

# FACE YOUR GIANTS AND MOVE FORWARD IN LIFE

We all go through hard times in this life and have issues we need to deal with.While it's not easy to face challenges or things that have caused pain, it can actually help us if we let God use them to do a good work in us.

James 1:12 (AMPC) says, "Blessed (happy, to be envied) is the man who is patient under trial and stands up under temptation, for when he has stood the test and been approved, he will receive (the victor's) crown of life which God has promised to those who love Him."

This verse is talking about how going through difficult times and resisting temptation to sin tests and tries us, revealing our true character. It prepares us to pass our tests so we can be promoted and move forward in God's plans for us. It's time to stop running from things that are hard, that we're avoiding or putting off because we just don't want to confront them. I'm talking about issues like debt, an addiction, poor health due to bad habits, unhealthy relationships, messes caused by bad choices that have led you to live in self-pity...or anything else that is making you feel guilty, frustrated and weary.

Maybe you've been living with a broken heart—an emotional wound—that's been bleeding for way too long. Perhaps you have an anger issue, bitterness, or insecurity that causes you to be easily offended and hard to get along with.Whatever your "issues" are, they are not just hang-ups, weaknesses or things you have to live with. They are giants coming against you in your walk with Christ. And as a believer in Jesus, you don't have to live with any giant—you are a giant killer!

#### **Confront Your Giants**

In 1 Samuel 17, we read about David, the shepherd boy who conquered Goliath, the Philistine giant who was oppressing the Israelite army. David's brothers were soldiers, and his father sent him to the battlefield to take provisions to them. When he heard about Goliath, David asked, "Who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should defy the armies of the living God?" (v. 26).

It bothered David that these Israelite men of God were standing around, letting Goliath intimidate them, so he said, "I'll fight him!" But King Saul didn't think he could defeat the giant.

So David told Saul how he had killed the lion and the bear when they came after his sheep. Then he said, "And this uncircumcised Philistine shall be like one of them, for he has defied the armies of the living God!" (v. 36). You've probably heard the story: he took his slingshot and five smooth stones, "ran quickly toward the battle line" (v. 48), and killed Goliath. David used what he had and ran toward the battle—not away from it. God blessed him and made him a giant killer, and He wants to do the same thing for you!

#### Learn the Best Strategy for Battle

The first step in confronting your giants is making the decision that you won't live with them any longerbut you will trust God to help you do what you need to do to be free of them. Your attitude should be: I am a giant killer, and I'm not running from my problems anymore. I'm going to take responsibility for the messes I've made and stop making excuses to avoid them. I'm trusting God to show me what I need to do, and by His grace, I'll do it!

Remember that we are partners with God: We have a part to do and He has a part to do. He won't do our part, and we can't do His part. When we do what we can do, He will always do what we cannot do. But we have to be willing to obey His direction, doing what He shows us to do.

The next step is to study the Word; look up every scripture in the Bible that addresses the issue and meditate on each one. Write them down and put them places where you'll see them often. Pray and ask God to help you apply His Truth to your life. It can also help to read books about the subject, and if you need it, get professional help, like counseling.

As you spend time with God, praying and studying Scripture, He will work in your heart, healing your wounds, strengthening your faith, and showing you how to move forward to overcome your giants.

The truth is, you don't have to live defeated, with a broken heart and emotional pain. Make your mind up today: "I'm not going to get stuck in the past and give up my future because of something that hurt me. I can't go back and undo it, but I can go forward in Christ. I will have a whole heart and be healed because Jesus came to heal the brokenhearted. I am a giant killer!"

# **PERFECT LOVE NEVER FAILS**

The struggle for self-preservation and independence is, in fact, the condition of a heart that is ignorant and has no understanding of, the true nature of God's unselfish and perfect love. The devil may not have the capacity to know or experience it, but every man and woman, created by God, does. Why would we take on, or follow after the insecure nature of the devil? He has tirelessly fought and struggled for self-gratifying power, with the assumption that it will in some way bring him satisfaction. And He has relentlessly tried to convince man, that independence from God, will make us powerful and controllers of our own identities and destinies. When in fact, our true identity and destiny, is only complete in the perfect, unfailing love of God. Nothing else will ever satisfy, or give us purpose.

The words of Jesus make this very clear, in John 15:4-7, "Dwell in Me, and I will dwell in you. (Live in Me, and I will live in you.) Just as no branch can bear fruit of itself without abiding in (being vitally united to) the vine, neither can you bear fruit unless you abide in Me.

I am the Vine; you are the branches. Whoever lives in Me and I in him bears much (abundant) fruit. However, apart from Me (cut off from vital union with Me) you can do nothing.

If a person does not dwell in Me, he is thrown out like a (broken-off) branch, and withers; such branches are gathered up and thrown into the fire, and they are burned.

If you live in Me (abide vitally united to Me) and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you." Living free, fulfilled and complete, can and will only come from a life that is totally surrendered and yielded to the nature and character of Christ. In everything, we are to surrender our all, to become one with Him.

Keeping His Words in our hearts, and His ways directing our

lives, is a purposeful decision, as a result of our love for Him. It's an act of love that will always be rewarded with His manifest goodness, kindness and joy in our lives. In fact, there is nothing He will not do for us, when we choose to set our love on Him and surrender our lives to His love.

Jesus said, in John 14:21, "The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who (really) loves Me; and whoever (really) loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I (too) will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him. (I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.)". And in John 15:11, He says, "I have told you these things, that My joy and delight may be in you, and that your joy and gladness may be of full measure and complete and overflowing." In John 15:7, He says, "If you live in Me (abide vitally united to Me) and My words remain in you and continue to live in your hearts, ask whatever you will, and it shall be done for you."

Let this portion of Psalm 91, become an anchor for your soul, as you yield your life to His unconditional, never failing love today. "Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him; I will set him on high, because he knows and understands My name (has a personal knowledge of My mercy, love, and kindness—trusts and relies on Me, knowing I will never forsake him, no, never).

He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honour him. With long life will I satisfy him and show him My salvation." (Psalm 91:14-16)

Being completely surrendered to the One who created us, is the only way to a life marked by true happiness. A long, full, productive and satisfied life will never be found independent of Him. It's the way He designed it to be, since before the foundation of the world.

What makes your programme unique as opposed to other Gap year courses? We believe the Beyond Adventure concept to be unique in South Africa. The concept of 'Extreme Education' was designed to provide a challenging environment for young people to discover and develop their leadership potential. Leadership deals with direction, vision, purpose and principles and our leadership programme focuses on building the students up, making them aware of other cultures, helping them with emotional bank account building and strengthening them as individuals functioning in a group context.

# WHY YOU SHOULD FIND A GOOD MENTOR

In many ways, the most important advantage a person has in the workplace are relationships. In the past, "networking" was about taking advantage – what other people can do for me. But today, networking is about helping other people because it's the right thing to do. Whether you believe in God, Karma, or random chance, the truth is, when you help others achieve their dreams, they can help you achieve yours. But when it comes to the mentors and allies you have at work, here some important principles to remember:

1) Find people who can help you in your weak areas. If you're weak with numbers, develop a relationship with someone in accounting. If you're weak creatively, get to know the creative team. Too often we spend the most time with people like us, when we should be spending more time with people who compliment our skill set. It's not about using them, it's about how together you can be more valuable to the organization.

2) Be sincere. I can tell in less than a minute when someone is simply trying to get something from me. The old saying "They don't care how much you know until they know how much you care" is true. Count on it.

3) "People skills" are the most important skills you'll ever learn. I don't care what your job is, your ability to get along

with people trumps everything. If you can inspire and motivate people, you'll always be in demand.

4) The people you meet on the way up, you'll meet on the way down. Far too many people are rude and inconsiderate to co-workers while they're rising in the company. But no one knows the future, and you never know who you'll need to know. Be nice now – it can reap powerful dividends later in your career.

5) Finally, the unexpected people in the office can often help the most. Early in my career I realized I couldn't spend time with the company president, so I got to know his secretary, an older woman named Ruth. I remembered her birthday, asked about her family, and we became friends. I discovered pretty quickly just how much power the president's secretary really had. An email from her was as authoritative as an email from the boss, and her influence made a huge difference for me. Likewise, security guards, receptionists, and others can help when the chips are down. Never forget that the least powerful people can often have the most influence. ■

If we look at Luke 17:11-19 we will see that Jesus healed 10 lepers, but only one leper returned after he was healed to say thank you to Jesus. There is an old saying that I read just recently which says, "Do not grumble because you do not get what you want; but rather be grateful that you don't get what you deserve." Not one of us deserves to go to Heaven, not one of us deserves salvation, not one of us deserves to meet Jesus Christ faceto-face one day but because of His goodness towards us, those of us who believe that He is the Son of God, will meet Him in paradise and live with Him forever.

A man by the name William Tiptaft said, "God is pleased with gratitude because He gets so little of it." We need to start to be grateful for what we've got and stop complaining about what we haven't got.

There is a story of a little boy who had no shoes and he was continually grumbling to his mother about it. Until one day when he was walking down the street, he saw a little boy being wheeled down the street in a wheelchair and he had no feet. From that moment onwards the little boy never grumbled again.

I remember preaching in a Church in Johannesburg many years ago and on the wall inside the Church, in bright neon lights was written "Missionary work is gratitude for Calvary." I've never forgotten that. We don't preach the Gospel for anything else, but because we love Jesus and He has called us to go into all the world and to preach the Gospel to every creature (Mark 16:15). As a farmer, I'm sitting in my quiet time room and I am listening to the gentle rain falling on top of my tin roof. The air is pregnant with moisture and the trees are dripping with drops of rain - I'm so thankful.

Let us not take God's blessings for granted, because not one of us deserves anything from God. Let us rather be grateful for every drop of rain that we have got. Instead of saying "It's not enough", let us rather rephrase that comment and say "God thank you for giving us the life support we need by sending this gentle, beautiful rain."

How can we show God in a practical way that we truly love Him and that we truly are grateful for the promise we have of eternal life, not because of our good works, but because we believe?

We can show Jesus by telling others about Him. By telling others with a positive attitude that Jesus Christ is Lord and that nothing can happen to us without His permission. The most grateful man that I believe in The Bible was Job, the farmer. He was not a fair-weather Christian and he loved God unconditionally. He refused to speak badly about God and his very own wife said "Why don't you curse God and die." Job lost everything, his possessions, his health and his farm etc. but he continued to say in The Book of Job 13:15 (NKJV), "Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him."

That is gratitude and saying "Thank you Lord, I love You unconditionally." That is what God is requiring from you and me this year; unconditional love, much gratitude and thankfulness for saving and giving us an eternal future.
