



ave you ever tried to have a meaningful conversation with someone who didn't speak your language? It basically becomes a guessing game of charades, where you are unable to get the other person to understand let alone respond to you. As much as this is a funny picture in our imaginations, if there was any urgency regarding what you needed to talk about, that so called 'conversation' would only result in their blank stare and your growing frustration.

I think this may resemble the conversations we have with the Lord from time to time. It's as though our communication becomes one sided. We pour out our hearts or desperate appeals, just to feel them bounce off an invisible wall. We have no reassuring come back. No response at all.... just a dull silence. As if we were speaking to God in a language that was completely foreign to Him.

So, what is the language of God? Is it difficult and complicated to learn? Well, it turns out to be as complicated as when a sinner cries out in faith to the Lord for salvation, and God responds with His saving grace. Grace is God's gift to us, and not just for salvation. We find it in every promise in His Word, and each time we approach Him. Grace is God's continuous approach and response to us. His sovereign nature is and always will hold the quality of grace in our relationship with Him. Grace is God's language to us. What is equally important to understand, is that grace always responds to the language of faith.

This perpetual exchange between grace and faith, becomes an ongoing conversation between the Lord and us, it forms the pattern of a language that we both understand and can respond to. Grace is simply what God says to us, in His Word, and in our hearts, and faith is our response to Him. I once heard someone say that faith is a positive response to receive what the Lord has freely done for us.

Grace says, "You are loved, you are redeemed, you are never alone... you are free, you are healed, you are valuable, and in Me, all things are possible." Faith responds, "Thank you Lord, I believe you, I trust you, I receive all you have done for me... I am yours and I delight in You."

Now that's the language God always responds to, it's the one He has bound Himself to honour. In Hebrew 4:14, we learn that Jesus is the high priest of our **confession**. The Word **confess** means **to say the same thing**. So, when we speak to the Lord, either in our approach or response, our words must carry the same truth we hear in His Words. We must communicate with Him, in His language. The language of faith that agrees with and responds to His grace.

So the next time you feel like your prayers are falling on 'deaf ears', try speaking the language you know is heard and guaranteed to bring a response that will fill your life with peace and joy. few years ago, I reached a point where I was feeling weary...tired of the world around me...tired of doing the same thing all the time. I've been doing this a long time, and my passion and zeal for the call of God on my life was gone.

Isaiah 60:1-2 (NIV) says, "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you...." The Amplified Bible, Classic Edition, says to "arise [from the depression and prostration in which circumstances have kept you – rise to a new life]!"

Prostration means you're lying down. When I was weary, I was lying down on the inside, in my heart. I had to "get up" and rekindle my desire for God to use me and shine

His light through me in this dark world. This was a decision I had to make for myself...and you have to do the same thing.

We can't afford to waste our time waiting for our circumstances to change or for someone else to make us happy. As believers in Christ, we have the power of the Holy Spirit in us, and we can decide to stir ourselves up on the inside and "arise, shine" in the way we live. I want to make this practical for you and show you two ways you can do this. Matthew 5:16 (AMP) says, "Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good deeds and moral excellence...."

The first way is by doing good deeds. This basically means we should help someone or just be good to somebody. If you pay attention to people around you, it won't take long for you to see something you can do to make someone else's life better.

It could be simple, like holding the door open for someone, allowing them to go before you. Or maybe you can give an encouraging note to a friend who is going through a hard time. You could mow the neighbor's yard, pay for someone's groceries, babysit for free, give something you have to a person who needs it...the list of possibilities is endless.

The second way is to live with moral excellence. Excellence is not common in our world today, but as sons and daughters of the Most Hight God, we should be excellent in everything we do. I'm not talking about being perfect; being excellent means you do the best you can at everything you do. You strive to always do what is right in God's eyes – even when no one is looking.

For example, when you're at work, don't take company time to do personal business on your computer, and then when your boss comes in, make it look like you're working. Your boss may not be watching every minute of the day, but God is.

We need to get to the point where it's more important to us to please God in everything we do, whether others see us or not. Because God is always with us and He always sees everything we do.

The older I get, the more I realize how important it is to live for God all the time because we don't have time to waste! Before I got really serious about my relationship with God, I wasted so many days being upset because I didn't get my way all the time. I was so focused on trying to get what I wanted that I wasn't thinking about how God could use me to make a difference in this world.

It was a miserable way to live. But I discovered that helping others - walking in love to glorify God - is the key to being truly satisfied, content and happy.

So I want to ask you: Are you weary, apathetic and struggling to shine the light of God's love? Are you tired of wasting your days being discouraged that you aren't making progress in your relationship with God or changing in areas of your life that need to improve?

If you are, I want to provoke you to get up on the inside! Make a decision that you refuse to live this way any longer - no matter what your circumstances are, what you've been through, how others have hurt you or how long you've been struggling.

Stop waiting for God to do something and wake up to the truth that in Christ, you already have everything you need in your spirit to make a major difference in your part of the world. There is a greater purpose for your life than just getting what you want or settling for a frustrating, unfruitful existence.

have a beautiful painting in my prayer room, that was given to me many years ago by a fellow believer and it depicts a man. He looks very much like a farmer to me, with an old-fashioned paraffin lantern in his right hand and he is walking down a path at night.

We in South Africa, at the moment, are on a journey and for many of us we do not know exactly what the future holds. We are optimistic because our Lord Jesus Christ is an optimist, but the only way we're going to continue to walk along this path is by faith. 2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV), "For we walk by faith, not by sight."

You might ask, but how does one get faith? How does one get the paraffin to keep the lamp burning, so that we can see where we are walking? ## The right to education is the right to develop all aspects of the human personality to its fullest extent

ost systems in our country have failed us. Think of Eskom, corruption in municipalities, tax evasion, the unethical behaviour of various political leaders and the great lack of a supportive medical system. The low results in 2014 in the standardised ANA Tests (10,8% for Grade 9 math literacy) and great percentages of children suffering with learning disabilities, has also resulted in parents not trusting the educational system. Good teachers become totally despondent with results such as these since they have a passion to teach and a hope to see positive results.

Though parents might feel inadequate to change large infrastructures, it is possible by having the relevant knowledge, pressure can be put on those who are involved in their children's education. Many principles have seen the "light" as I share with them how children can learn more effectively. Often, as a result of this knowledge they change their methods and revisit their vision to come in line with their original call from God to be involved in effective education. Across the country people with a passion for education start transformational centres and small school learning centres in the interest of their communities by making themselves available to a different way of learning not as slaves of a failed system but rather as leaders who want to be vessels of God in bringing hope.

It is clear that the current philosophy of education in South Africa will not bring the change parents are hoping for. What is even more concerning is that private schools, and specifically Christian schools, are guilty of sending learners away because they cannot offer a learning climate to produce the desired outcome. Children that do not fit the mould move from school to school, and province to province, in the hope to get help. Often parents are exhausted by this search.

I want to give a few pointers to inform parents, schools and churches to act in the interest of their children. It is

of no use to change a wrong system with yet another burdensome system, and of utmost importance that people responsible for education seek God to bring boldness in a process of change for this country. It will start with the selective few who grasp this and embrace a radical different approach.

"The right to education is the right to develop all aspects of the human personality to its fullest extent" (United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child). The parents choose to embrace this development mainly at home or can have a tutor coming to their home. It is also an option to establish learning centres or even small schools. Community leaders get legal help from sites such as www.pestalozzi.org and www.sahomeschoolers.org. Both the small schools and learning centres should be no more than twelve children so that individual attentions can be assured. Research shows that "first year university students have a Gr 5 level Literacy level and a Gr 7 level Reading Comprehension. No wonder that "20 % of high school graduates qualify for university entry, about 50% of first-year university students drop out, in part because of poor school preparation for university disciplines" (Jonathan Jansen, Molly Blank).

There is absolutely no value in these learning centres following the same structure as a traditional school. Instead of it being graded, itsfocus should be on the level of the child's competency, since all children have different gifting in various areas such as mathematical, artistic, and technical or language ability.

The facilitator/s in these centres do not necessarily have to be qualified teachers, but rathera person parents can trust, with a gift of teaching willing to embrace change and has a heart for education. Since parentsare the main educators, with the school as an extension of them, parents will pay more for such services purely because they will have peace of mind. This peace comes from understanding the curriculum used is not the same as used in public schools education since children learn differently in smaller centres. Even the world's leading educational systems (Finland) with the best outcomes, havedecided in March 2015 to

change their strategy for even better results. Finland is scrapping traditional "teaching by subject" in favour of "teaching by topic." PasiSilander, Helsinki's development manager, explained: "What we need now is a different kind of education to prepare people for working life."

See what a teacher on Facebook answers about this change in approach: "At the school that I am leading we have been doing this (new approach) for 40 years with great success. Our secondary-students experience a teaching that has relevance to their life and their parents see that what they learn and develop at school is relevant to their future. And the students are performing on the top-level of Norway. Finland is really approaching an education for the 21st century." It is therefore advisable that interested parties do a study of the different and amazing approaches to education and its effects in the learning environment.

The aim of this new way of learning is that children actually learn. Most parents complain about the fact that their children are not learning. Effective learning should have the desired effect/outcome on the life of a person; in the Information Economy all children can learn, even the illiterate, with a high emphasis on creativity rather than rote learning.

If there is no trust in the learning climate, one in which children can make mistakes, this kind of learning cannot take place. It is advisable in the structuring of these smaller schools that the facilitators form a strong bond with the learners to ensure a level of trust and that children stay with one teacher for many years.

All children do not learn in the same way, hence it is logical that the futurists of such centres focus on the different learning styles of children and how to differently and creatively motivate children and allow learning to take place in the most suitable manner. Young children up to six should sing, play, work (chores) and listen to stories and not be bound by formal classrooms.

During assessmentor testing of children it cannot be required that all do a specific learning in exactly the same way. There should be studios in these centres where children are able to give feedback on what they have learnt in various ways. In a digital era, it is important that children use digital tools as an aid to prove what they have learned. The slow writer will not be discriminated against as he can type much faster. Various matriculation options are available if needed, but generally a wider education is needed.

In a digital era, where there is too much information to remember, it is important that children get knowledge, have comprehension (explain an idea), apply this idea (use it in their own way), and understand it in a wider context. Digital tools can be wisely used in this process.

During the ages of 4 to 16, children should work on discovering their passion and keep themselves busy with that, so that they know what subjects or interest choices they can make for specialised training in the future. In a traditional school system this I precisely the time learners are kept busy with schoolwork and homework. No wonder then that school-leavers often do not have an idea what direction to take with regards to careers. Where children have focussed on their passions and gifts, the period from 14 to 18 can be used to mentor young people into specific skills or career paths.

It is of no value to be involved in the education of children without educating the heart and the willingness first to be changed as educators. It asks for a constant evaluating of goals with regards to character training in both the child and educator. Christian educators are at times the only Light source.

This is the time like never before for parents to rise up and be envisioned. It is the time to decline any participation in an educational system where the child does not learn, not be equipped for life or have a transformed heart. Parents need to know there is an answer. Home school, micro school, learning centre, unregistered private school, low fee school and cottage school are all different terms that are used to refer to a new and fast growing phenomenon in the South African educational environment. These are (mostly) small independent or private schools that are operated by a small group of entrepreneurs, parents, exteachers or volunteers.

Dynamis helps families to choose curriculum that is in the interest of the child. It is a service that brings new direction and vision where leaders have been exhausted with the problematic realities of a system that does not produce the desired results. It normally asks for a new vision with the main emphasis - **the heart of the child**.

## The Power of Video Games: The World of Warcraft

emember the video game World of Warcraft? I'd lost track of it, until recently when it came up in a book on addictive technologies. As a reminder, World of Warcraft (WoW) is a massively multiplayer online role-playing game with millions of players from around the world who create avatars that roam across landscapes, fight monsters, complete quests, and interact with other players. In case you thought video games were completely benign, here's a few interesting stats:

World of Warcraft may be one of the most addictive behavioral experiences on the planet. Almost half of WoW players consider themselves "addicted."

Popular Science magazine described WoW as the "obvious choice" when searching for the world's most addictive game.

There are now support groups with thousands of members, and more than a quarter of a million people have taken the World of Warcraft Addiction Test.

In ten years, World of Warcraft has grossed more than 10 billion dollars, and attracted more than one hundred

million subscribers. If they formed a nation, it would be the 12th biggest on the earth.

It interferes with sleep because it's difficult to sleep when you know that your guild-mates in Copenhagen, Tokyo, and Mumbai are on an epic quest without you.

Games like WoW attract millions of teens and young adults, and up to 40% develop addictions. Several years ago a computer programmer and clinical psychologist joined forces to open a gaming and Internet addiction center near Seattle called reSTART.

Are all video games addictive? Obviously not. But there are plenty more like World of Warcraft that have similar horror stories from users. In a world that's quickly moving toward accepting all technology without caution or discernment, this might be a good reminder to think clearly about the long term impact of your next device, app, or game.

## The Keys to Communicating Change: One of the Greatest Challenges for a Leader

f you're a professional communicator, a significant part of your job is leading people through change. It's a tough challenge, and if you've read my book "Jolt: Get the Jump on a World That's Constantly Changing" then you know that for individuals and organizations, change is incredibly hard. One example in the book is research that indicates that within two years, the vast majority of open heart surgery patients go back to their old lifestyle – the one that got them into trouble in the first place. So if the fear of death doesn't make people change, then what will?

I asked Dawn Nicole Baldwin, our Lead Strategist here at Cooke Pictures to weigh in on the subject. Before working with us, she led Visual Communications on staff at Willow Creek Community Church, and was on the advertising team for the creators of VeggieTales. She's guided many churches and nonprofits through a wide number of changes, and here's what Dawn had to say: "I just don't get it," he sighed. "I feel like I've been repeating the same thing for months until I'm blue in the face. Why aren't people getting on board with the new vision?"

My heart went out to this frustrated pastor. He's a gifted communicator and skilled at painting a vivid picture of the future people want to be part of. But he's not getting the traction that he'd like in his new church.

The truth is nobody likes change. We are creatures of habit and prefer our routines. But leadership requires moving people from here to there and change just comes with the territory. Understanding why people resist is half the battle. After working with leaders for nearly 20 years, I've noticed there are three primary reasons why people don't get on board with change:

- 1) They Don't Agree Let's face it. This group can be the most difficult to deal with because some people are just impossible to please. They will find reasons to complain regardless if something changes or stays the same. Don't let these people hold your vision (or you) hostage by their version of what the future should be. Having a clear direction will mean some people won't want to be part of it. Let them go to make room for those who do.
- 2) They Don't Understand Many leaders spend most of their time talking about WHAT needs to change without spending enough time on WHY it needs to change in the first place. The pain of staying where they are needs to feel greater than the discomfort or inconvenience of changing. Paint a clear picture of why things can't stay the same. Tie it to vision. Tell stories make it feel real. Then focus on where you want to go & how you plan to get there.
- 3) They Don't Know What to Do Once people are excited, they want to get involved. The quickest way to squelch that enthusiasm is to overwhelm them with options. People don't want a catalog listing 485 ways to help. When faced with many choices, many shut down and don't do anything. Instead, focus on a few simple next steps that can apply to everyone. "Everyone" being a critical part. Bill Hybels, the senior pastor of Willow Creek Community Church, calls this the Power of Everyone. There is momentum that builds when everyone feels like they can take part in the vision. Once it's in motion, it's hard to stop. Understanding why people resist is half the battle. The other half is consistently casting vision and celebrating small wins along with way. Because communicating change is a marathon, not a sprint. Prepare for the road ahead.

### **EXTRAORDINARY**

So I'm standing in the midst of about 30 000 young people on a rag farm somewhere in Pretoria, and as exciting as it is to see Joel Houston on a screen 600 miles ahead of me and watching masses of students and teens dancing to the sound of "Break Free", I somehow feel very alone. There's nothing like being in the midst of a massive crowd to spark a little bit of introspection. As I go beyond the noise and lose myself in the silence, I hear God speak a simple phrase in my heart, "From ordinary to extraordinary."

When I read the Bible and see all the promises and purposes that God has for His Church and His people, the Extraordinary Life, I can't help but think that we have settled for something less. Somewhere between the church pews and the Christian bookstores we stopped being Christians. We went from being Christ-like to being

churchgoers, from being the Body to being bored, and from being saved to being served. We desperately need to take a hold again of that for which Christ has laid a hold of us.

How do we do this practically though? What are the steps we need to take in order to go from being ordinary to being Extraordinary? Quite simply, they're called Spiritual Disciplines. More than just a set of have-to-do's, spiritual disciplines are essentially about becoming more like Jesus. They're about cultivating the kind of life in which God can work. As Richard Foster said in his classical book. The Celebration of Disciplines, "The spiritual disciplines are a means of receiving God's grace. ... they allow us to place ourselves before God so He can transform us." Are you ready to be transformed?

### **MOTIVATION**

I have learnt that motivation is very important in order to have discipline. Think about how empty the gyms are in winter and how full they are in spring. Why? Because

everyone knows that in two or three months they have to go to the beach, so they have the right motivation to be disciplined. Our motivation should be the Fear of the Lord. That means that we should want to be disciplined spiritually because we understand who God is, we understand who we are, and in light of that we want to please Him. Without a reverential understanding of the greatness of God, we will struggle to be disciplined.

### **PRAYER**

Prayer, of course, is much more than a spiritual discipline; it is a life. Prayer is opening our lives to God for change. Prayer is recognition that God is God and we are not, and so in prayer we yield our desires to God's. Prayer is communication and fellowship with God, the very lifeline of our relationship with Him. Henri J. M. Nouwen said, "Those who live prayerfully are constantly ready to receive the breath of God, and to let their lives be renewed and expanded." Jesus knew temptation was heading His way and so He spent forty days in prayer and fasting; Peter on the other hand slept instead of praying and ended up denying Jesus. We need to rise up and pray, lest we enter into temptation. I would say that every person who is serious about his or her relationship with God should spend at least one hour a day in solid prayer. No less.

## **THE WORD**

In Ezekiel 37 we have the famous picture of the Valley of the Dry Bones. God instructs Ezekiel to prophesy to the bones and as he does they rattle and come together and flesh and sinews form on them, but there is no breath in them. God instructs Ezekiel to prophesy again and so the breath of God enters them and they live. The breath of God is life. Its interesting that in 2 Timothy 3:16, Paul states that all scripture is "inspired by God" or "God-breathed" the word used here for breath is the equivalent of the word used in Ezekiel 37. In other words just as the breath of God will bring life to dry bones, so scripture will bring life to your dry spirit. Studying, reading and practicing the Word of God, will release God's power into your life.

### **FASTING**

Psychologists agree that the strongest human instinct is that of survival. Linked to that instinct is our urge to eat. Our stomachs therefore represent the cravings of the flesh and our fleshly desires. By fasting we deny ourselves,

dethrone our stomachs, and declare "that man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds from the mouth of God". There is more to living than being alive.

### **SILENCE & SOLITUDE**

We are addicted to noise. We need noise. Silence is creepy, frightening even. Silence steals away the distractions of life that anesthetize us from the feeling that our lives are still empty. As Dallas Willard said, "Silence is frightening because it strips us as nothing else does, throwing us upon the stark realities of our life." As Christians we need times of silence and solitude so that we can reflect on our lives and hear the voice of God, just like Jesus did.


### **SERVICE & SUBMISSION**

Jesus taught that the way up is to go down. He taught His first disciples that the secret to becoming great is to become the servant of all. He illustrated His teaching by putting on the dress of a lowly house servant, and washing the grimy feet of his students. "Jesus took a towel and a basin and redefined greatness." Richard Foster. As Christians we need to practice the disciplines of service and submission until they become a way of life.

## **FELLOWSHIP**

The life of faith is not an individual affair. Yes, each of us has our unique life of faith, but it cannot exist separate from the community of faith. When you give your life to Jesus you also become a part of His Body, which means that you have to have fellowship with other believers. As Eugene Peterson puts it, "Whether we like it or not, the moment we confess Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, that is, from the time we become a Christian, we are at the same time a member of the Christian church." Joining a church is not just about attending services or listening to sermons; it's about building Godly relationships that will encourage us to become more like Jesus.

This is by no means an exhaustive list of the Spiritual Disciplines, but it might just help to get you started. If you call yourself a Christian but you're not practicing these disciplines chances are that your spiritual life is in trouble. Its time for us to get our minds set on spiritual things, striving after Christ-likeness, so that we may go from the ordinary to God's Extraordinary.



## Only with strong foundations can we expect them to stand firm in a shaky world out there

here is no doubt in any thinking person's mind that morality is globally in a serious state of decline. With every new generation, we seem to outdo the previous one in its wicked deeds. If we look back at the fuss kicked up fifty years ago when rock and roll had just been birthed we almost think people were crazy and what they viewed as obscene and rebellious seems timid when compared with the "normal" popular bands of today. The same can be said about television, school violence and so on. You have to wonder just how different our generation is from that of Noah's. Even in the churches we see high divorce rates, drunkenness, people yielding to immoral sexual desires and, probably most of all, a lust for money.

So how do we make sure that our children grow up against the grain in this world without having them alienate themselves from life in general? We certainly cannot expect their schools to install Biblical values in them, they are more likely to be told that they evolved from apes and to accept man's theories over God's Word. We definitely can't expect them to learn from TV or their friends either. Even youth groups produce horror stories and are not always safe. So the full responsibility then rests on us as parents and guardians.

### **BE AN EXAMPLE**


I remember as a young boy being told by my father to never start smoking while he was smoking two packs a day himself! Perhaps this is the reason why both my siblings smoke to this day. We have to lead by example; Paul understood this, in 1 Corinthians 11:1 he says "You must follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ." We cannot hold onto old habits and tell our kids that Christ is the One Who saves. The logical question they will ask in return is, "Well what has he saved you from, the bondage of sin?" We have been told not to be conformed to the image of this world but to be conformed to the image of Christ: "Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you. God knew what he was doing from the very beginning. He decided from the outset to shape the lives of those who love him along the same lines as the life of his Son. The Son stands first in the line of humanity he restored. We see the original and intended shape of our lives there in him" (The Message, Romans 12:2 & 8:29).

### **REAL VALUES**

Probably one of the least emphasized parts of the Christian life is eternal values. It is natural for every parent to want the best for their children on earth, and so we make sure they study hard, and that they understand the importance of getting a good job so that they can make lots of money. While there is nothing at all wrong with this if taught in its proper place, we do not show them scriptures that teach us to first seek the kingdom of God, not to worry about food and clothes, or that God takes care of those who love Him. So their focus in life often is drawn toward material gain, the little bit of religion installed in them will often become warped and God becomes a type of genie to pray to who is there only to benefit us in our social standing.

We need to ask ourselves, if our children were to say as Paul, "Compared to the high privilege of knowing Christ Jesus as my Master, firsthand, everything I once thought I had going for me is insignificant" is that really what we want for them? What if they gave up a promising career or even marriage proposal in order to become a missionary in a hostile nation?

These are hard questions to answer but if you can answer with a positive "Yes" your child will have a much better perspective for eternity. So beyond morals, you need to install eternal principles and a healthy fear of God into them which is a doctrine that also seems to have been lost. Proverbs 1:7 teaches that the fear of God is the beginning of all knowledge. Only with strong foundations can we expect them to stand firm in a shaky world out there. "Teach your children right from wrong, and when they are grown they will still do right" (Proverbs 22:6 CEV).

n the past few weeks, I have been through a lot. I have questioned the call I believe God has on my life, and I have lost someone very dear to me.

The pain and loss I was feeling seemed to emerge from somewhere deep within, and it submerged my whole being.

When Christ ascended into Heaven, He left the Holy Spirit us. To me He is a personal friend and counsellor. The Holy Spirit reminded me that only good and perfect things come from God, and He only has good thoughts in mind for us. He reminded me that this also applied to the family member I had lost. He helped me restore my faith.

In the midst of all this, a single line from a Hillsong tune rang in my head: "...the art of losing myself in bringing you praise..."

Although I did not understand everything that was going on in my life, I knew one thing that was certain - I knew that God's Word remained true and alive. In all this the praise due to God remained. Praising God in the midst of misery and confusion does not come easy but the song lyrics say losing myself in praise to God is an art. An artist has a gift to produce art and the art to lose ourselves in giving God praise applies to all people. The more I thought about it the more I believed that praising God in the midst of my life was possible: I am able to praise my Dad from the inside out...

The **South African Christian Directory (SACD)** is a newly launched online platform that gives an overview of the Christian landscape in South Africa, covering a wide scope of areas of influence and activities of Christian churches, ministries, organisations, initiatives, networks and movements. There are currently over 3 000 organisations from 35 sectors on the directory, with the number growing daily.

The SACD is the result of an extensive ongoing research initiative, spearheaded by Mergon Foundation and Bible Media, responding to the need expressed by various church and mission networks to develop a platform that gives an overview of the Christian landscape in South Africa. The purpose is to facilitate connection, communication, and collaboration.

"There is a need for a comprehensive, reliable and free online digital database for Christianity in South Africa. That is why Mergon and Bible Media combined forces to build this mobile-friendly, responsive and secure online database. Our prayer is that this would advance the Kingdom and empower the harvest force," said Nico Simpson, Head of Publications and Media. Bible Media.

The SACD aims to be a national online database that is sustainable and comprehensive, and portrays an overall picture of the Body of Christ in South Africa. It will ideally increase cooperation and networking within the national Church sphere.

"A better understanding of who the Church is, what her activities are and where those activities are based, would help to build platforms for unity and synchronize Kingdom activities for greater impact," said Skip Krige, SACD project coordinator. The online hub has multiple layers of information, and has the functionality built-in to harvest statistics that can be used for various trend reports.

The SACD builds on the legacy of Marjorie Froise, who published the SA Christian Handbook from 1986 to 2001 to address the need of exploring the Christian landscape in SA. Her aim was to empower the Church for strategic partnerships and collaboration towards Kingdom expansion. This publication, later with the help of Bible Media, was issued until 2008. The SACD hopes to further this important role, in an online format.

In essence, the SACD envisions Kingdom expansion through information.

"The collective knowledge of the SACD will empower the Body of Christ to connect better, synergise more and strategise effectively to establish the Kingdom of God in all spheres of the South African society through the "whole church" in South Africa," said Etienne Piek, Regional Manager SA, Mergon Foundation. "Strategic funding is only possible if we know the Christian landscape, understand current trends and contexts and know where, how and who to fund. The SACD will make an enormous contribution in this regard, for the wider Body of Christ in South Africa," he added.

The widespread buy-in and excitement from most denominations, Christian NGOs, missions organisations and Christian media platforms underlines the urgent need for a platform like the SACD, and the strategic role that it can play in terms of future effective Kingdom expansion within the SA context.

"The SACD makes Kingdom synergies possible," said Rev. Moss Ntlha, TEASA General Secretary.

Currently there are a few thousand organisations, ministries, networks, platforms, movements and initiatives on the SACD representing 35 different sectors: Church Denominations/Networks, Missions, Evangelism, Prayer, Justice, Business, Media, Family Life, Youth, Children, Education, Health, Environment, Research and Development etc. A further 50 categories to include Advocacy, Rehabilitation, Violence, Human Trafficking, Relief Response, Strategic Partnerships etc.

The first phase mainly focused a national and regional scale, while the second phase currently underway will expand the directory to the local level by including congregations and branches at city and town level.

"In order to efficiently work in the Kingdom, Christian organisations need to be able to effectively communicate with one another. By creating an online directory of Christian organisations, SACD has provided a unique tool for this to happen," said Jenny Mason, Projects Director, SATS.

The following functions are currently available on the website: a variety of search options, an events calendar, a volunteering section and Pray for Africa. A neutral research platform with national statistics and trends is being developed, as well as a mobile app.

Search options include search by category, topics, name of church or ministry, province, city, town, suburb, or abbreviation. Links between themes and geographical areas are also possible to search e.g. Justice Ministries in South Africa, Teaching and Training Ministries in KwaZulu-Natal, Youth Ministries in Cape Town, Social Ministries in Soweto, BADISA programmes, branches of YWAM or CUM Books etc.

The events calendar lists events per calendar month, while under Volunteers, ministries can provide the needs and time periods for volunteering opportunities.

From a technical angle the SACD is accessible to all and mobile friendly. It allows members to update or edit their own profiles to ensure accuracy. It is secure, no personal information is required and participation is entirely free of charge.


### Future functionalities of the SACD include:

- Sub-categories for all the congregations within denominations
- Further sub-divisions of towns within provinces
- Online chat forums within focus areas
- Focused connections between volunteers and volunteering opportunities

The methodology to develop the SACD was based on identifying a few "champions" for each sector with the assignment to map that particular sector. This was to ensure accuracy and a relational approach.

"We have for a long time asked ourselves in the context of the South African church, 'where is the church, what are they doing, and where are the gaps that still need to be filled?' The SACD will go a long way towards answering those questions," said Peter Tarantal, Director of WENSA.


