There were just too many choices! No matter what grocery item I needed, there were rows and rows of variations to choose from. Right there and then I decided to do my homework on each brand before I did my next trip to the grocery store. This way I would eliminate the frustration of having to read all the labelling and save so much time. So I began to ask some of my friends about the products and read up on them. Once I became knowledgeable about the items, I was able to make good choices when I shopped again. The funny thing about grocery shopping though is that there are always new products that pop up on the shelves. So you never stop having to inform yourself about them in order to make the best choices.

I believe this principle carries true in our every day lives. From the time we open our eyes in the morning, till we close them again at night, we have to make choices. And every choice we make has a consequence.

The Bible teaches us that even our thoughts are governed by choice. We may not be responsible for every thought that pops into our minds but we certainly have the responsibility to choose what to do with each thought. 2 Corinthians 1:5 clearly instructs us on what to do with thoughts that don't line up with the character of God and the truth of His Word: "...refute arguments and theories and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God; and lead every thought and purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One)"

The thoughts we continuously choose to allow our minds to entertain and meditate on, are the thoughts that will shape and influence our belief systems. In fact, the way we choose to think, will determine the life choices we make. That's why the Word says, in Proverbs 23:7, "As a man thinks in his heart, so is he."

If anyone in the Bible knew the importance of making the correct choices in life, especially in the area of his thoughts, Joshua did. He had to make some very important choices that would affect the very survival of the Israelite nation. When Moses, his predecessor died, Joshua had to fill some mighty big shoes and lead millions of people into their destiny. No wonder he was terrified at the very thought of the task. But the Lord spoke to Joshua and gave him the blueprint to guide him in every choice and decision he would ever have to make in life. We read about it in Joshua 1:8. God told Joshua to take the book of the law, which is the Word of God, and be sure to familiarise himself with everything it taught. He was to fill his mind with its wisdom and never stop meditating on it. He had to be sure that every word he spoke was in character with that wisdom and never contrary to its truth. And then he was to appropriate what the word instructed him to do. God promised Joshua, that if he followed these instructions he would not only prosper, but he would have good success in every thing he did.

ENJOYING EVERYDAY LIFE

YOU CAN OVERCOME!

o you know that you have an enemy? It's true. In fact, we all have an enemy—the devil—and it's very important for us to understand who he is, or we will be defeated in life.

I went to church for years and didn't know the devil was real; I thought he was just a cartoon character in a red outfit with a pitchfork. I never heard a message about the devil and how we can have authority over him. I did get a good foundation of what salvation is, and I'm very thankful for that. But I wasn't living a victorious life in Christ because I didn't understand who the enemy is, that he is the author of my problems, and that I need to aggressively resist him.

If you're thinking, "Joyce, I don't want to talk about the devil," I understand. But the devil has strategies and plans to come against you, so the worst thing you can do is ignore him. That's why I want to help you get informed about who he is so you can know how to recognize when he's at work in your life and how to defeat him.

Because the good news is, through Christ, you can be more than a conqueror and overcome the attacks of the enemy (Romans 8:37).

WE'RE IN A SPIRITUAL WAR

In 2 Corinthians 10:4 (AMPC), the Bible says, "For the weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood], but they are mighty before God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds." This verse makes it clear that our battle is not against flesh and blood.

In other words, people are not the source of our problems. People can create problems, but we need to realize that the enemy works through people, and if we just deal with them, we're not getting to the root cause of the issues in our lives.

Now, there are several reasons why we have trouble: We live in a fallen world and experience the effects of sin; we disobey God and make poor choices; and we are directly attacked by the devil. I want to focus on the ways and reasons why the enemy brings trouble into our lives.

IT'S HIS NATURE

The Bible teaches that Satan (another name for the devil), was formerly called Lucifer. He was created by God as an angel with a free will. He was an archangel and had great power and responsibility. Some biblical scholars believe he was the angel in charge of worship. Ezekiel 28:13-15 says he was covered with precious stones, he was the anointed cherub and he was blameless in his ways from the day he was created until he turned against God (AMPC).



Isaiah 14:12-15 explains that he is fallen from heaven because he said in his heart: "I will ascend to heaven; I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will sit upon the mount of assembly in the uttermost north. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High" (AMPC). He used his free will to try and be like God, yet he was brought down by Him.

When Satan fell from heaven, he took a third of the angels with him; therefore, the devil and his demonic hosts are alive in the earth today. They are the evil in this world, and we can't be lazy Christians and expect to overcome them.

KEYS TO DEFEATING YOUR ENEMY

The devil has power, but Jesus came to put him in his place and deliver us from the power of the enemy. First John 3:8 (NKJV) says, "...For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil." When we accept Christ as our Saviour and come into a personal relationship with Him, we gain access to the authority and power of God in our lives.

John 10:10 says that the enemy comes to steal, kill and destroy, but Jesus came to give us life—abundant life! And John 8:32 says God's truth sets us free. See, when we know the Word and who we are in Christ, then we can recognize the lies of the enemy and how he is trying to work in our lives. We can stand our ground by faith in God, submit ourselves to Him completely and resist the devil, and the enemy must flee! (See James 4:7; 1 Peter 5:9.)

There are so many scriptures that help us know how to overcome evil in the world and live victoriously over sin and the enemy. For example, Romans 12:21 says we overcome evil with good; 1 John 4:4 reminds us that Christ, who lives in us, is greater than the enemy in the world; and Colossians 1:13-14 (NKJV) says God "has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins."

Here's some more truth for you: God loves you and He has plans for your life that are good...that will prosper you and give you hope. Make a determined decision to aggressively pursue your relationship with God in prayer and through studying His Word. By God's grace, you can defeat the attacks of the enemy and have the victorious, more-than-a-conqueror life Jesus died to give you!

CREATIVITY: LEARNING TO FORGET HOW THINGS WORK

This is our granddaughter Kennady. (bottom right of the page) I spend a lot of time watching her, and obviously, since she's only a year old, she hasn't had much time to learn how things work.

As a result, the first few times I gave her a book, she had no idea what "reading" was, so she walked on it, set it up like an A-frame house, or used it for a plate. It's been that way with everything. Since she doesn't yet know the way things are "supposed" to be used, she just makes it up, and has come up with some pretty remarkable uses for things like spoons, a flute, a ball – not to mention food.

While I was watching her the other day, it hit me. People, who are less creative, always default to what we're "supposed" to do with things. People who are more creative have the ability to set those expectations aside and approach it like Kennady does – with no preconceived ideas.

Here's an exercise to find out who's the most creative on your team: Take something everyone knows – like a hammer, an umbrella, or a stool. Ask each person to come up with something completely different – and legitimate – that item could be used for. You'll find out pretty quickly, who's bound by what they know, and who's able to set that knowledge aside and start seeing new possibilities.

Why does it matter? Because during your career, you'll be asked to come up with new ideas for things everyone already knows. Perhaps a new way to structure your team, a new approach to marketing, or a different way to look at a client's problem. Remember that pretty much

everyone looked at mobile phones the same way, until Apple's creative team came along and set aside that "knowledge" and viewed it from a completely different perspective.

Whatever the task, you'll be more successful if you can set aside your "knowledge" and look at it like my granddaughter.

FORGET YOUR IF YOU CAN'T GET

In today's hyper-competitive, distracted culture, it's time we realized that it's not the customer's job to find you, donate to your cause, or buy your product; it's your job to find them. I was in a meeting with a business group the other day and one of the board members vented in frustration: "We've been producing an incredible product for decades! Why aren't people buying it?" I told him that's analogue thinking from yesterday. In the old days 90% of the battle was building a great product, because there wasn't as much competition. But in today's digital age, there are simply unlimited choices for everything, which means customers, donors, and audiences are overwhelmed. That's why it's our job to help connect our product to them.

"In today's media driven culture, visibility is just as important as ability." - Phil Cooke. I don't care how great your church service, non-profit work, or business, it simply doesn't matter if you can't get on the culture's radar. It's one of the reasons I spend nearly as much time coming up with a book title, as I do writing the book itself. There's just so much competition in a Barnes & Noble or Amazon.com, I need something that will reach off the shelf and capture their attention.

For many from the last generation of celebrities, movie stars, writers, and musicians, publicity was actually beneath them. You rarely saw novelists like John Cheever pitching his books, or Marlon Brando doing a press tour (remember when he had a Native American woman in full Indian dress pick up his Academy Award? It was beneath him even to show up at the Oscar ceremony.) But today it's very different. The biggest stars are doing press junkets, top writers are working the media, and even CEO's are getting into the act.

It's not the world I'd like, but it's the world that exists. So know this (and this is good for job hunters to think about as well): It's not anyone's job to find you, your product, or your organization. It's your job to find them. Visibility is now just as important as ability.

Never forget it.



The question is – how long are you willing to pursue your dream?



Unveiling Islam


The Isis Crisis

If there is something that I'd like to be better at, it would be prayer. And, according to Luke 11 from verse 1, it's something you can learn. The disciples asked Jesus to teach them, and He did. He gave them and then us; the prayer that most people in the world have heard at some point or other, whether they know Him or not. To many it becomes a bit of a rhyme. I fell into that trap myself many times growing up, and every now and again I seem to be content to climb back in that same hole again. Stupid. Given, I didn't have a relationship with God, but I knew the Lord's Prayer and I knew it verbatim, but understood very little. Jesus' idea of how to address the Father is locked up in His words, and it's a key to intimacy with the Creator of the universe.

We have been given the right, through Jesus, to find quiet moments in the midst of the chaos of life, to 'plug' ourselves into the Creator of the Universe.He is the One who loves us more than we could possibly fathom, the One who knows how to intricately manage the puzzle pieces of our very existence and He never slumbers or sleeps. (Psalm 121:4) To say prayer is an *honour*, is simply a ridiculous understatement. Someone has called it the *'breathing of the soul'* but to be honest, it's a whole lot less ethereal than that. It's a practical conversation with a God who is both interested in our lives, and working all things for our Good. (Romans 8:28). He wants to see us engaging with Him and asking for what we need. (Philippians 4:6)

It's a time to express our thanks and to just acknowledge God for His goodness and to lift His name in worship. You know how we can sometimes get in the corporate setting on a Sunday; hiding the truth so it continues to look like everything is ok.

There's no space or time for that nonsense when you're alone with God, in your room. It's your space to be raw and exposed, plucking up the courage to show the Father what He can see anyway. We knock off the clichés and the '*Christianese*' and we get down to business.

It's funny how vulnerable we become when we realise we can hide nothing.

So prayer is less about the breathing of the soul, and more about baring it; whether in honest desperation or loud proclamation. The way you feel, will dictate your approach to prayer, and that smacks of relationship to me. It's not about what you wear, how you kneel and following a script, but like with any relationship, there's always a better way to say things as you get to know each other better.

This isn't a manual on prayer, goodness gracious no! What this is thought, is a reminder to all of us that we have been taught to do something by Jesus Himself, so I think we'd better pay attention. God deserves praise, others deserve our concern, and we need more of God in every area of our lives. Should prayer get greater priority in our lives? Well you answer that one.

ON THE FRONTLINES OF FAITH SERVING THE PERSECUTED CHURCH -by Open Doors SA

The ministry of Open Doors began when a young, Dutch, newly converted Christian, Andrew van der Bijl, was invited to a Polish Youth Festival in 1955. Other than a change of clothes and linen, his bag was filled with Christian literature for believers in Warsaw. What he found behind the Iron Curtain was a Church in desperate need of support and Bibles. It was in this moment that God spoke to Brother Andrew, as he is best known, through the words of Revelation 3:2, "Awake, strengthen what remains, which is at the point of death..."

Under Brother Andrew's leadership, Open Doors has gone, and today, 60 years later, still goes, where very few Western Christians dare to go. "I think we in the West, now this is a personal confession, I think we are cowards. We want a personal profit to come first and if that is at risk, we don't do anything. We ought to become people of guts, courage and strong convictions and [shouldn't] count our lives dear unto ourselves, if only we can fulfil the high calling of God on our lives. That's what I'm after," says Brother Andrew.



THE PERSECUTED CHURCH TODAY

An estimated 100 million Christians worldwide suffer interrogation, arrest and even death for their faith in Christ. Christians like Seema* who at age 11 was driven away by her family because she accepted Jesus. Ever since then she has had to survive virtually on her own, but recently received support from Open Doors to expand her tiny shop. "I am selling many grocery items now, and my business is running very well. I praise God for all His provisions."

Open Doors supports and strengthens many believers in the world's most difficult areas, enabling them to continue shining Christ's light in their families and communities. We do this through Bible and Christian literature distribution, leadership training and assistance, Christian community development, prayer and presence ministry and advocacy on behalf of persecuted believers.

THE OPEN DOORS WORLD WATCH LIST

The Open Doors World Watch List highlights the top 50 countries where it is most difficult to live as a Christian. The list reports that persecution became more intense in more parts of the world in 2015. While North Korea remains the most difficult place in the world to be a Christian, persecution is growing most rapidly in Africa, especially sub-Saharan Africa. In the Middle East, Islamic State violence in Iraq and Syria has increased the pace of the exodus of the Christian population from the region and is also having, as news headlines daily testify, a global impact.

In the 60 years since Brother Andrew's first mission trip, the world has








changed. Radical and violent Islamism has taken over from Communism as the main source of Christian persecution. What the Open Doors World Watch List highlights is the plea of Christians being persecuted in Muslim dominant countries, which was unheard of in 1955. What does remain the same in 2015, as in 1955, is that many continue to witness the Gospel spreading even amidst martyrdom and struggle. (Visit www.opendoors.org.za/eng/wwl for more.)

Most recently, in one year, Open Doors delivered over two million Bibles and pieces of Christian literature to persecuted believers. And our mission continues.

Jesus told his disciples that "In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world (John 16:33)." Since Jesus' ascension His Church has indeed faced much trouble and persecution. Although the forms of persecution have changed throughout the ages, and will continue to change, one thing remains the same: the mission that Open Doors and the worldwide Church is called for, "Awake strengthen what remains which is at the point of death..." As Brother Andrew says, "It's what Jesus told the disciples to do... He who spared not His only Son but gave Him up for us all, how shall He not freely give us all things, including guts..."
