FROM THE EDITOR

Allow me a brief moment to discuss 'youth': this could be young people, anything from 0-18 years old, but perhaps common assumption would focus on the 13-18 age bracket. Research has shown that the 0-3 age group is critical in terms of brain development. So, for any child to have a fighting chance as an adult it must be ensured that the proper nutrition is given to the developing brain; brain functions can be severely hampered in cases of malnutrition or physical trauma to the head. When we see the many relief organisations out there attempting to feed the hungry children in the world we realise that the seriousness of this situation is indeed real. However, the dangers of malnutrition don't stop at age 3 but is still a major concern worldwide.

Other research has shown that a child's adult identity (including their sexual identity) is completely formed at the age of 6, and is just waiting for the commencement of the hormonally charged teenage years to kick into action. When we consider the onslaught on the sexuality of our youth today we should sit up and take note! The homosexual agenda has become a real voice in international politics even though it still is a minority group; other voices clamouring for attention are the so-called metrosexuals, feminists and other minority groups. The sexuality issues the youth are facing today are serious since it leads to new definitions regarding issues of marriage, divorce and abortion.

There is a host of books and guides out there that tell parents to make sure enough time is spent with children from 0-12 years old to effectively help them with the transition period from 13-18. Many believe if parents spend

The problem seems that too many parents are too busy with their own lives to really spend enough time with their children in the formative years, and then stand with their hands in their hair when the paw-paw hit the fan. There is a great responsibility that rests on the shoulders of all parents, guardians and teachers; in fact, on the shoulders of any person that stands in a position of mentoring.

Children are gifts from God and should be treated as such. There is sound advice to be found not only in the writings of researchers but also in the Bible. I believe as parents we worship God by allowing our children the opportunity to explore a relationship with Him. I see worship in simple things like feeding the hungry, clothing the naked and supporting the widows. There is also the congregational aspect of worship where music, dance, art and other creative forms of expression have a role to play; without labouring around issues of style, there are essences of worship found in the Word that guide us into the type and form of worship that is acceptable. 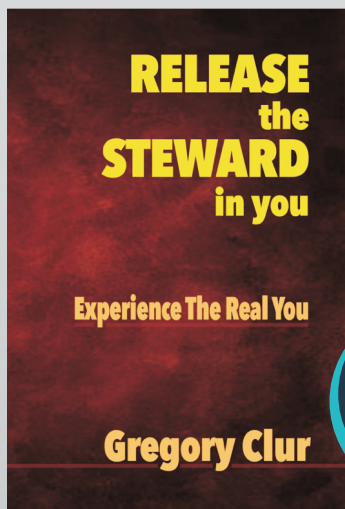

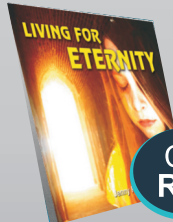

A merry heart does good, like medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones

Growing up, I remember my Dad trying to comfort me with a rhyme after my heart was broken by a mean, spiteful word someone had spoken to me. He said, **"Sticks and stones may break my bones, but words will never hurt me."** Unfortunately, despite his good intentions, this couldn't be further from the truth. You see, all words, good or bad, are like seeds. They have the ability and potential to lodge themselves into our minds as thoughts. They root and anchor themselves down and produce after their own kind.

Recent scientific studies have proven that our thought life directly influences our physical bodies. If we reject a thought, before we spend time meditating on it, it will have no effect on us (which is really what my Dad was implying). However, if we meditate on that thought, we cause it to build up a memory in our brains that becomes a mental stronghold. It has also been proven, that every thought releases a chemical response, and has an emotion attached to it as a response to that thought. As you think on it, it carries that emotion and chemical response along a network of nerves that are directly linked to the rest of your physical body.

Every word released from our (or others mouths), is received by our physical senses as a thought. If we pay attention to that thought, it will produce an emotional and chemical response. That response will be carried throughout our physical bodies and depending on whether it is good and healthy, or wicked and fearful, it will produce its very nature and intent in our lives. It doesn't matter if the person who spoke the words meant it or not. The hearer gets to either receive it and make it a living memory or reject it and never have it penetrate his mind or life.

Doesn't that make you want to think twice before you say any word?! In a nutshell, so to speak, good, healthy thoughts produce good, healthy people; and wicked, fearful thoughts, produce wicked, unhealthy people. For this reason the Bible teaches us to guard our hearts with great vigilance (the state of keeping careful watch of possible danger), because out of them flow the issues of life. Whatever we allow to attach itself to our hearts (mind), will produce in us, the same nature that flows from it.

Proverbs 3:26, **"For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he."** Proverbs 17:22, **"A merry heart does good, like medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones."**

Now, the Bible declares God's Word as an incorruptible seed (I Peter 1:23,25). When it is received into our thoughts and meditated on, it produces after its nature (God's own nature), bringing peace and life and healing with it! As we meditate on it, it carries it's never-failing and everlasting power into every area of our lives - chemically and emotionally affecting everything in our physical bodies!

Proverbs 4:20 **"...For they (God's Words) are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh."**

Philippians 4:8, **"Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy - MEDITATE ON THESE THINGS."**

As we make an asserted effort and a conscious decision to take God's Word of truth, and meditate on it, we cause it to become a rooted memory in our minds that has the supernatural peace and life of God attached to it. Every time we think on it, it produces and transmits that peace and life attached to it, to every part of our physical bodies - bringing healing and peace and well-being.

THE #1 KEY TO HAVING PEACE

Peace is an amazing gift God offers us. I know what it's like to live without peace – upset most of the time, anxious, fearful and worried. It's miserable! Since I've discovered how to live with God's peace, I will do anything I need to do to have it.

We have to understand the value of peace if we're going to have it. Because if you think it's really no big deal to lose

your temper, worry, be stressed-out or upset all the time, you won't do what you need to do to live with peace.

I think it's interesting that one of the last things Jesus told His disciples before His crucifixion was about peace. John 14:27 (AMP) says, ***“Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge.]”***

In John 20:19, **“Peace to you!”** is the first thing Jesus said to His disciples after His resurrection. Verse 21 says, “Then Jesus said to them again, ‘Peace to you....’” Notice the word “again.” He must have wanted them to realize how important it was to maintain their peace.

Take a moment to think about how much peace you have. Do you worry, get upset or feel stressed-out often? Many people do...but that's not the way God wants us to live.

A lot of Christians pray for God to give them peace, but they need to realize that as believers in Christ, they already have His peace. We need to pray for God to help us learn how to walk in peace.

Philippians 4:6-7 (AMP) says: **“Do not be anxious or worried about anything, but in everything [every circumstance and situation] by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, continue to make your [specific] requests known to God. And the peace of God [that peace which reassures the heart, that peace] which transcends all understanding, [that peace which] stands guard over your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus [is yours].”**

We can learn a lot about how to pray powerful, effective prayers by studying Scripture. Instead of praying for peace, notice that in Philippians the apostle Paul is encouraging believers to trust God in every circumstance so they can have His peace as they go through challenges.

If we don't have peace and we want it, we have to be ready to make some changes. The world around us probably isn't going to change, so we need to change our approach to life. We need to make a conscious decision to trust God in every area of our lives, every day.

We're called believers, and that's what we're supposed to do: Believe God! When we trust Him, we enter His rest and can enjoy our lives.

Years ago, I remember when God helped me to learn this lesson as I studied James 4. In verses 1-4, we see what causes quarrels, strife and discontentment. Verse 2 (NLT) says, **“You want what you don't have, so you scheme and kill to get it. You are jealous of what others have,**

but you can't get it, so you fight and wage war to take it away from them. Yet you don't have what you want because you don't ask God for it.”

Wow! This is basically saying, **“You want something, so you strive to get it your way or make it happen on your own, but it doesn't work. If you would just ask Me, I would help you.”** It's important to point out here that God won't just give us anything we ask for. He loves us and wants what's best for us, and when we ask for things that are in His plan and purpose for us, He will give them to us.

I used to think I wanted a lot of things that ended up making me miserable after I managed to get them. But once I started giving up my will and asking God to do what He wants to do in my life, I experienced peace and contentment that I'd never known before.


It was so freeing for me to give up trying to run my own life and instead focus on seeking God and trusting Him to give me what He wants me to have. Psalm 37:4 (AMP) says, **“Delight yourself in the Lord, and He will give you the desires and petitions of your heart.”**

I want to strongly encourage you today to purposely choose to seek God and delight yourself in Him before anyone or anything else in your life. He is the Source of love, joy and peace. And you'll live in peace as you live in Him!

THE URGENCY OF THE HOUR

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you

The Bible tells us very clearly in the gospel of Matthew 24:14 (NKJV), ***“And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.”*** There is a tremendous urgency now to get the gospel out; we have our favourite saying at Shalom Ministries that ***“nobody deserves to hear the Gospel twice until the world has heard it once!”***

The Lord did not say that He will come again once everybody in the world is converted; He said His second coming will take place when everyone has heard the Gospel. The Lord Jesus, before His ascension back to the Father in heaven, said clearly in the gospel of Mark 16:15 (NKJV), ***“Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.”*** We need to be careful that we do not get side-tracked in this calling of God; it is not only for evangelists but for all believers. There needs to be urgency in our reaching people. All must be born again, since without that no one will see God. John 3:7 (NKJV), ***“Do not marvel that I said to you, ‘You must be born again’.”*** So, like never before, we see His coming ahead and the time is running out.

As a farmer I can identify with the Lord Jesus when He says that when you see a factory producing new leaves, you know that spring is on its way. The same thing applies when you see the signs taking place in the world – we know that the end is imminent so we need to tell people

about the situation. Of course, it will not always be well received but it is the truth. The Lord tells us very clearly in Matthew 6:33 (NKJV), ***“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”*** The priority for all Christians is to preach the gospel, both by word and action. The Lord promises that when we do that: ***“And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”*** Mark 16:17-18 (NKJV)

We always say that one genuine miracle equals a thousand sermons. We have experienced, not once but many times, how God always confirms the preaching of the Gospel with signs and wonders and miracles. It is so exciting! No-one can dispute the facts when, for example, in a drought situation where the Gospel has been ministered in its entirety, the congregation praises earnestly for rain and the rain comes. That miracle will challenge the greatest atheist to give his life to Christ.

Our God is a holy God. He will not tolerate sin of any degree, but often people are not all that serious. They are told that, through Jesus, all your problems will be over and in a way that is true since Jesus promised us that He never abandon us. ***“I will never leave you nor forsake you.”*** (Hebrews 13:5 NKJV) Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego were in the fire, but there was a fourth person in the furnace like the Son to God and we believe it was Jesus. Similarly, that is exactly what He will do for us if we preach the Gospel uncompromisingly!

That Fear in Your Gut? It's Not Going Away

And that's a good thing...

We spend an enormous amount of time trying to live without fear. We read books about being brave, take classes in gaining confidence, and spend tons of money on inspirational books and courses. That's not necessarily a bad thing – except for the fact that fear is one of the most powerful motivators on the planet. Fear of danger kept early human beings alive. Fear of war kept leaders working at diplomacy. Fear of poverty kept our parents and grandparents working hard. And today, while many of the things we fear may have changed, the emotion is just as relevant – and important.

I see too many leaders living in denial because they refuse to acknowledge the fear that their business, church, or non-profit is failing. I see others with no self-awareness, because to face their shortcomings would create too much fear.

Certainly there are overblown fears. When what I would call a **“healthy”** fear is replaced by an unfounded or out of proportion fear, that's a bigger issue that needs to be dealt with in other ways.

But for most of us, most of the time, we need to embrace it. Look at your fear in the face. Understand where it comes from. Your fear is the canary in the coal mine. It's the early warning sign that something needs to change.

That uncomfortable feeling in your gut when you do certain things or make certain decisions shouldn't be ignored, it should be welcomed. Here's the important point: Fear becomes your friend not when it's gone, but when it's overcome. When you've acted on the fear in a way that solves the problem... When your response to the fear is to fix the reason it's there.

Fear: Stop ignoring it, worrying about it, or denying it, and start responding to it.

What Overwhelms You?

You need to stop it before it stops you...

This is about how to get your story out there. It's designed for filmmakers, writers, pastors, musicians, business and non-profit leaders – anyone who has an idea or story burning in their heart that they need to share. But one of the greatest obstacles to getting your story out there is becoming overwhelmed with the process. It happens to me when I'm balancing too many things and get the sneaky suspicion that there's something important to do that I've forgotten about.

It usually comes when I haven't been paying attention to my priorities, am over-stretched, and not taken a close look at my notebook. When that happens, I usually get a wave of negative feelings, I find it tough to concentrate, I can't write, and feel like I have to get away. I can see a meltdown coming in the distance.

The bad news is that I hate that feeling. It eats away inside like cancer, and I feel completely helpless and anxious. The good news is that I know what causes it, so I can see it coming. As a result, I know what steps to take to alleviate it, and get things calm again.

What about you? Have you taken the time to identify the red flags that lead you to become overwhelmed? Until you do, you'll continue to get caught in the death spiral, and it usually happens at the most inopportune times – in client meetings, before deadlines, or in front of co-workers. Without intervention, over a period of time, these moments often lead to complete burn-out in a career.

Note that I'm not talking about serious depression or anxiety issues. Those need to be dealt with through a qualified professional. I'm talking about those moments when you simply feel overwhelmed, have hit a wall, and your creativity, productivity, and output bottoms out.

Know yourself. Learn to see it coming. Take the right steps to avert it; because righting the ship during those challenging times can often lead to your greatest creative breakthroughs.

RENDER UNTO CAESAR



The payment of a tithe effectively by means of a salary sacrifice

GREG CLUR

A scheme that I have been requested to comment on in the past is one which involves the payment of a tithe effectively by means of a salary sacrifice. Typically, this scheme occurs in the case of someone employed by a ministry and would work as follows:

The individual is employed at a given basic salary but in terms of a private arrangement with his employer (the ministry) he agrees to be paid a basic salary which excludes the amount that he would have paid as a tithe. In other words, the tithe amount is deducted from his basic salary and he is simply paid the net amount. In this way, the tithe is effectively paid as a “salary sacrifice”. Presumably, the prime motivation for this scheme is that monthly “pay-as-you-earn” tax is calculated on the salary net of the tithe and not the larger basic salary, which was the original salary to which the individual agreed when he was employed.

For example, the individual is employed at a basic salary of R 15 000 per month. He would normally tithe R 1 500 per month (10%) on this salary. He and the employer agree that he will be paid a salary of R 13 500 (R 15 000 less R 1 500). As only R 13 500 is processed through the payroll system, tax is calculated on R 13 500 and not R 15 000. At current tax rates, this would represent a saving to the employee of R 450 per month. The employer (ministry) is happy because they would have paid him R 15 000 as a salary and received R 1 500 back as a tithe. The net cash outflow is R 13 500. Therefore, paying a salary of R 13 500 places the ministry in the same net cash outflow position. So, what is wrong with this scheme?

Based on the above facts, this scheme contains elements of flagrant disregard for the provisions of the Income Tax Act. I believe that it is dangerous and ill advised. Firstly, without elaborating on the specifics of the prevailing income

tax legislation, if a basic salary of R 15 000 was agreed, this is the amount subject to monthly tax, particularly if an employment contract was signed at this salary. Variations to a contracted basic salary must be capable of being clearly substantiated. In addition, both the employee and employer may experience considerable embarrassment and difficulty explaining to the South African Revenue Services how it is possible for a salary to decrease!

Secondly, a salary sacrifice such as this is most likely subject to tax as a fringe benefit under the Seventh Schedule to the Income Tax Act. For example, it could be construed as a financial obligation of the employee that has been paid by the employer or the employee could be considered being released from an obligation to the employer. Alternatively, the amount could be subject to tax under the general tax avoidance legislation in the Income Tax Act. Salary structuring requires experienced professional input. The complexities of prevailing tax law have made this a prudent decision.

Thirdly, the act of disclosing R 13 500 on the monthly payslip as opposed to R 15 000 arguably involves a large element of dishonesty. There is potentially an element of fraud in this action.

Fourthly, Unemployment insurance premiums are paid on R 13 500 and not the R 15 000 originally contracted for on employment.

As a matter of principle spiritually, the scheme presents serious concerns. Besides the elements of dishonesty, a tithe is a step of faith and the action of paying the tithe is eliminated in this scheme. If it is suggested by the parties that the actual salary agreed to is R 13 500, then where is the tithe? Tithes, after all, are paid on the gross.

I would advise that anyone involved in such a scheme should obtain independent professional advice as to the merits and the integrity of the structure as well as experienced counsel as to its correctness spiritually.

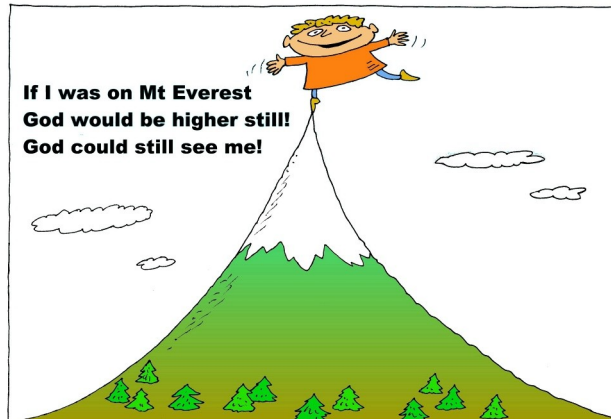

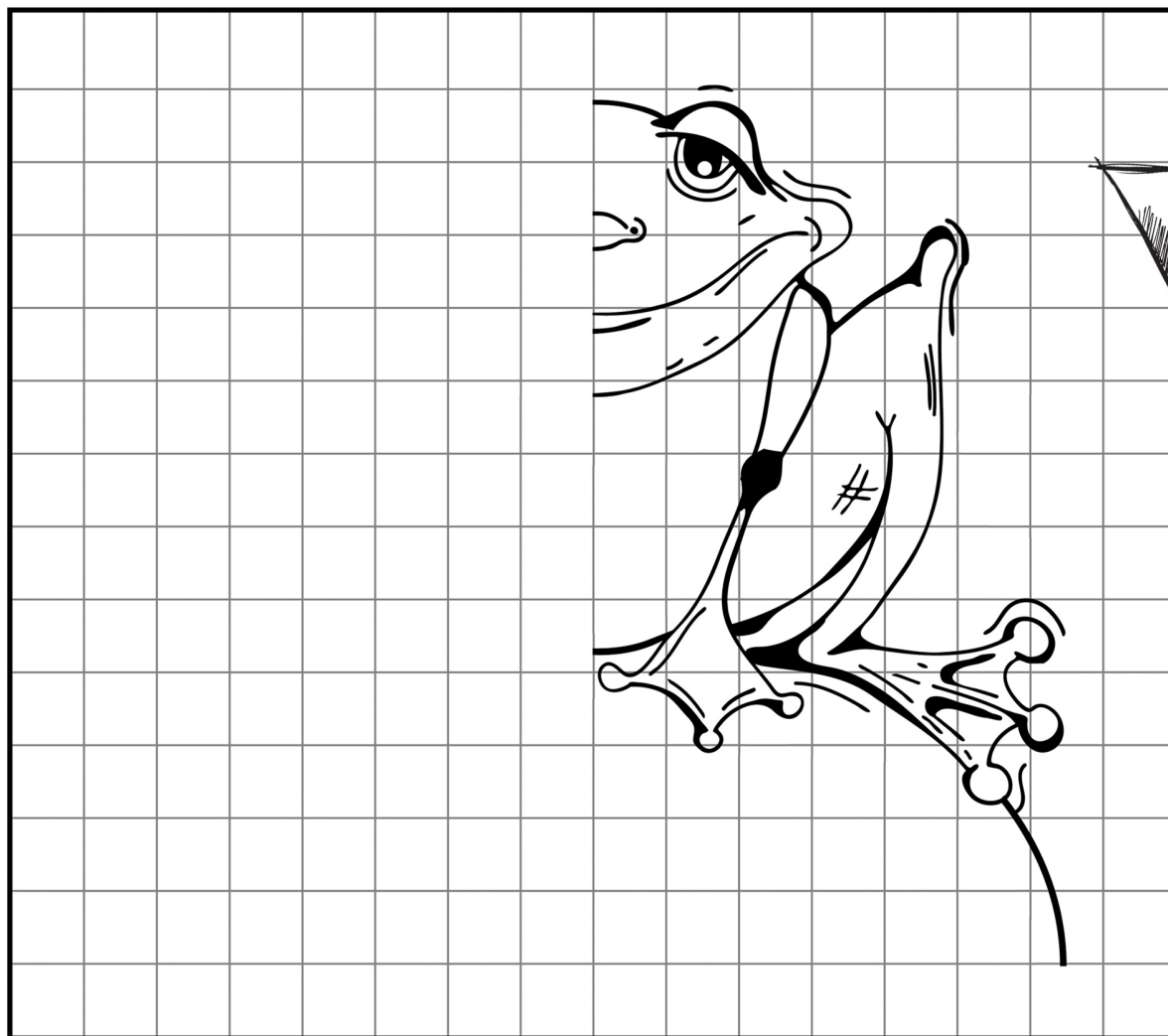

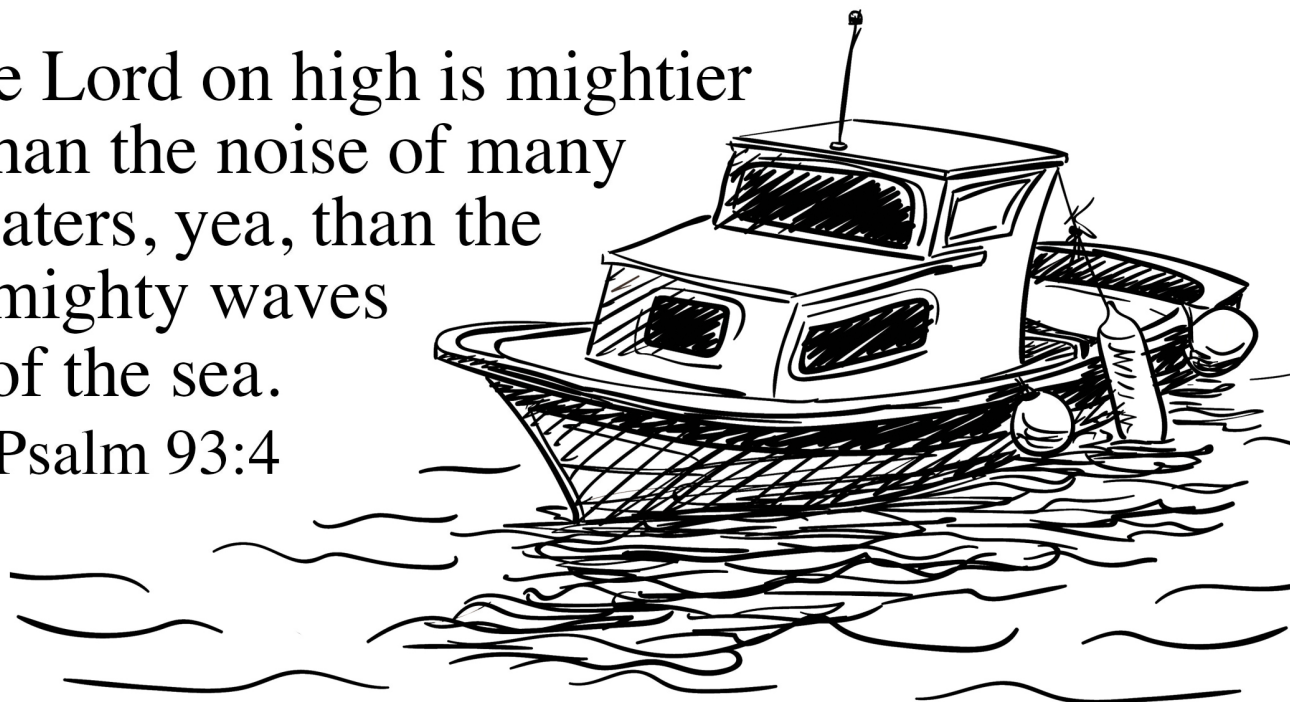
