area of your life.

It's easy to get caught up in the busyness of everyday life in the world we live in today. We all need to take time on a regular basis to think about how we're spending our time so we can evaluate whether we're being fruitful and making progress in the things we should be doing.

I like to do this before I go to bed at night. I think through the things I did that day to see what I accomplished. Doing this helps me discover anything that caused me to waste time and lose my focus on the things I needed to do.

Take time to honestly examine the way you're spending your time. Pray and ask God to reveal things that need to change, ways you can make better choices that line up with His wisdom, and then lean on Him for the strength to make changes. You'll find that as you make choices guided by the Spirit of God, you won't end up with regrets—you'll be fulfilled, peaceful and excited about how He is working in your life!

His name was William Carey. He fulfilled his vision and as a result multitudes of people in India, the most populous country in the world, can read about Jesus Christ in their own language. Follow your dream.

I meet a lot of people who are very down hearted at the moment, because of the current situation in the Country, in fact the situation in the world at large. How to Share Your Faith on Social Media BY PHIL COOKE

Social media is powerful. Recently journalists lost their jobs over their reckless use of words on social media. I have watched leaders bring pain to people by posting their opinion on social media

I find it fascinating that many people who handle social media for very large churches and ministries find it difficult to share their faith on their personal SM platforms. And others do it in an incredibly obnoxious way. But every new technology gives us another possibility for telling the greatest story ever told, but we have to do it with honesty and sincerity.

Krysta Masciale, CEO of Big Deal Branding puts it this way: "For me, it's important that I share as much on social media as I would in person. Since I don't speak about my faith until I've gained trust and been given permission to do so in a relationship, I use that same philosophy with my SM accounts. Also, know your audience. If Christians follow you and are expecting spiritual insights, GIVE IT TO THEM. If not, be aware that you're building a relationship, not trying to sell a car."

Krysta is exactly right. So I asked Kristen Tarsiuk, Creative Director + Community Pastor at Liberty Church Brooklyn to give us some suggestions about sharing our faith without screwing up the message. Here's her tips: Social media can be an extremely powerful tool, or noise. It can be a communication channel where we share our humanity encountering Christ, or it can be a polished pic from the platform. Social media can be a celebration of the goodness of God, or a "look how good I look" selfie. The choice is always ours. Here are three tips on how to share your faith on social media authentically.

1. Be relatable

As a pastor and creative director, I could post pics of creative meetings or me working on my message. My journey as a pastor, though unique, is significantly less relatable to most people. So for the past two years, I have chosen to share my journey of faith as a mom on social media.

It never fails, each week the posts I share of my son are conversation starters with other moms in my neighbourhood and church. It opens the door for trust and connection, and ultimately me sharing my reliance on Jesus, or an invitation to church.

Ask yourself, is what I am sharing relatable to non-believers? Not every post needs to point to the Gospel, but think about the story you are telling.

2. Post the pain

Don't be afraid to share those less than perfect moments of life, especially the ones when you personally need God to show up. Christians suffer. Non-believers suffer. Pain and suffering are a universal experience.

A few months ago my 3-year-old son had bladder surgery for a condition he has had since birth. My husband and I utilized our social feeds to share our journey. In post-op recovery we did a "Praise God – this journey is over!" type of post, thanking God for His goodness and faith-fulness.

A few hours after arriving home (off the high of the Praise God post), Rocco's temperature sky-rocketed, and we found ourselves headed back to Children's Hospital. So at 2am we shared our pain and asked for prayers. At 3am, the fever broke. Then what we thought would be a couple day recovery, turned into weeks, with multiple posts saying things still aren't working.

I remember thinking, I don't want to be Debbie the Downer. Do people really want to know about my son's bladder? To my surprise they did. When we shared updates on social media, both our Christian and non-Christian friends would reach out letting us know we were in their thoughts and prayers. And when we shared the good news that Rocco was healed – both are Christians and non-Christian friends celebrated with us.

Be humble and human. Share the less than perfect moments of life. Our weaknesses are the perfect platforms for God's strength. Share that story.

3. Remember someone is always listening

The Apostle Paul wrote, "I have the right to do anything," you say—but not everything is beneficial. "I have the right to do anything"—but not everything is constructive. No one should seek their own good, but the good of others. – 1Corinthians 10:23-24 (NIV)

Yes, we have the right to emotionally process on social media. But is it beneficial? Yes, we can post selfies and polished pics of ourselves. But is it constructive?

Social media is powerful. Recently journalists lost their jobs over their reckless use of words on social media. I have watched leaders bring pain to people by posting their opinion on social media – not understanding the weight of the conversation they entered, or the hashtag they used. As believers, we are called to be a light. It is so important that we think before we post. Don't lose your testimony over a hashtag or a flippant tweet. Ask yourself, is this for the good of others, or am I just venting? Delete the vent, post the good.

I encourage all of us to use social media as a tool to share our faith. Be relatable. Share your humanity. Think before you post – because someone is always listening.



Three Things You Need When **Filming on Location**

Over the years, I've produced and directed programming on location in more than 50 countries around the world. For everyone that spends lots of time on a film or video set – particularly in far away places – there are certain things you just don't leave behind. Novices could do well to learn what more experienced filmmakers consider "must have" items during a shoot. For me? The top 3 would probably be my laptop (I'm always writing), a raincoat, and a great bag. In fact, I'm a little obsessive about bags and have way more than I should. But on location, a bag is my office, so I'm not afraid to spend money for one that does what I need. So I asked some other experienced professionals what were the top 3 absolutely "must have" items they take to every location. Here's a few answers:

From Stu Hazeldine, Director of the upcoming feature film "The Shack:"

☑ Script in a leather binder.☑ Director's Viewfinder.☑ Blundstone boots.

From Lisa Swain, formerly Production Coordinator on films like "Big Fish," "Anger Management," and "Face/Off" and now Associate Professor of

☑ Sharpie.☑ Swiss Army pocket knife.☑ Chapstick.

Cinema at Biola University:

From Korey Pollard, Assistant Director of "House," "Grey's Anatomy," "Nashville," "CSI," and "Monk:"

Charlie Peacock's West Coast Diaries.

And when I asked Ralph Winter, Producer of films like "X-Men," "Wolverine," "Planet of the Apes," and the upcoming "The Promise," and "Altered Carbon" from Netflix, he couldn't stick to 3 items, but since he produces \$100 million plus movies in all kind of challenging conditions, I let him explain:

From years of traveling, I build several "go" bags, that are always ready. Probably too much to explain here. But for instance:

⊠ Snow bag: heavy gear, sweat shirts, sweaters, hats, gloves, boots, various levels of socks, scarves, etc. Hockey size bag, good to −20 degrees. Ready for Fedx with manifest to any country.

☑ Computer gear: backup laptop updated exact copy of working laptop; backup drives (3); various cables, power supply for apartment, office, trailer; Apple TV; older but spare Apple Extreme for use in apartment; Blu-ray NTSC drive with USB for laptop (otherwise a problem in countries like Spain, which are PAL); computer repair tools (several packets).

☑ Phone gear: separate iPhone 6+ for local sim card (everything else syncs with iCloud and iTunes); phone repair tools and various covers.

☑ Passport, Global Entry, Nexus cards; local currency which I have built up over the years; never know when you need cash for taxi, or a favour.

⊠ Reduce wallet size: I take only specific credits cards that I will use on location, leaving others at home so they don't get lost. Cards in my wallet I make of and keep copy in office and home, in case of loss.

Always carry a pocket knife (good site for this is www.everydaycarry. com) but this is in packed luggage of course, along with cigar lighter, cutter, etc.

THE HABIT OF ALL

was reflecting on my own penchant to fall into all kinds of habits, and at first I thought I was unique in this, until I realized that all people are creatures of habit. This is not simply because we choose certain habits (although this is true), but really, just the way we were made. From birth to our death we are creatures of habit. In fact, it was Moses who recorded (by divine inspiration) the conversation in heaven where God decided to make people in His image and after His likeness. So, my reasoning says that if I know a little bit about God, I will also know a little bit about myself. Obviously, the more I get to know God, the more I get to know myself.

God is a God of habit. Many people in the past and present, have made the statement (after getting to know God), that He has always been, still is, and will forever be the same – He doesn't change. So what habits of God do I know about? Well, for one, He has the habit of being kind, good and loving. He has the habit of doing good. He has the habit of constantly seeking out my company. He has the habit of being just and fair. And He has the habit of displaying grace in His dealings with me. People form habits, and as I've said, some are good and some are bad. The habit of eating is good since it keeps us alive, but at the same time we can form bad eating habits that will speed our death. Some stuff is outright bad for eating and will cause instantaneous death, preventing us from forming a habit with that! Many habits are destructive to our bodies, but then there are the habits that are destructive to our spirit and soul, and these effect the people around us, and ultimately our own future. It is for this reason that God encourages all people to follow His habits, and He even took the time to have His bestseller, The Book Of Habits, written for us. Habitual anger, resentment, taking offense and unforgiveness are a few habits that will kill our spirit, deaden our perception and destroy our passion. Habitual peace, joy, gentleness and love, on the other hand, will revive our spirit and have a positive outflow in our body.

It would make sense therefore, that every now and then we take stock of the habits we have surrounded ourselves with, especially those habits we have come to regard as friends. Are they really friends? Are they really good for us? Do we really benefit from having them around? Then, after taking stock, make the decision for some Spring cleaning where needed, and rid ourselves of those who turn out to be unfriendly, ungainly and ultimately unwanted.

Let us get into the habit of examining our habits and clear out decisively those that hamper our vision and passion. Let us cultivate new habits that will encourage our creativity, energize our vigor, and regenerate our passion for life! Someone once said that first we make our habits, and then our habits make us! Success or failure? Which do you want? The philosopher Aristotle remarked, "We are what we repeatedly do. Excellence, then, is not an act but a habit."

'Excerpt from: "The Azusa Street Revival" by Roberts Liardon – P.204-205

"Although he (Lake) founded a number of institutions, they never gained the widespread prominence of other similar ministries. His daughter, Gertrude, and her husband, WilfordReidt, carried on his ministry until late in their lives when they officially passed the ministry to a young minister named Curry Blake. Blake had been run over by a car as a baby, but while in the hospital, his mother prayed for him and he miraculously recovered with barely any sign of what was thought to be a life-threatening injury. Unknown to the Blake family at the time, this event occurred exactly 25 years after Lake had given a prophecy about a successor who would come 25 years later. Blake has begun to rebuild Lake's ministries and vision. Many claim Lake as a spiritual influence, but Blake's success in the healing ministry, as well as the extent of his vision of Christianity is uniquely reminiscent of Lake himself."

Born April 1, 1959 in Jasper, TX. At 17 months of age Curry was hit by an automobile in the driveway of his grandparent's home. Curry's father did not see him as he was backing out. The car ran over his head, ripping his right ear off. The car's wheel pinched his scalp to the point that it ripped from his right ear to his left ear. This ripping caused his scalp to be pulled down across his forehead to the top of his eyes.

Curry's grandfather came out of the house, picked Curry up, picked up his ear, put him in his truck and drove him to the hospital. The doctor's told Curry's mother to buy a casket and plan his funeral because there was no way he could survive such extensive brain damage.

Curry's mother, a Pentecostal, began to pray. She told God that if He would spare Curry's life, she would raise him and train him to serve Him. The doctors came out of surgery to tell her that if he lived, he would be completely handicapped and that someone would have to care for him the rest of his life. The doctors went back to surgery and Curry's mother went back to praying. This time she said, "God, if you're going to let him live, then heal him completely."

After some time, the doctors returned saying, "Well, we can't find any signs of brain damage, but, if he lives and even if he doesn't have any brain damage, he will never have any hair and he will never hear out of his right ear." Once again his mother began praying. She told God, that if He was going to let Curry live, that he would be of no use to Him unless he was completely healed.

Today, Curry is totally and perfectly healed. He has at least an average IQ and a full head of hair and perfect hearing in both ears. At 17 years of age, Curry enlisted in the U.S. Air Force as a Security Police, Law Enforcement Specialist.

During his term of enlistment, God began to deal with him about answering the call to ministry. After some time he decided to go with his heart. He began to pray about being released from his enlistment contract. Within 3 days, Curry was called to the C.O's office, where he was informed that there were too many Security Police at that time and that he had a choice of either changing fields or receiving an Honorable Discharge with full G.I. benefits. Curry took the latter. After his discharge, Curry went home to share the news with his father and mother that he was going to preach. When he told them what had happened, his parents told him how he had been given to God 17 years earlier. He had known about the accident, and how God had delivered him, but he had not known about his mother's dedicating him to God. Within 1 year he was married and had a child on the way.

By 1983 Curry and his wife had 3 children. Over the years, God has done many wonderful things in the Blake's lives. Below are just a few of them. Curry's father, Johny F. Blake, has been a Police Officer, Narcotics Detective, Chief of Police, and an Internal Affairs Officer with The State of Texas Department of Corrections.

Today, Curry's father is a saved, spirit-filled, man of God.
