editorial



FROM THE EDITOR

There is a great word in the English language, that when practically implemented, make for an extremely civilized society. That word is of course "sportsmanship." And then, of course, I think good or poor sportsmanship extends even into the spiritual realm; I equate sportsmanship with attitude, so the extent to which you approach life will yield the desired results. Spiritually speaking our lives can either be ruled by fear or by faith – there is no middle ground in life. When we are ruled by fear, our attitudes will tend to display the negativity and poor sportsmanship (rudeness, impatience, anger) will result. However, the flipside is when we approach life with a positive attitude that is based in faith. Now faith for me is a two-way street; it is firstly the faith we have in God and ourselves to accomplish things, and secondly (and equally important) the faith that God has in usl God's faith in us should be a motivating factor for a good attitude, after all, He entrusted us with the message of hope and love to give to a world lost in fear and insecurity.

So the next time we find ourselves in a situation where we are tempted to display poor sportsmanship, perhaps it would do us well to remember that our real task on earth is to support, encourage and build up the people around us with a positive and love-filled message of hope.



THE ABSOLUTELY AMAZING REST OF GOD!

God wants us to enjoy our everyday lives. John 10:10 says that Jesus died for us so we "may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows)" (AMP). But it seems so many people who say they believe in Jesus are not really enjoying their lives. It's tragic to think that Jesus paid the price for our sins, that He suffered to make that sacrifice, and yet there are Christians who are struggling just to get by and make it through each day.

The key to having abundant life in Christ is living by God's grace through faith. Because grace is His power working in us that enables us to do whatever we need to do in life.

When we try to do everything in our own strength and leave God out of the equation, we just get worn-out and frustrated by our mistakes and failures. But when we lean on God, we actually enter into His rest and can enjoy our lives, no matter what our circumstances may be.

Hebrews 4:9-11 (AMP) says, "So there remains a (full and complete) Sabbath rest for the people of God. For the one who has once entered His rest has also rested from (the weariness and pain of) his human labors.... Let us therefore

make every effort to enter that rest (of God, to know and experience it for ourselves)...."

Now the rest of God is not a rest from work—it's a rest in work. It's partnering with God to do what He is calling you to do by His grace, and leaving the part you can't do in His hands, trusting Him to do it. Hebrews 4:3 says it this way: "For we who believe (that is, we who personally trust and confidently rely on God) enter that rest...." So we start by believing.

When I'm trying to believe, I haven't entered God's rest. But when I do believe, I have complete rest in Him. Living by faith is not a life of struggle—it's rest. And you can enter into God's rest in every area of your life.

I've discovered that the stress in my life is caused by the way I approach my circumstances and the attitude I have toward them. It was a turning point for me when I realized that the world will probably never change, but I can learn how to change the way I go about handling situations that are challenging.

One key to this is knowing that as believers in Christ, we are partners with God—we have a part and He has a part in everything He calls us to do. When we don't do the part we can do and we try to do His part, that's when we live stressed-out with worry, fear, anxiety, frustration, no peace and no joy.

The reason this happens sometimes is because we think God needs our help. We meditate on the problem—rolling it over and over in our mind, worrying, trying to figure out how things should work out. It's like we're telling God, "I kind of think You need my help, and I'm not sure You can take care of this situation, Lord."

We need to realize that worrying is useless! It's like sitting in a rocking chair, rocking all day, wearing yourself out and getting nowhere. Trusting God means we give up worrying, reasoning, and anxiety and we enter into His rest with simple childlike faith—we live by grace through faith!

Ephesians 2:8-9 is a great scripture that says we're saved by grace through faith. And we walk out our relationship with God and His plans for our lives the same way we receive salvation: by grace through faith.

This is possible because Jesus made the perfect sacrifice for us when He gave His life, taking our guilt and condemnation and paying for our sins. Through a personal relationship with Jesus, we access God's grace so we can do what He's calling us to do.

It's so amazing to know that God is always with us, giving us His grace for everything we need to do in life. Trust God's unconditional love for you today. Do what you can do and give Him everything else. And when you find yourself getting frustrated or feeling overwhelm tike you just can't do it anymore, remember to stop, get your focus back on Him and enter into His rest once again.



THE GOSPEL IN PURITY AND SIMPLICITY

I read a beautiful article by a wonderful preacher regarded by the Baptists, as the prince of preachers, Charles Haddon Spurgeon and he spoke about the simplicity of preaching The Word of God. If ever we needed to get back to basics, it is in this day and age. It's not Jesus plus, its Jesus only!

He says, "To try and win a soul to Christ by keeping that soul in ignorance of any truth, is contrary to the mind of the spirit; and to endeavor to save men by mere claptrap, or excitement, or preaching display, is as foolish as to hope to hold an angel with a bird-lime, or lure a star with music." We've got to get back to the old- old Gospel.

How often do we hear a message preached, for example from John 3:3 (NKJV), "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." or verse 7, "You must be born again." Was it not Nicodemus, the member of the Sanhedrin and one of the most powerful man in Israel who came to our Lord Jesus Christ by night and asked Him what he should do to inherit eternal life.

Nicodemus said "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him." Of course, Jesus answered, "You have got to be born-again (make a clean start)."

We can no longer serve two masters. Matthew 12:30 says, "He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad." If we are going to experience a change in our lives, then we need to make a new start and people need to know that, like never before. There has got to be a difference in one's life. You cannot say, "because my parents and grandparents were Christians than I automatically qualify too." As the old saying goes "There are no grandchildren in Heaven." Each and every one of us has got to meet Jesus for Himself.

The change I am talking about, is what happened to Saul of Tarsus who was on his way to Damascus to persecute and kill the Christians, only to be knocked off his horse and to be converted instantaneously, from being a murderer of

the believer to becoming an agent of Jesus Christ. He was used mightily by the Lord to save souls.

While the disciples were fishing for food they met the Carpenter from Nazareth, the Son of God and got changed instantly into 'fishers of souls.' There has got to be a change! Zacchaeus, the rich publican was one moment extorting people, especially the poor and making himself extremely rich, and then the next moment he was giving half of his goods to the poor and restoring 400% of anything taken by false accusations.

Mary Magdalen a woman who seven demons were cast out of by Jesus Christ, turned her life around and became His most ardent, passionate and devoted follower right up to the cross, when even the disciples ran away, she remained faithful - a complete turnaround. That is why John Newton could write that beautiful hymn "Amazing Grace." He was the captain of a slave ship and I cannot think of a worse profession possible. Yet he said, "I once was lost, but now I am found. I was blind, but now I see." There has got to be a change.

I think of my own life, as a young boy who couldn't speak to more than two people, who ran away when he saw a girl and just a few months ago had the privilege of speaking to over one million people, and praying the sinner's prayer with them. Surely it was only God, for with man these things are totally impossible.

How do we see the results of a life changed? While quite simply, by the fruit of the Spirit. We have got to see love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23) taking place in a new believer. When people find such a gem, or pearl, as salvation they cannot possibly keep it to themselves, and that's all revival really is: – "a people saturated with God."

From homeless to a multi-award winning artist, empowerment speaker and philanthropist.

JuroLumba was once an occultistand alcoholic, but everything changed when he had a life-changing encounter with God. This encounter came after a season of being homeless, which incidentally, was also the inspiration for songs such as God is in Control. In short, the 'fast life' was exchanged for ministry, feeding the homeless in Cape Town, and giving away blankets to the poor.

His love of music (hip-hop) became a vehicle to promote the kingdom of God, and to minister to a generation often left on the sidelines in the Church. He noticed that some young people (and many adults) weren't interested in attending Church because they felt 'left out', misunderstood, and seemingly forced to serve God according traditions and people's personal taste. Juro faced some opposition from those who did not welcome rap as a legitimate genre or medium of worship and outreach.

In the midst of all this confusion and opposition, Ambassador J Loemba(his stage name) decided to stop performing rap in order to solely focus on preaching; however, when-

ever he prayed about it, the Lord reminded him that He is the one who gave him this talent!He asked the Lord for a sign, and after a while hewas invited to minister in song in a very conservative Church and was surprised to see old men and women (from 60 and up) praising God to rap, almost with more energy than young people who were equally as shocked as he was.

After the event, a kid came to him and told him that he always wanted to be like 2Pac but after hearing him, he decided to use his talent for God and rap about things that edify people; after encouraging and praying for the kid a group of elderly women approached him to tell him that they loved his music and that the Lord has placed a special anointing upon him and that he will be mightily used by God to reach lives around the world.

A while later, the Grammy Award winning Artist Donnie Mc-Clurkin prayed for Juro during his African Tour; Donnie also prophesied exactly the same things Ambassador J Loemba has been receiving through visions, as well as from other ministers. Donnie McClurkin also inspired him to combine his preaching and music ministry in order to reach different groups of people in and outside of the Church.

After seeing and hearing many more similar encouraging testimonies and prophesies, Ambassador J Loemba decided to record his first album but he quickly faced another obstacle - he couldn't get a record deal because the Hip Hop Gospel Genre was still new and not well received in the Christian Community. Jurowas inspired by God, while praying, to start his own record label that was subsequently named Christ Impact Records. Even though many people (including Christians) never thought that anything good would come out of this initiative, today by the grace of God he is a multi-award winning artist. He was recently nominated in UK in the Best International Artist Category along Grammy/ Dove /Stellar Awards with winners such as Donnie McClurkin, Andy Mineo, Israel Houghton, and Deitrick Haddon. In South Africahe has (together with CMMM) won the SABC Crown Gospel Music Awards 2016 "Best Music Video of the Year" for a song and music video he wrote and co-directed titled God of Miracles.

Because Ambassador J Loemba chose to obey God, despite the opposition and lack of support, his Record label "Christ Impact Records" is one of the most successful Urban Christian Records Label in Africa today, with his music featured on mainstream TV Channels and most major Gospel Media Platforms from Africa, Europe, to the USA. Through

his music ministry lives have been transformed; he has seen people healed, the dead raised back to life and hardcore gangsters changed while in prison while listening to his music and testimony.

When asked how he would like to be known and remembered, Ambassador J Loemba said "I want my life to reconcile men and women around the world to the reality of God, and demonstrating that nothing is impossible with God."











