





n our quest to really live out God's best for us, I found a treasure of a teaching from Jeremy Pearsons that could not have come at a more appropriate time! It has inspired us to be extra vigilant to keep our mind renewed to what God has made available to us through the cross of Jesus. Having said that, I want to remind you today that whatever good things God has purposed and wants us to enjoy in this life, He has already provided and secured for us on the cross. Every covenant promise is a gift to us because of what Jesus accomplished over 2000 years ago. That means we can't acquire a promise by our own efforts or good works. No, every good and perfect promise is a gift of grace to us, and our appropriate response is to accept it with thankful hearts that are full of faith!

hen it comes to your relationship with God, how do you rate it? Do you judge it by how often you go to church? Or how many Scripture verses you've memorized...maybe the length of your prayer time? Does any of that really matter?

Well, the answers to these questions are yes and no. Yes, there's a benefit to attending church. Sure, it's good to know the Word of God. And prayer - well, you really can't pray too much. But it doesn't matter whether you're sitting in a pew every time the church doors open or even if you can quote the whole Bible. It doesn't matter how long or loud you pray!

That may sound like a contradiction, but it's not. Yes, go to church, worship and fellowship with other Christians. Certainly, we should learn God's Word and know how to apply it to our lives. And like I said, you simply cannot pray too much. But no...none of that impresses God or proves anything to Him. He is not logging your prayer hours.

You see, Christianity is not about our weekly church attendance. Many people go to church often and hear many sermons, but hardly put much of what they learn into action. But real Christianity is about having a personal, intimate relationship with Christ. It's about learning how to live an abundant, purposeful life.

We can go to church each week and hear a powerful, life-changing message every time, but when we hear a sermon, we need to focus on what really touches our life in a personal way. That's most likely the thing God wants to deal with us about. Then, we need to go home and meditate on it, study more about that subject in God's Word, and spend time in prayer seeking how to apply that truth to our life.

That's what intimacy with God is all about. It's a personal relationship with Him. It's Him being involved in our lives, and it's knowing He's aware of and concerned about all the details - even the seemingly insignificant or non-spiritual details.

I remember years ago when my husband, Dave, and I used to be in a bowling league. God had recently touched my life in a powerful way. On my way to bowl one evening, God spoke to my heart and said, "Why don't you ask Me to help you bowl?" Bowl? God? Yes...and He will help us with everything we're concerned about - our health, our finances, raising our children, or whatever it is we need. That's how personal a relationship with God is! He is concerned about everything that concerns us. We don't have to divide our lives into the sacred and the secular. Ephesians 6:10 (AMP) says to "be empowered through your union with Him." Our whole life is sacred because God is in it!

So, why does it seem like some people are much closer to Him than others? Does God have favorites? Why do some seem to have a deeper relationship with Him? Why can't we all have that?

I think the answer is simply one thing: Intimacy. We - not God - determine our level of intimacy with Him. We are each as close to God as we want to be. And the closer we get to God, the more intimate we become in our relationship with Him and the more we grow and mature spiritually. In other words, we grow up.

David had the right idea. He said, "One thing I have asked of the Lord, and that I will seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord [in His presence] all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty [the delightful loveliness and majestic grandeur] of the Lord and to meditate in His temple" (Psalm 27:4 AMP).

David was more concerned with seeking God's face - His presence - than seeking His hand - what God could do for him. He simply loved God. And because of that, he grew in character, excellence and integrity, and became a mighty king.

Jesus had many followers. Twelve of them were close friends that He spent much time with. Three of them went with Him into special situations and circumstances to minister to someone. And then there was one who actually called himself "the disciple whom Jesus loved!" All of these people spent time with Jesus. Some were closer to Him than others, but He loved them all. And He loves all of us. God will never love any of us more than He does right this minute. He has a plan for each one of our lives. The one thing that's more important than anything is spending time with Him. The only question is: How close do you want to be?

feel like I am in a hole with no light at the end of the tunnel. Everything is just too much. I feel like I'm under so much pressure. How do I get my monthly budget to work? It can wait until tomorrow. Do these statements sound familiar? Perhaps too familiar?

We are living in increasingly difficult times, politically, economically and spiritually. One of the obvious results is mounting financial pressure on each of us. This is particularly acute for those of us who fulfil the role of head of our particular households and, indeed, our businesses. I have found that we can draw a lot of inspiration and lessons from the life of Joseph, who became the executive premier of all the land of Egypt of old, second only to the president of that time, Pharaoh. Egypt was faced with looming economic difficulties and Joseph's brief from Pharaoh was quite simply to solve the problem. He was not given much more detail than that. These lessons, I firmly believe, will help us all in these challenging times. In the next series of articles I would like to focus on some of these. Although they may not all be strictly financial in nature, I believe that their application will have, as one result, a positive financial effect.

One of the basic tenets of Joseph's success was the bold and diplomatic application of Godly wisdom in his life. He seemed to display an ability that nobody else had. He was always prepared to provide a solution to seemingly

complex problems or abstract dreams. In our lives we need to pause and allow God to help us make sense of our present conditions and then actively implement our attempts at a solution. Procrastination simply will not work. We need to energetically face all of our obstacles with a quiet confidence that we are actually in control of them. Take stock of who you are in the first place and how wonderfully you have been created.

Joseph was also consistently prepared to publicly explain his solutions. This implied that he had a solution in the first place and had sufficient clarity to articulate his understanding of the problem and his methodology to solve it. This is an important lesson because, too often, we can see our obstacles, such as worsening economic times, but we simply do not know how to react and therefore do not... to our peril. There is always a solution. We just need to find it!

Nowhere in the account of Joseph's life is there any suggestion of timidity. Let's face it, he was placed before some powerful people and yet he was prepared to speak his mind, albeit with diplomacy. This implies that under pressure situations, he was confident that he was correct. He knew, and was prepared to publicly admit, that his wisdom came directly from the throne-room of God and this was a fundamental building block of his personal success in his future.

A RINGING SUCCESS

ne of the greatest 19th Century inventions that still finds prime place in modern communications technology is the telephone. While telephonic communications have evolved in parts of the world from copper wire to satellite and fibre-optic variations, the principle of sound transmission remains as one of the foremost tools in global communications.

The inventor of the telephone is the famous Alexander Graham Bell, born on 3 March 1847 in Edinburgh, Scotland. Both his grandfather and father were authorities in elocution and speech correction, and Alexander was groomed to pursue the same career from a young age. His knowledge of the nature of sound saw him becoming a teacher to the deaf (the fact that both his mother and wife were deaf certainly played a role in choice of career), and also assisted him in the invention of the telephone. According to Elizabeth MacLeod, author of Alexander Graham Bell: An Inventive Life (Toronto: Kids Can Press,

1999), Alexander Bell considered his most famous invention an intrusion on his real work as a scientist and refused to have a telephone in his study! (Could modern day cell phone fanatics learn a lesson from this?)

In 1872 Bell became professor of Vocal Physiology and Elocution at the Boston University School of Oratory, where he was excited to also be in a city full of many scientists and inventors. He continued his research in sound, particularly to find a way to transmit musical notes and articulate speech. Although he was committed to his research he found it difficult to devote enough time to experimentation since his days and evenings were occupied by teaching and giving private classes. The only solution for Bell was to stay awake late into the night, running experiment after experiment; he was concerned that his work would be discovered and took great pains to lock up his notebooks and laboratory equipment.


When Bell began experimenting with electrical signals, the telegraph had been an established means of communication for nearly thirty years. Although a successful system, the telegraph (sending Morse code), was limited to receiving and sending one message at a time. Bell's experimentation was to find a way of transmitting multiple messages over the same wire at the same time, hence the name "harmonic telegraph" to describe his early experimentation.

By October 1874, Bell's research had progressed to the extent that he could inform his future father-in-law (Gardiner Greene Hubbard) about the possibility of a multiple telegraph. Seeing the potential Hubbard gave Bell the financial backing he needed. Bell continued with his work together with Thomas Watson, a young electrician whose services he had enlisted. While working on the 'multiple telegraph', Bell and Watson were simultaneously exploring the idea of developing a device that would transmit speech electrically. In March 1875 Bell visited the famous scientist Joseph Henry (director of the Smithsonian Institution) to ask his advice on the electrical invention that Bell hoped would transmit the human voice by telegraph. Henry replied that Bell had "the germ of a great invention". When Bell said that he did not have the necessary knowledge, Henry replied, "Get it!" Spurred on by Henry's positive opinion, Bell and Watson continued their work.

Alexander Graham Bell's notebook entry of 10 March 1876 describes his successful experiment with the telephone. Speaking through the instrument to his assistant, Thomas A. Watson, in the next room, Bell utters these famous first words, "Mr Watson, come here, I want to see you."

Although Alexander Graham Bell is most often associated with the invention of the telephone, his interests were extremely varied. According to his biographer, Charlotte Gray, Bell's work ranged "unfettered across the scientific landscape" and he often went to bed voraciously reading the Encyclopaedia Britannica, scouring it for new areas of interest. His other patents included inventions for phonographs, the hydrofoil (and other aeronautical inventions), a metal detector and selenium cells.

The life of Alexander Bell is a testimony to the power of the human mind and the potential that is locked up on the inside of each human being. The only requirement is a thirst for knowledge and the quest to find the answers and solutions to our dreams and vision. King Solomon made this remark, "Sell everything and buy Wisdom! Forage for Understanding! Don't forget one word! Don't deviate an inch! Never walk away from Wisdom - she guards your life; love her - she keeps her eye on you. Above all and before all, do this: Get Wisdom! Write this at the top of your list: Get Understanding! Throw your arms around her believe me, you won't regret it; never let her go - she'll make your life glorious. She'll garland your life with grace, she'll festoon your days with beauty." (Proverbs 4:5-9 The Message). Well, what are you waiting for? Don't you have some experiments waiting? +



ow are we really supposed to know what anyone else is saying nowadays? Sure we think we know what people are saying but do we really? So what are we to do? How do we communicate effectively? And how do we become discerning when we are "communicated to". Well here are one or two points that I've learned in my life.

Zzzzzzzzz I can already see some people nodding off saying, "yeah, yeah communication schlommunication blah blah". But wait, listen? Are we ready to be communicated to by the media, politicians (elections are coming up), even pastors/ministers etc. I mean some people are gifted speakers but do we make the effort to think about what they're really saying. I've heard some really gifted speakers which make you feel "wow" after a sermon but upon reflection they haven't said much more than, "The cat sat on the mat."

One of the points that I've learned in life is critical thinking. Huh? "What does that mean?" you ask. "Am I supposed to criticise my thoughts?" "Hmm that ice cream looks nice... no! Stupid thought! You're worthless, get out of my head!"

No, that's not what I mean. Critical thinking is kind of like putting a spam filter in your brain. It sorts out the good from the bad, the wrong from the right. It engages your brain into gear as opposed to parking it in neutral. I mean the basic rule is - don't believe everything you hear/ read. There's a good start, put that one in your brain and your spam filter's working already. You see this even goes for when you're hearing a sermon. You don't disengage your brain just because it's a Christian thing or just because the Dominee is saying it. On the contrary think about it. That doesn't mean be sceptical about everything...no... just think about it. The big test is does it measure up with the Bible? Is it in line with what God is saying in the Bible? Because remember I can quote Bible verses that seem to back up what I'm saying about just about anything. But is the scripture I'm quoting in the right context? In other words is what the person is saying/preaching about lining up with what God is saying in those verses? But this

doesn't only apply to sermons – that's just an example. What about the media (what music, movies, TV etc say to us), politicians, friends/family etc?

Another big thing I've learned about communication is making sure I'm being understood when I say something. I can't even tell you how many times I've been misquoted and misunderstood. Not always my fault but there are many times where my less than phenomenal communication skills have led to me being misunderstood (hopefully that's not happening now). And I've had to learn how to make myself clearer so people know what I mean when I say something. - so I need to be clear when I say something and careful how I say it. TV shows - especially sitcoms use this idea to great effect. Often they will use situations of miscommunication to make a scene funny and one of the main reasons its funny is because we know that that kind of thing happens. Picture this: two people are in a room, a third person is outside listening to the situation and misunderstands what is going on. Which either produces funny or disastrous consequences. We've all seen it.

I read about a survey recently where people did a test with emails. In the survey 90% of the people thought they were clear about what was said and meant. However, when tested only about 50 % had actually understood the messages. Makes you think, doesn't it?

So let's be more proactive in our communication - remembering that communication is a twoway thing. Let us have our spam filters turned on at all times. We need to be wise...even us young okes. Another thing is making our and everybody else's lives (especially our parents) easier by being careful about what we say and particularly how we say it. Miscommunication can cause unnecessary problems in our lives with our friends, family, girl/boyfriends etc. On the other hand good communication can ensure we do not mislead or are not misled by others. One of my favourite verses on communication especially as a Christian is 1 Peter 3:8-18. Well...go on, look it up...I'm not going to just give it to you...don't be lazy. ■

















