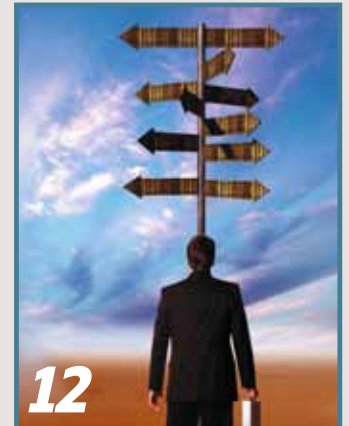
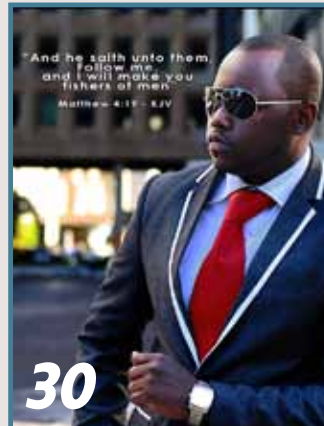

Our Eternal Purpose

Spring is in the air and soon enough, the chill of winter will be behind us as we move into the next season of the year. As we well know, seasons come and go bringing with them new expectations and promises of change. But these aren't the only seasons we experience in life, in fact, since the time we were first conceived in the heart and mind of our creator, our seasons in life began. And they will continue to fill our lives for eternity. Seeing life from an eternal perspective can make those seasons full and meaningful as we learn to live on purpose.

What is my purpose?

So many people go through life wondering what their purpose in life is. They ask the questions, "Why was I born? Who am I? What is my purpose?" Today, we want to dispel any doubt concerning your purpose by casting light onto the One Who created you for His purpose. The Word of God gives clear evidence that God is an eternal God and His purpose for each of us has an eternal significance. The word eternity means: infinite time or the state of existence

outside of time. This means that our purpose is not just for this time on earth, it's for eternity. That's why it's imperative to begin to see our lives from an eternal perspective and only the Word of God, through the leading of the Holy Spirit can do that because eternity cannot be grasped by our minds but by our hearts!

Take God's Word for it...

Take a look at what God's Word says concerning our purpose:

Psalm 139:16, "Your eyes saw my unformed substance, and in Your book all the days [of my life] were written before ever they took shape, when as yet there was none of them. How precious and weighty also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How vast is the sum of them!"

Ephesians 1:4, "Even as [in His love] He chose us [actually picked us out for Himself as His own] in Christ before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy (consecrated and set apart for Him) and blameless in His sight, even above reproach, before Him in love."

Ephesians 2:10, "For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live]."

From the above scriptures, it's quite clear that our lives were never a mistake or afterthought. On the contrary, we were carefully, tastefully and painstakingly created by a God Who loves us fully, even from before we took our first breath, before, in fact, the earth we live on existed.

Two significant truths concerning our purpose....

My favourite scripture by far, that refers to our eternal purpose is Ecclesiastes 3:11, "He also has planted eternity in men's hearts and minds [a divinely implanted sense of a purpose working through the ages which nothing under the sun but God alone can satisfy]"

Two significant truths can be gleaned by this particular scripture: The fact that our purpose is eternal and that that purpose is a divinely (by God) implanted sense or instinct that God alone can satisfy.

Once again, it's confirmed that our purpose is an instinct that is grasped by our hearts and not our minds. Look what Romans 1:19 says, "For the truth about God is known to them instinctively. God has put His knowledge in their hearts."

So the question we should be asking ourselves is, "What is that instinctive purpose placed inside of us that can only be satisfied by God Himself?" Surely, if we know the answer to that question, we will know the answer to our eternal purpose.

Paul lived on purpose...

Probably the best example, outside of Jesus Christ, of someone who truly lived life on purpose with an eternal perspective would be the Apostle Paul.

In studying his life and all he accomplished for the kingdom of God, Paul made some remarkable statements that give a perfectly clear description of what our instinctive, eternal purpose is:

Philippians 3:7-8, "But whatever former things I had that might have been gains to me, I have come to consider as [one combined] loss for Christ's sake...."

Yes, furthermore, I count everything as loss compared to the possession of the priceless privilege (the overwhelming preciousness, the surpassing worth, and supreme advantage) of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord and of progressively becoming more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him [of perceiving and recognizing and understanding Him more fully and clearly]..."

V10,11, "[For my determined purpose is] that I may know Him [that I may progressively become more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him, perceiving and recognizing and understanding the wonders of His Person more strongly and more clearly], and that I may in that same way come to know the power outflowing from His resurrection"

After all that he had accomplished for the kingdom of God on this earth, Paul still placed the purpose of knowing God instinctively of greatest importance - in fact, he said that nothing he ever did compared to the importance of it.

Paul explained that to Know God instinctively, is a process whereby we are continually transformed to experience life from God's perspective. A victorious perspective as believers seated with Christ in Heavenly places. Believers not overwhelmed by the circumstances of this natural world. He also understood that in knowing God instinctively, we would experience the power of His resurrection flow in and through our lives into the lives of others.

In order for us to fully grasp our eternal purpose of knowing God instinctively, we must develop a relationship with The Word of God.

When we receive the Word with the honour and joy it deserves in our lives, it dwells in us richly (Colossians 3:16). This causes us to be continuously mindful of God's perspective and keeps us instinctively connected to His Spirit. Can you imagine living this way? Full of the Living Word and instinctively connected to and controlled by the Spirit of God? This is how we live with the resurrection power of God flowing in and through us. This is how we live our eternal purpose. ✦

• **WHAT IS A DAY LIKE IN THE LIFE OF JASON CRABB?**

• **APART FROM MUSIC, WHAT ARE YOUR HOBBIES?**

I enjoy spending time outdoors. We have a lake next to our house, and when school's out and it's a hot day, you can find us in the boat on the lake. As a family, we love to do that. My girls are very active in sports – you can always find me in the stands watching them play and cheering really loud.

• **WHAT IS YOUR FAVOURITE SPORT TO WATCH/PLAY?**

• **REFERRING TO THE TITLE “WHATEVER THE ROAD”... YOUR STORY IS ONE OF REMAINING FAITHFUL NO MATTER THE UPS AND DOWNS. WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE TO READERS ABOUT DEALING WITH LOSS?**

Everyone experiences loss at some time in their lives. That's life. But God promised in His word that He would never leave us or forsake us and that He would be with us until the end. Now that's a promise we can hold on to. He has promised that He would meet us.

• **DURING SOME OF THE DARKEST DAYS, WHAT SCRIPTURE WOULD YOU HOLD ON TO?**

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will make straight your paths. – Prov. 3:5 & 6. Anytime I go through a situation in my life, this is something I can hold onto. We don't always understand what God is doing, but we are told to trust Him and He's never failed us yet.

• **HOW MANY OF THE SONGS ON THE ALBUM DID YOU PERSONALLY WRITE?**

I co-wrote seven songs on Whatever The Road. Every night I visit with people after the concert until the very last person is gone – I love to hear their stories. Many of the songs on this project came out of stories I've heard or experiences in my own life. One very special song is my current single “He Knows What He's Doing.” No matter what is going on in life, God knows what He's doing and we have to trust Him – even when it's hard and makes absolutely no sense to us at all.

• **FAVOURITE SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORM AND WHY?**

Oh boy, this is a hard one because they all serve a purpose. I love to connect with people and Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram but I'd have to say Facebook is probably my favorite.

• **IF YOU THINK OF SOUTH AFRICA, WHAT IS THE FIRST THING THAT COMES TO MIND?**

BEAUTY – the people and the land. I've heard it's beautiful there and seen some wonderful pictures of the land and people. The one thing that comes to mind is the wild animals found there. I love nature and South Africa to me is probably the most remote area for wild animals.

• **ANY PLANS ON TOURING SOUTH AFRICA IN THE FUTURE?**

That is a great idea! I would love to come, let's get a tour going.

• **WHAT IS YOUR FAVOURITE SONG ON THE ALBUM AND WHY?**

I have so many favorites but the one that strikes closest to my heart is a song called “Home.” My grandmother Billie was my favorite person and I loved her with all my heart. She passed away earlier this year, and one of the last conversations we had was on a day when I was just having “one of those days.” She said “Jase” – that's what she called me – “when you get to the end of your rope, just hold on real tight and know that He's holding onto the other end.” I miss her, every single day but I know right where she is. She loved Jesus with every thing that was in her and she let everyone that she came in contact with know just how much Jesus loved them.

• **WHAT PRACTICAL ADVICE DO YOU HAVE FOR COUPLES WITH A BUSY LIFE LIKE YOURS TO KEEP THEIR MARRIAGE ALIVE?**

Communication is key. You've got to keep the lines of conversation open. Keep dating each other – keep going out for special nights, special days. Treat each other like you did when you first fell in love.

• **YOU HAVE EVEN HAD A ROAD NAMED AFTER YOU! WHO IN YOUR FAMILY HELPS YOU REMAIN AS HUMBLE AS YOU ARE?**

My wife Shellye, and my girls Ashleigh and Emma are the ones who keep me grounded. I get to take out the trash, mow the grass, fix the toilet. That'll keep you humble! My Grandfather and Grandmother taught me about hard work and instilled within me that “you get what you work for” and that “God blesses hard work” – those words ring in my head every day.

• **WHICH MUSICIAN FRIENDS DO YOU “CONSULT” ON YOUR ALBUMS OR TRACKS, AND WAIT IN ANTICIPATION TO HEAR THEIR OPINIONS?**

My brothers Adam & Aaron – I always like to run the music by them. I think we've made music together for so long, we've worked on music together so it's always fun to go back and play a track for them – talk about the direction of the music.

• **WHO IS YOUR BIGGEST CRITIC?**

The Bible says “iron sharpens iron” and I have some of the best “iron sharpeners” there are. My management team – Philip & Tina Morris – have been a Godsend to my life and my family's life. They've been with me from the beginning and over the years, they've consistently pushed me to be a better person – not just an artist – but to be a better dad, husband, brother and friend. They have seen it all – from the beginning. Recently, God has placed a lady named Diane Sheets in my life. She's helped me be more polished and she's the first to call out a wrong note or tell me where I can improve myself and how I can connect more with the audience.



• **WHAT HAVE YOU LEARNT THE MOST ABOUT BEING A DAD TO TWO BEAUTIFUL DAUGHTERS?**

Everyone always says kids will change your life forever, but I don't think I understood just how much being a dad would change me and challenge me. I grew up in Beaver Dam, KY, which is just as small as it sounds. It's the kind of place where everyone knows everybody and in a sense, your neighbor's sort of feel like your family. Beyond that, I was on the road with my family for years doing music. I know family. I do the family thing well. But there is no amount of family time that could ever prepare you for kids. There is absolutely nothing in the world like being a father. Soon, I'm going to be the father of teenagers, which just seems crazy. Time flies so fast. The last thing I want to do is waste it or miss out on a chance to teach them something or encourage them in some way. I think as much as Shellye and I want to be the best parents we can be, we're still human and sometimes it's going to be trial and error. I sit back all the time and ask myself, what are they thinking? What's going through their minds? Am I doing this right? Am I giving them enough...or too much? Am I really teaching them how to live a life in Christ? In a lot of ways, God is answering all these questions and blessing me through the faith that's growing inside each of my daughters' hearts. To watch my girls get to know Christ...really, there aren't words to describe that feeling. It's amazing and demands that I keep growing right alongside them. The Bible tells us, "Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it." (Proverbs 22:6).

• **YOU HAVE ACHIEVED SO MUCH IN YOUR LIFE, A GRAMMY AWARD, TOO MANY DOVE AWARDS TO LIST, WHAT IS STILL ON YOUR "BUCKET LIST"?**

I'd like to hold a traveling revival tour – an old tent revival and take it on the road. One of those where you put the tent up for a few days and then move to the next city – lots of music and messages. I love to see people changed by the power of God's word – in music and message. ✦

Family Feuds

Fighting within families is nearly as old as time itself. Soon after the creation of the world we find the first-born earthling killing the second-born earthling over some perceived slight. Incidentally, Abel was wholly unaware that he had offended his brother Cain to warrant a cold-blooded murder. It nearly seems as if this incident set a precedent for the future of mankind.

Perhaps it would do us well to consider the nature and purpose of a family, and then from there see what we can do to preserve this precious unit. Essentially God, who is love, created humans because He longed for relationship. The very nature of love requires that we have to love, and also be loved in return. This reciprocal exchange forms the basis of all relationships, and in the mind of God sealed the purpose and function for His creation. We read in the Genesis account that this perfect relationship lasted for a while, where God is found to walk in the cool of the day with Adam and Eve; I can just imagine how interesting those conversations must have been! However, we are soon introduced to Satan, who is pathologically jealous of the relationship (and we can call it a Father-child, family relationship) between God and man, and we also see how cunningly he puts a wedge between God and the crown of His creation.

The plan of God was that man was to multiply, increase, be fruitful, and to be the ranking authority over all the creatures on earth; the earth still belongs to God! In essence man was to rule, subdue and reign on earth as a steward of God's property, and to help him in this task he could rely on his family. But that prideful fallen angel is still at work to bring about disunity and to dismantle as best he

can the family unit of God's intention. The history of mankind is filled with stories of family feuds, and leaves in its wake hate, bitterness, unforgiveness and death – this is far removed from the original blueprint for mankind. Writers and filmmakers have immortalised many tales that at its core has family fighting as the theme.

God's idea of family gets a renewed focus in the New Testament, where believers are again encouraged to call Him Abba, Father, and where they are referred to as children of God. The family unit again became the focus and purpose behind mankind's existence. Yet, still the enemy of mankind schemes to break up the unity upon which God commands a blessing. In most cases the basis for disunity in many families is small and insignificant issues, which through pride and the refusal to forgive, soon blossom into a full-scale storm of anger, strife and hate.

The New Testament Church is also likened to a family, all being brothers and sisters in Christ. It is rather sad that within this family there seem to be constant and persistent fights that bring dishonour to the Father. One hears about congregations that are openly hostile to one another, denominations that will not tolerate those with a different view, and ministers publically attacking their brothers for insignificant issues. Often ministers are ruled by them striving after numbers (members of their church family), boasting about the financial income they are able to generate, or even about the impact they have in the local community. The World Christian Encyclopaedia cites 33000+ total "Christian" denominations (Barrett, Kurian, & Johnson, Oxford University Press, 2nd edition, 2001). I do not decry denominations per

se, however, when one considers that a denomination is basically defined by its doctrine (set of beliefs and interpretation of Scripture), and that many denominations were birthed through a church split (family feud), it does put a damper on the celebration. Now, what is true for congregations (of all denominations), is also true of other Christian organization and companies, and one is constantly exposed to stories of feuding in the media. Ultimately I am decrying the dishonour within our Christian family, not only towards one another, but also towards our Father.

I often wonder how it was possible for 33000 separate belief systems to have been birthed out of one cross, one death and one commission, and all this over a mere 2015 years! Imagine the impact of a "single family", with a singular vision and purpose, on a society! Imagine the significant contribution this "family" would be able to make in the lives of people! Imagine a family united in love, with no in-fighting, grudges or offenses, but with a single focus of sharing that love! If we are able to imagine this, then nothing we can imagine will be able to predict the response from God!

It is time that the family of God place focus on what really matters: tell the world about His love. In love there is no disunity, hate or striving, but everything opposite to this and more!

So, are you ready to look at your own life and opinions, and restore those relationships that have suffered either consciously or unconsciously? Are you ready to forego your perceptions for the sake of focussing on simply loving God and others? Are you ready to decree that the greatest thing in life is to love and be loved in return? ✚



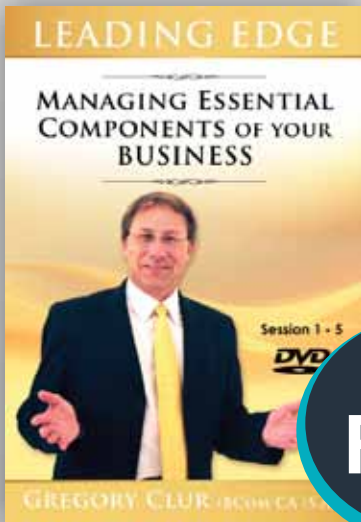

Overcome Doubt and Live with Bold Faith

In Acts 27 (AMP), there's a great story about the apostle Paul. He was travelling by ship with some people when "a violent wind [of the character of a typhoon]...came bursting down from the island" (v. 14). For days they were caught in the storm, and at one point it was so fierce, they were "dangerously tossed about by the violence of the storm" (v. 18) and had to throw the ship's equipment overboard. They ended up without food, hungry, stranded – seemingly without hope.

In that moment, Paul stood in the midst of the survivors and said to them, "I beg you to be in good spirits and take heart, for there will be no loss of life among you..." (v. 22). He then shared that an angel of God told him this, and said in verse 25, "So keep up your courage, men, for I have faith (complete confidence) in God that it will be exactly as it was told me."

How could Paul, in the middle of a horrible storm, ask the people to "be in good spirits" and have a good attitude? Because he believed in his heart—without a doubt—"that it will be exactly as it was told me." I love that! It's a great picture of the power of faith in God when all hope seems lost. And we can have the very same faith that Paul had if we will overcome doubt.

We all face storms in life. Some are more difficult than others, but we all go through trials and tribulation. That's why we have the gift of faith. Ephesians 6:16 (NIV) calls it "the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one." Doubt is a type of "flaming arrow" that the enemy uses to attack our faith.



We usually experience doubt after we've made a decision. In James 1:6, the Bible says having doubt is like being tossed about like the wind, which feels like you're trying to go in two different directions at the same time. And it's miserable to be torn between two places, not able to decide what you really believe. It's in those moments we have to choose whether we are going to believe God or the enemy...God or our feelings...God or what people tell us...God or our circumstances...

When doubt comes against us, we have to lift up the shield of faith. We do this when we open our mouth and say what God's Word says, rather than grumbling and complaining about the problem. Our faith is released as we say, pray and do the Word. So in those times, open your mouth and say, *"I believe that everything God has told me will come to pass!"*

Maybe you're doubting whether you can hear God's voice or not. This happens because we usually doubt ourselves more than we doubt God. Now I'm not talking about actually hearing a voice; I'm talking about that knowing we have inside our hearts about what is right or wrong. That's the still, small voice of God. Believers in Jesus Christ all have it, but many don't have the confidence to trust it.

The Bible says in James 1:5 that when we need wisdom, we can go to God, ask Him for it, and He will give it to us *"liberally and ungrudgingly, without reproaching or faultfinding"* (AMP). What this means is that even with our imperfections, God will be faithful to us and give us what we need if we will ask Him for help. He loves us, blesses us and uses us in spite of us, because He is faithful! And we never have to doubt that.

I've learned through my own relationship with God that He's not expecting me to be perfect; He wants me to do my best to be in His will and take steps of faith as He leads me, through His Word and the promptings He speaks to my heart. Remember, He wants us to put our confidence in Him. God really does want to speak to you personally and lead you in His great plan for your life. So don't be afraid to step out and do what's in your heart. If you make a mistake, you'll learn from it and go on. That's how we "step out and find out." And we all have to do it.

I want to encourage you to begin making confessions every day that will help you grow in your faith and confidence in God. We need to make declarations like, **"God loves me. He wants to speak to my heart. I can hear from God. He is faithful to me and will lead me in His will for my life. And I believe it will be exactly as God has told me!"** By God's grace, we can be bold in faith and overcome every attack of doubt during the storms of life. 📌

In fact if we look at 1 John 5:7 (NKJV) "For there are three that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one." Therefore we see that Jesus Christ is in fact The Word and The Word is Christ. If we look at John 1:1 (NKJV) we see one's again the importance of God's Holy Bible, it says "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." So how can we say in modern day society that the Word of God has no more relevance. I would say it is more important today than ever

before, because if there is any dispute we need to go back to the Bible. I am not interested in your opinion and you should not be interested in my opinion, we are only concerned about God's opinion. The legacy which I am determined to leave my family and the body of Christ is the importance of God's Word, because when everything else departs God's Word will stand. As we see in Amos 8:11 the Lord warns us that the days are coming when there will be a famine in the land, not a famine for bread, not a thirst for water, but of hearing the Words of the Lord. So you and I are custodians of God's Holy Word on earth until we go home to be in heaven, and we preserve the Word as it stands. Nothing added to it, nothing taken away from it, because the Bible tells us clearly that if we adjust this Bible at all every plague in the Book will come upon us. I cannot stress enough how God has spoken to me about the importance of speaking His unadulterated Word without any apology whatsoever. I want to be His Colporteur. Now a colporteur is a man in the early days that would go from door to door selling The Bible. He carried a rug sack and he took Bible's from door to door, in the country, in the city marketing the Word of God. What a noble way to live one's life.

In the Word of God we have everything we need. The Word of God is our compass, our direction finder (Psalm 119:105, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."), it is healing (James 5:16 "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much."), it instructs us how to anoint the sick with oil and pray the prayer of faith which will heal the sick. Indeed if you are reading this article and you are lacking faith in these hard times in which we are living then you need to get into this Book and read it systematically. Not randomly.

Starting maybe in the Book of Psalms and then going across to the Gospel of John. Reading a portion each day and then applying it to your life, because The Bible says in Romans 10:17 (NKJV) "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

If you are having problems with your family and priorities at home then you need to apply what the Bible tells us about the model family. E.g. Husbands love your wives, wives submit to your husbands. Children respect your elders, elders don't antagonise your children, and then you will see a difference in your family literary over night, but the problem is many of us and some of us are even Preachers, tend to water down The Bible. We side step issues that are of relevance, because we don't want to offend people. The Bible is a life saver, but the Bible can also be a tremendous offence to those who are wrestling with God.

So God has given me a "mandate" and He has told me that in the last chapters of my life I need to start preaching The Word more sincerely, telling less stories about other things and getting back to the lifesaving Word of God. I really want to say to you, my dear friend, it will be a good thing for you to start memorising scripture and hide it in your heart, because we do not know what the future holds for us. We know that we are living in the last days and those of us who are Bible speaking believers are going to be severely tested before the coming of the Lord. If you want to leave something for your children, leave them The Word of God. In closing the Lord says clearly in Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV), "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." ■

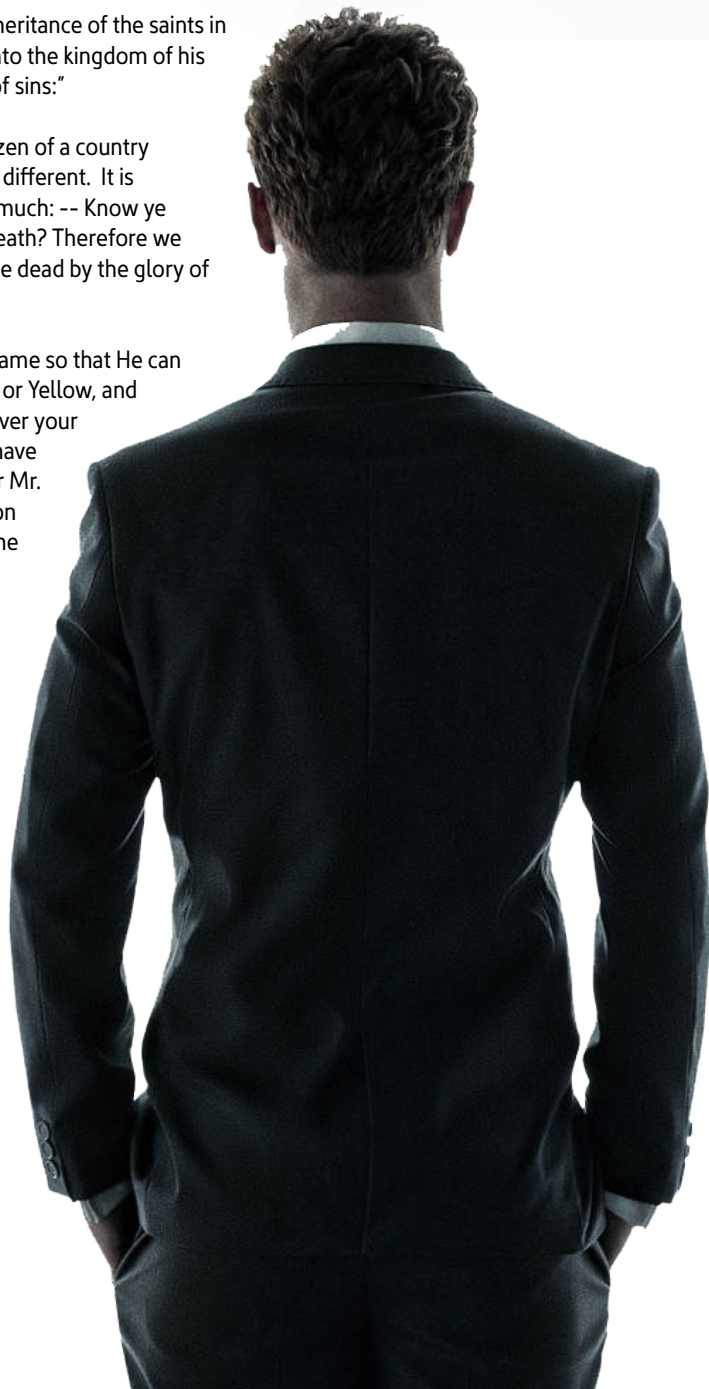

It is with great excitement that we give you the latest update on the Studio Project. May we start off by saying how grateful we are that you have partnered in this vision with us? So many times when a ministry project of great magnitude is launched people who fail to 'connect' with the vision start thinking that it is all about the resources, but we know that the majority of our partners have, in fact, connected with the vision! When God gives a vision to accomplish much for His Kingdom, He also provides the necessary resources, and of this we bear positive testimony! The vision is plain and simple - Go and make disciples in all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and then teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you; and be sure of this—that I am with you always, even to the end of the world (Matthew 28:19-20 TLB). And this is the exact mandate of Faith Broadcasting Network and its partners! Thank you again for heeding the voice of Christ and partnering with us to make this commission a reality.

We decided from the start that to mark our commitment of making this project about the Word, to place four Bibles in the four corners of the new studio. This is our way of saying the project has the Word of God as its foundation! We placed a Bible in the middle of the floor at the casting of the first new concrete in May, and on 31 July we placed the east corner Bible in the foundation! Our partners have sent us some of their favourite Scriptures and promises, and these were highlighted in the Bible that was placed in the fresh concrete. Please continue to send us your Scriptures as we are still going to place a further three Bibles!

The project is progressing at a steady pace, despite a few concerns about some unseasonal wet weather! Again, the progress is a testimony to the goodness and provision of God in all areas! We are grateful that God has put the right team into place to see His vision fulfilled.

While there is hectic construction happening on the fourth floor of River Park, the floors below remain a hive of activity in the daily tasks that keep Faith Broadcasting Network on the air, and your favourite programmers and presenters 'in your lounge!' In a manner of speaking "all hands are on deck."

We are further happy to report that to date all the partners who have joined in the vision of seeing God's kingdom extended have pledged 49,56% of the initial R30-million budget. This is a significant 5,45% increase from our last update and equates to just over R14,8 million, of which roughly 49% has been received. The team of Faith Broadcasting Network is very privileged to have so many like-minded people at their side and is honoured to call them friends! We praise God for such faithful partners. There are daily calls and emails from people all over the world who are pledging support, both in prayer and finances, for the project. We know that God commands His blessing where there is unity, and so together and united we believe to see the entire renovation completed on time.

Thank you for your continued support of this vision in prayer and finances - we value your partnership greatly! To give you some practical insight into the timeline of the project, and also to help you pray specifically for each stage in this phase of the development, here is an anticipated timeline (we will keep updating you with the latest news as the plans unfold!

- Building of tiered seating structure
- Waterproofing of entire roof/wall areas

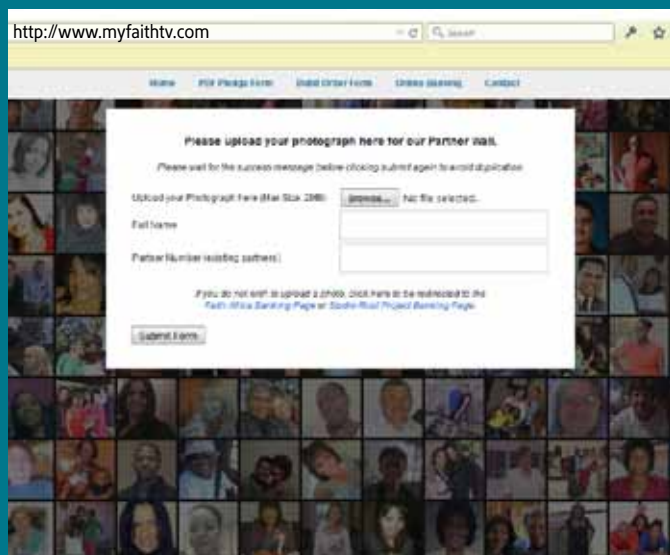

What Hollywood Knows About Resilience, That YOU DON'T!



Love it or hate it, one thing you can say about many producers in Hollywood is that they are remarkably resilient. They don't give up, and in some cases keep pitching ideas for years. There's something to be said for that, because in my experience, when people outside Hollywood hit a wall, get rejected, or suffer a defeat, nine times out of ten, they give up. But in Hollywood, you'll find producers that are still pitching ideas, concepts, and scripts they developed decades ago – and in an amazing number of cases, they eventually strike gold. For instance, back in the 1980's, Ken Wales, who's had a long career as a producer in Hollywood acquired the rights to Catherine Marshall's book "Christy" – about a pioneer woman living on the American frontier. He pitched that book to every studio in town and did it for years. But time after time, he was turned down. Studio after studio, financier after financier. Turned down flat.

But Ken never gave up. In fact, he just wouldn't let it go, to the point that I started feeling really bad for the guy. So one day I pulled Ken aside and told him to give it a rest. "Ken, nobody wants to make a movie about a pioneer woman. Give it up. Move on with your life." But Ken refused to listen. Then in 1994 – about six months after our conversation, Jeff Sagansky, then president of CBS, bought it and turned the book into a TV series that ran for twenty episodes on that network. Series regular Tyne won an Emmy Award for her work on the series.

Needless to say, Ken Wales taught me the value of resilience. Just like the old Timex watch theme, Ken could take a licking and keep on ticking. So when it comes to resilience, here are a few lessons we could learn from Ken Wales and other producers in Hollywood:

- 1. Don't be a "One Trick Pony."** Ken pitched that book for years, but it wasn't the only project he was developing. He was also working on other movies as well, but always looking for the right opportunity to produce "Christy."
- 2. Don't burn bridges.** I'm sure Ken was laughed at a few times because the 80's weren't a prime era for making movies about pioneer women. Even the "Dr. Quinn Medicine Woman" TV series didn't start until the 90's. But no matter what reception Ken received from studios or other producers, he was always gracious. As a result, he never burned bridges and still has those valuable relationships for pitching other projects.
- 3. Be open to change.** Ken always thought about that project as a movie. But when CBS suggested it could be a dramatic TV series, Ken agreed. But in other situations, I too often hear responses from writers and producers like "It can't be changed," or "This is the way I've always dreamed it would be and I'm not interested in changing it." I'm all for fighting for your vision, but all the artistic vision in the world won't amount to much if you don't have any finished projects to show for it.
- 4. Learn from Ken Wales.** Be resilient. You never know when the right time and circumstance for your project will happen. Only God knows the big picture, so learn to trust, keep your attitude high, and never give up. 📌

4 - The people you meet on the way up, you'll meet on the way down.

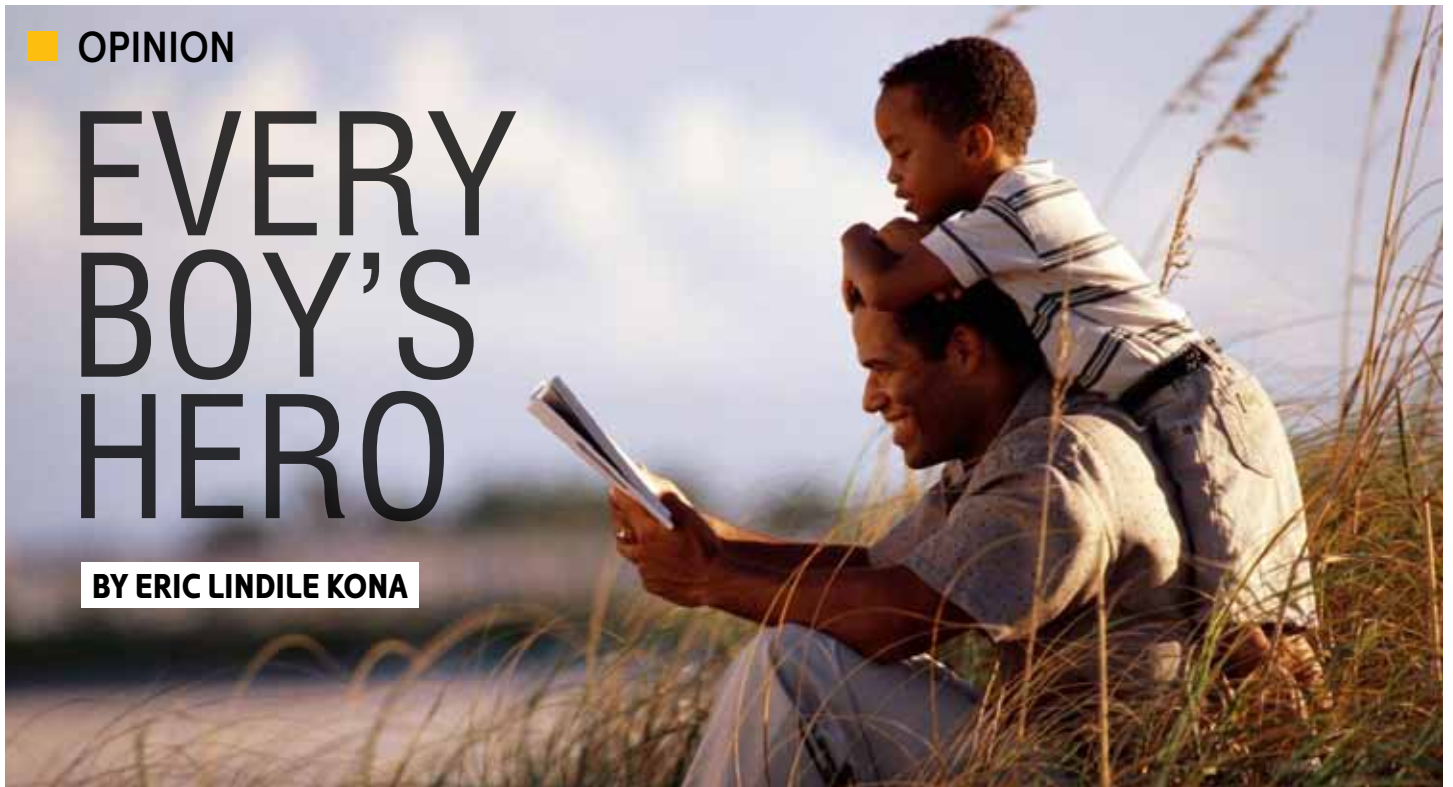
